## Statistics of civil cases for debt February 1998

Statistical release P0041

Co-operation between the Central Statistical Service and the residents of the RSA, the private sector and the government institutions is essential for a successful statistical system in the RSA. The CSS publishes approximately five hundred different releases per year. ## CIVIL SUMMONSES LEVELLING OFF WHILST CIVIL JUDGEMENTS CONTINUE TO INCREASE

The total number of civil summonses has been levelling off since the middle of 1997. However, the number of civil judgements for debt continues to show an upward trend since the middle of 1996. The total number of civil summonses for debt recorded for the three months up to February 1998, increased by 10,8% compared with the corresponding period of a year ago, and was 2,8% higher, after seasonal adjustment, than the previous three months. The total number of civil judgements for debt increased by 24,1% compared with the same period of a year ago and was 6,5% higher after seasonal adjustment compared with the preceding three months.

The largest contributors to the 10,8% increase in civil summonses for debt were civil summonses pertaining to "other services" and money lent, with increases of 32,0% and 22,8%, respectively. During February 1998, 30 836 or 26,1% of the total civil summonses for debt issued were for civil summonses relating to "other services", while 20 023 or 16,9% were in respect of money lent.

During February 1998, 65 545 civil judgements for debt were issued and the total amount involved was R475,6 million. Civil judgements for debt relating to money lent continue to constitute the largest portion (R178,3 million or 37,5%), followed by "other services" (R48,9 million or 10,3%).

Default and consent judgements relate to judgements given in respect of undefended debt cases only.


**COMPARABILITY**

The jurisdiction limit for civil cases handled by Magistrate's Offices (R20 000 for liquid assets and R50 000 for non liquid assets) was increased to R100 000 as from 1 May 1995. A comparison with the period prior to May 1995 must thus be handled with circumspection.

## CIVIL JUDGEMENTS FOR DEBT - NUMBER



## **SMALL CLAIMS COURTS**

### **NOTES**

Small claims courts serve as a forum for the adjudication of money claims against individuals or firms. It is for use by the general public only and not for business enterprises.

Up to 30 September 1995 the following actions were excluded from the jurisdiction of small claims courts:

- Claims exceeding R2 000 in value;
- Claims against the state;
- Claims based on cession or the transfer of rights;
- Claims for damages in respect of defamation, malicious prosecution, wrongful imprisonment, wrongful arrest, seduction and breach of promise to marry;
- Claims for the dissolution of a marriage;
- Claims concerning the validity of a will;
- Claims concerning the status of a person in respect of his mental capacity; and
- Claims in which the performance in accordance with a contract is sought, without an alternative claim for payment of damages, except in the case of a claim for rendering an account or transferring movable or immovable property not exceeding R2 000 in value.

As from 1 October 1995 the jurisdiction limit of R2 000 was raised to R3 000.

### **COMPARABILITY**

The information in respect of magistrates courts shown in this statistical release refers to debt cases only and is therefore not strictly comparable with the information shown for the small claims courts.

### **CONCEPTS**

"Courts" relate to the total number of small claims courts at the end of the months as indicated. "Litigants referred" relates to the number of persons (plaintiffs) referred to legal assistants by clerks of the small claims court.
