## Statistics of civil cases for debt January 1997

---

Statistical release P0041

Co-operation between the Central Statistical Service and the residents of the RSA, the private sector and the government institutions is essential for a successful statistical system in the RSA. Without this continued co-operation and goodwill, the timely release of relevant and reliable official statistics will not be possible.

The CSS publishes approximately five hundred different releases per year. In the light of expenditure restraints in government, it is no longer economically viable to produce them in more than one of the eleven official languages in South Africa. Since the releases are also extensively used by the international economic and social-scientific communities, from 1996 CSS releases will be published in English.

**DEBT CASES INCREASE**

*The total number of civil summonses for debt for the three months up to January 1997 shows an increase of 17,0% (from 125 438 to 149 906) compared with the corresponding period of the previous year. The total number of civil judgements for debt increased by 19,5% during the same period.*

The increase of 17,0% in civil summonses for debt can mainly be attributed to more summonses issued in respect of non-professional services (+50,0%) and money lent (+22,0%). Out of a total of 95 568 summonses for debt issued during January 1997, 20,5% were in respect of non-professional services, while 19,4% were in respect of goods sold on open account.

The total amount involved in respect of civil judgements for debt issued during January 1997 was R355,4 million. Of this amount 45,9% (R163,1 million) was for cases relating to money lent, 10,3% (R36,8 million) for cases relating to promissory notes, bills, R/D cheques, credit cards and other acknowledgements of debt and 9,8% (R34,8 million) for cases relating to goods sold on open account.

Default and consent judgements relate to judgements given in respect of undefended debt cases only.


## COMPARABILITY

The jurisdiction limit for civil cases handled by magistrate offices (R20 000 for liquid assets and R50 000 for non liquid assets) was increased to R100 000 as from 1 May 1995. A comparison with the period prior to May 1995 must thus be handled with circumspection.

Thousand



## SMALL CLAIMS COURTS

### NOTES

- Up to 30/9/95 small claims courts served as a forum for the adjudication of money claims of not more than R2 000 against individuals or firms. It is for use by the general public only and not for business enterprises.
- As from 1/10/95 the following actions are excluded from the jurisdiction of the small claims court:
  - Claims exceeding R3 000 in value.
  - Claims against the state.
  - Claims based on cession or the transfer of rights.
  - Claims for damages in respect of defamation, malicious prosecution, wrongful imprisonment, wrongful arrest, seduction and breach of promise to marry.
  - Claims for the dissolution of a marriage.
  - Claims concerning the validity of a will.
  - Claims concerning the status of a person in respect of his mental capacity.
  - Claims in which the performance in accordance with a contract is sought, without an alternative claim for payment of damages, except in the case of a claim for rendering an account or transferring movable or immovable property not exceeding R3 000 in value.

### COMPARABILITY

The information in respect of magistrates courts shown in this statistical release refers to debt cases only and is therefore not strictly comparable with the information shown for the small claims courts.

### CONCEPTS

"Courts" relate to the total number of small claims courts at the end of the months as indicated. "Litigants referred" relates to the number of persons (plaintiffs) referred to legal assistants by clerks of the small claims court.
