EMPLOYMENT IN THE FORMAL WHOLESALE, RETAIL AND MOTOR TRADE AND HOTELS SECTORS SHOWED A NET INCREASE OF 1,9% AT THE END OF DECEMBER 1997

Total employment in the formal commerce and hotels sectors increased by 1,9% or 14 560 employees to 784 186 between September 1997 and December 1997. Employment in these four sectors also showed a net annual increase of 1,0% or 8 009 employees comparing December 1997 with December 1996. This annual increase is slightly higher than the increase of 0,4% recorded between December 1995 and December 1996.

The overall quarterly increase presents countervailing tendencies. Employment in the retail and wholesale trade sectors for December 1997 increased by 3,8% or 15 500 employees and 0,4% or 800 employees respectively compared with September 1997. These sectors showed steady increases since the first quarter of 1997. However, employment in the motor trade and hotels sectors for December 1997 decreased by 1,4% or 1 600 employees and 0,3% or 140 employees respectively compared with September 1997.

The overall annual increase in employment in the formal wholesale, retail and motor trade and hotels sectors also presents countervailing tendencies. The retail trade sector recorded an annual increase of 2,1% or 8 600 employees for December 1997 compared with December 1996, followed by the

wholesale trade sector with an increase of 2,0% or

4 100 employees and the hotel sector with an increase of 0,9% or 409 employees, while employment in the motor trade sector for December 1997 decreased by 4,4% or 5 100 employees compared with December 1996.

Real average salaries and wages (at constant 1995 prices) in the formal commerce and hotels sectors during the fourth quarter of 1997 increased by 12,6% or R322 compared with the third quarter of 1997. This increase is mainly due to the annual bonuses paid in December of each year. The seasonally adjusted real average salaries and wages (at constant 1995 prices) increased by 0,7% between September 1997 and December 1997.

Total vacancies in the formal commerce and hotels sectors showed a decrease of 28,2% or 188 posts when the relevant information for December 1997 is compared with the information for December 1996.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. The data in respect of wholesale, retail and motor trade and hotels are estimates based on quarterly sample surveys. Data relating to the latest quarter are preliminary.

2. The data in respect of **agricultural marketing boards** are published in the statistical release P0251 - Employment and salaries and wages: Public sector, as from 1987, and are thus not included in this statistical release.

3. Since September 1993 the data of those establishments where personnel records do not allow identification of population groups, are shown as **unspecified**.

4. Data on the **former TBVC states** are included at the hotels sector as from March 1995. Information available to the CSS indicates that the total employment of the hotels sector in these states for March 1995 amounted to approximately 16,0% of the total employment for the total hotels sector.

In the case of the other sectors, data on the **former TBVC states** are included as from March 1996. Information available to the CSS indicates that the total employment of the trade sectors in these states amounted to approximately 0,1% of the total employment for the retail trade sector, 0,1% of the total employment for the wholesale trade sector, and 0,7% of the total employment for the motor trade sector.

5. The data do not include persons liable to military service.

6. EMPLOYMENT

6.1 Employment refers to the number of paid employees on the last pay-day of the quarter.

6.2 Full-time employees (permanent and temporary) refers to the number of employees who normally work 30 hours or more per week.

6.3 Part-time employees:

Workers in morning posts refer to the number of employees who normally work more than 20 hours but less than 30 hours per week.

Other part-time employees refer to the number of persons employed who normally work 20 hours or less per week.

6.4 The number of full-time and part-time employees are converted to full-time equivalent employees.

7. SALARIES AND WAGES AND BONUSES

Salaries and wages and bonuses refer to gross salaries and wages and bonuses for the quarter and include, inter alia, overtime payments, allowances, commission, fringe benefits paid in cash and employers' contributions to pension and other staff funds. Most wholesale and retail trade establishments pay annual and incentive bonuses during December.

8. AVERAGE MONTHLY SALARIES AND WAGES

8.1 The average salaries and wages and bonuses (at current prices) are calculated by dividing the salaries and wages and bonuses by the number of full-time equivalent employees.

8.2 The average salaries and wages and bonuses (at constant 1995 prices) are calculated by deflating the average salaries and wages and bonuses (at current prices) with the CPI for all expenditure groups (metropolitan).

9. VACANCIES

Vacancies refer to the number of additional persons that can be employed immediately on the last pay-day of the quarter.
