## **QES Background**

QES is an enterprise-based sample survey

QES collects information on employing businesses registered for VAT with annual turnover greater than R300 000

R300 000

Samples are drawn from private non-agricultural businesses e.g. factories, offices, stores as well as national, provincial and local government entities

Sample size of approximately 20 000 was selected


### **EMPLOYMENT RESULTS**

Number of persons employed in Q2:2021

9 566 000



There was a quarterly decrease of 86 000 jobs (or -0,9%) in the Q1:2021 compared with Q2:2021.



Jobs **increased** by 60 000 (or **0,6%)** in the reference quarter compared with the same quarter of 2020 (Q2:2020).








## **EMPLOYMENT RESULTS**

Number of persons employed Part-time: 991 000



Full-time jobs decreased quarter-onquarter by 27 000 and year-on-year full-time jobs decreased by 17 000.

Part-time jobs decreased quarteron-quarter by 59 000 and yearon-year part-time jobs increased by 77 000.

# The mining industry reported net increase of 2 000 jobs in the second quarter of 2021.

Year-on-year the industry increased by 9 000 when comparing Q2:2020 with Q2:2021.






## The trade industry reported no change in the second quarter of 2021 compared to Q1:2021.

Year-on-year the industry gained 45 000 jobs compared with same quarter of 2020.

Trade industry, Q3:2009 to Q2:2021










## The community services industry reported a net loss of 65 000 jobs in the second quarter compared to Q1:2021.

Year-on-year the industry increased by 62 000 jobs compared with same quarter of the previous year (i.e. Q2:2020).












# The total number of persons employed decreased from 9 652 000 in Q1:2021 to 9 566 000 in Q2:2021.

Number of employees time-series from Q3:2009 to Q2:2021












## Gross Earnings decreased by R0,1 billion to R715,1 billion in Q2:2021











Gross earnings decreased by **R0,1** billion (or **0,0%**) in the second quarter of 2021 compared to Q1:2021. Decreases in gross earnings were due to decreases in bonuses and overtime payments by **R7,4** billion while basic salaries/wages increased by **R7,3** billion.

Year-on-year gross earnings increased by **R70,4** billion (or **10,9%**). Increases was due to basic salary payments made by **R55,2** billion and bonus and overtime payments by **R15,1** billion.

QES Q2:2021

There was a quarterly decrease of **R0,1** billion in gross earnings in the second quarter of 2021 compared to Q1:2021. Year-on-year increase of **10,9%** in earnings was reported in the second quarter of 2021 compared with second quarter of the previous year.

Quarterly and annual percentage change in gross earnings paid in the reference quarter.










### Time series of gross earnings paid from Q3:2009 to Q2:2021

AME including bonuses and overtime payments increased in May 2021 to R23 526. This is a 1,7% change from R23 127 in February 2021. Year-on-year AME increased by 9,7%.








Seven out of eight industries reported increases in average monthly earnings in the second quarter compared with Q1:2021. Five industries increased above industry average of 1,7% quarter-on-quarter. Year-on-year the Construction industry reported an increase of 24,6% in AME while the Community industry grew the slowest by 4,3%.
