

# TOTAL NUMBER OF DEBT CASES INCREASES

The total number of civil summonses for debt issued during the three months up to February 1997 (289 882 summonses) increased by 7,5% (or 20 252) compared with the three months up to February 1996. The total number of civil judgements for debt increased even more (18,2% or 22 530 judgements) during the same period.

The increase of 7,5% in civil summonses for debt can mainly be attributed to more summonses issued in respect of money lent (+26,5%); non-professional services (+4,8%) and goods sold on open account (+3,7%). During February 1997 109 594 civil summonses for debt were issued. Of these, 22,1% were summonses in respect of non-professional services and 20,6% for goods sold on open account.

The total number of civil judgements for debt issued during February 1997 was 51 320, which involved R382,9 million. The largest amounts were recorded in respect of civil judgements regarding money lent (R171,3 million) and promissory notes; bills, R/D cheques, credit cards and other acknowledgements of debt (R42,1 million), constituting 44,7% and 11,0% of the total debt respectively.

Except for cases recorded, all other information relates to debt cases only; i.e. claims for damages, ejectment orders and other non-debt cases are excluded.


Default and consent judgements relate to judgements given in respect of undefended debt cases only.


### **COMPARABILITY**

The jurisdiction limit for civil cases handled by magistrate offices (R20 000 for liquid assets and R50 000 for non liquid assets) was increased to R100 000 as from 1 May 1995. A comparison with the period prior to May 1995 must thus be handled with circumspection.

Statistics in respect of small claims courts are updated annually.






Scale: Semi-Logarithmic

# SMALL CLAIMS COURTS

#### **NOTES**

- Up to 30/9/95 small claims courts served as a forum for the adjudication of money claims of not more than R2 000 against individuals or firms. It is for use by the general public only and not for business enterprises.
- As from 1/10/95 the following actions are excluded from the jurisdiction of the small claims court:
  - Claims exceeding R3 000 in value.
  - Claims against the state.
  - Claims based on cession or the transfer of rights.
  - Claims for damages in respect of defamation, malicious prosecution, wrongful imprisonment, wrongful arrest, seduction and breach of promise to marry.
  - Claims for the dissolution of a marriage.
  - Claims concerning the validity of a will.
  - Claims concerning the status of a person in respect of his mental capacity.
  - Claims in which the performance in accordance with a contract is sought, without an alternative claim for payment of damages, except in the case of a claim for rendering an account or transferring movable or immovable property not exceeding R3 000 in value.

### **COMPARABILITY**

The information in respect of magistrates courts shown in this statistical release refers to debt cases only and is therefore not strictly comparable with the information shown for the small claims courts.

#### CONCEPTS .

"Courts" relate to the total number of small claims courts at the end of the months as indicated. "Litigants referred" relates to the number of persons (plaintiffs) referred to legal assistants by clerks of the small claims court.
