

## Errata for GHS 2012 Statistical release

Based a few errors identified during further analysis in Q412aGrant, Q412aNon and Q412bMain as well as the derived variable TOTMHINC, the GHS 2012 statistical release document was revised as follows:

1. Figure 39, on page 40, were revised. The percentage of households that receive grants as a source of income changed as follows:
  - Western Cape from 31,7% to 34,3%
  - Eastern Cape from 55,1% to 58,4%
  - Northern Cape from 48,3% to 50,3%
  - Free State from 50,6% to 53,5%
  - KwaZulu-Natal from 44,4% to 50,3%
  - North West from 44,8% to 46,8%
  - Gauteng from 21,9% to 27,4%
  - Mpumalanga from 48,7% to 52,3%
  - Limpopo from 53,7% to 59,3%
  - South Africa from 39,5% to 43,9%
  
2. Figure 40, that shows the percentage distribution of main sources of household income, was revised as follows:
  - Western Cape: Grants change from 11,6% to 11,8% and Salaries change from 73,1% to 72,9%;
  - Eastern Cape: Grants change from 37,9% to 38,0% and salaries from 42,3% to 42,2%;
  - Northern Cape: Grants change from 28,3% to 28,5% and salaries from 55,4% to 55,3%;
  - KwaZulu-Natal: Grants change 25,9% to 26,0%;
  - Gauteng: Grants change from 8,8% to 8,9% and salaries from 71,2% to 71,1%;
  - Mpumalanga: Grants change from 21,3% to 21,4% and salaries from 55,4% to 55,3%
  - Limpopo: Grants change from 32,8% to 33,1% and salaries from 42,4% to 42,2%
  - South Africa: Grants change from 21,3% to 21,4% and salaries from 59,2% to 59,1%;
  
3. Table 16.1 in the annexure complements Figure 39, above, and indicates the number of households that receive various sources of income. Only figures for grants changed as follows (figures in thousands):
  - Western Cape: 513 to 556
  - Eastern Cape: 898 to 953
  - Northern Cape: 143 to 149
  - Free State: 427 to 451
  - KwaZulu-Natal: 1 111 to 1 259
  - North West: 494 to 517
  - Gauteng: 909 to 1 138
  - Mpumalanga: 530 to 569
  - Limpopo: 747 to 825

- South Africa: 5 773 to 6 417

4. Table 16.2 in the annexure complements Table 16.1 as well as Figure 39, and indicates the number of households that receive various sources of income by the population group and sex of the household head. Due to the error in combination to incorrect labelling, all figures except those for 'salaries/wages/commission' and 'other income' changed.
