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PREFACE

This statistical release presents data on recorded live births based on information received from the Department of Home Affairs. The main reporting year for this release is 2005. However, reference is also made to the 1991 to 2004 data in order to provide information on trends and patterns in the occurrence and registration of live births.

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

Source of data

The Department of Home Affairs provides Statistics South Africa (Stats SA) with information on recorded live births. Two sets of birth statistics are provided: registration-based and occurrence-based data. These data come from the same source, namely, Nucleus Bureau. When the clerks at the various offices of the Department of Home Affairs capture the information about a birth, they do so directly onto the database at Nucleus Bureau. These transactions are used to update the population register database. A more detailed narrative on eligibility for inclusion in the population register is given below.

For the purpose of producing vital statistics, the following system is followed: everyday all the (civil) transactions carried out at all the Department of Home Affairs offices are written onto a cassette. At the end of every month, a combined set of cassettes is created containing all the transactions done for the month. These transactions are read and the birth transactions are extracted for processing at Stats SA. The year in which the births are registered is the registration or processing year. Using this information, Stats SA provides the breakdown of the registered births according to the year in which the births occurred.

While birth information sent to Stats SA is the same as that in the population register, there is a difference of format between the two. On one hand, Stats SA's data is based on births registered during the year (registration-based), while on the other hand, entries on the population register reflect the date of birth. The date of registration of birth is not stored on the population registration file. For this reason, the population register can only be used to obtain births data broken down by date of birth (occurrence-based).

By continuously updating the population register for late registration, the occurrence-based data from the population register gets closer and closer to the true level of births. In a situation where birth registrations are complete (with very few late registrations), the occurrence-based perspective (with births updated for late registrations) will be very similar to the registration-based perspective (with all registration births considered irrespective of year). However, if there is a large number of late registrations, the two perspectives will become widely dissimilar. With improvements in birth registration, the recorded data from the two sources will gradually converge.

South African population register

The South African population register deals with births, deaths, identity, marriages, divorces and movements of all South African citizens and permanent residents. Thus, each of the Acts dealing with any aspect of civil registration has implications for the information inputted onto the Population Register. The Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1992 (Act No. 51 of 1992) guides the registration of births and death throughout South Africa. The Act was subsequently amended in 1997 (Act No. 67 of 1997) and in 1998 (Act No. 43 of 1998). Another Act pertinent to the population register is the Identification Act (Act No. 68 of 1997). This Act repealed previous Identification Acts (Act No.72 of 1986, Act No. 21 of 1991, Act No. 4 of 1993 and Act No. 47 of 1995). From these various Acts and amendments, the following persons and particulars are eligible to be included on the population register:

- All children born of South African citizens and permanent residents when the notice of the birth is given within one year after the birth of the child.
- All children born of South African citizens and permanent residents when the notice of the birth is given one year after the birth of the child together with the prescribed requirement for a late registration of birth.

- All South African citizens and permanent residents who upon attainment of the age of 16, applied for and were granted identification cards.
- All South African citizens and permanent residents who die at any age after birth.
- All South African citizens and permanent residents who depart permanently from South Africa.

Persons whose particulars are not eligible for inclusion on the population register are listed below:

- Non-South African citizens who sojourn temporarily in the country.
- All South African citizens and permanent residents who died before notice of his/her birth had been given.

Municipal Demarcation

Prior to 1994, there were about 1 300 municipalities throughout South Africa. These were reduced to 843 following the 1995/1996 local government elections. Subsequently, the Municipal Demarcation Act, 1998 (Act No. 27 of 1998) established the Municipal Demarcation Board and charged it with the responsibility of determining new municipal boundaries for the country. In this report, we have included the municipalities in accordance with their magisterial districts.

Population group

As from 1991 no distinction is made between the different population groups on the data collected by the Department of Home Affairs. The statistics collected, therefore, refer to all population groups combined.

Definition of concepts used

- 1.1 **Live birth** – The complete expulsion or extraction from its mother's womb of a product of conception, irrespective of the duration of pregnancy, which, after such separation, breathes or shows any other evidence of life, such as beating of the heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord, or definite movement of voluntary muscles, whether or not the umbilical cord has been cut or the placenta is attached; each product of such a birth is considered live born.
- 1.2 **Recorded live births** – Recorded live births (birth registrations) indicate the number of births recorded (registered) in a specific year, irrespective of when the birth actually occurred. The births recorded in any given year include the births that occurred during that year plus other births that occurred in years prior to the year of registration. It should be noted that not all births are recorded (registered).
- 1.3 **Late registration** – Births occurring in a given calendar year but recorded in subsequent calendar years.
- 1.4 **Current live births** – Births occurring in a specific year and registered within that same year.
- 1.5 **Stillbirths** – The Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1992 (Act No. 51 of 1992) defines a stillbirth as intra-uterine death of a foetus of at least 26 weeks of gestation that showed no sign of life after complete birth. Prior to 1997, stillbirths were reported as a separate column but in the same release as live births. Stillbirths for 1997 and later years will now to be published in a separate statistical release.

KEY FINDINGS

1. Introduction

The Department of Home Affairs in South Africa is responsible for the registration of vital events, including the registration of live births. The registration of births is governed by the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1992, (Act No. 51 of 1992). The Department of Home Affairs uses form BI-24 to register births for persons aged below one year, form BI-24/1 for persons aged one year and older but less than 15 years, and form BI-24/15 for persons aged 15 years and older. Upon registration of a birth, a birth certificate is issued. Birth certificates serve as legal records of birth and identification. They also provide data that can be used to monitor fertility trends, population growth and population composition.

The main purpose of this statistical release is to present data on live births registered at the Department of Home Affairs in 2005. While the main reporting year is 2005, data for 1991 to 2004 are also presented to provide information on trends and patterns in the occurrence and registration of live births. The reporting of live births is divided into registration year (the year in which a birth was registered, regardless of when it occurred) and occurrence year (the year in which a birth actually occurred). The total number of registrations for any given year comprises both current registrations (for live births registered in the year in which they occurred) and late registrations (for live births registered later than the year of birth).

2. Total birth registrations and occurrences

Table 1 provides information on total birth registrations and occurrences for the period 1991 to 2005. Total birth registrations are all births registered at the Department of Home Affairs as at 28 February 2006. The end of February is used to make provision for 2005 births that were registered during the first two months of 2006. Total birth occurrences are all births occurring within a specific year and registered at the Department of Home Affairs by 28 February 2006. Updated birth occurrences refer to the number of live births as reflected in the population register as at 29 April 2006.

Table 1 shows that 1 380 496 live births were registered in 2005. This number includes live births that occurred in 2005, as well as those that occurred in the previous years but registered in 2005. The number of births that occurred in 2005 were 793 788 as at 28 February 2006. The population register indicated that, as at 29 April 2006, there were 848 043 live births that occurred in 2005. This indicates that between 28 February 2006 and 29 April 2006, the population register was updated by 54 255 births that occurred in 2005. The figures of birth occurrences vary each time data are extracted from the population register as they get updated continuously.

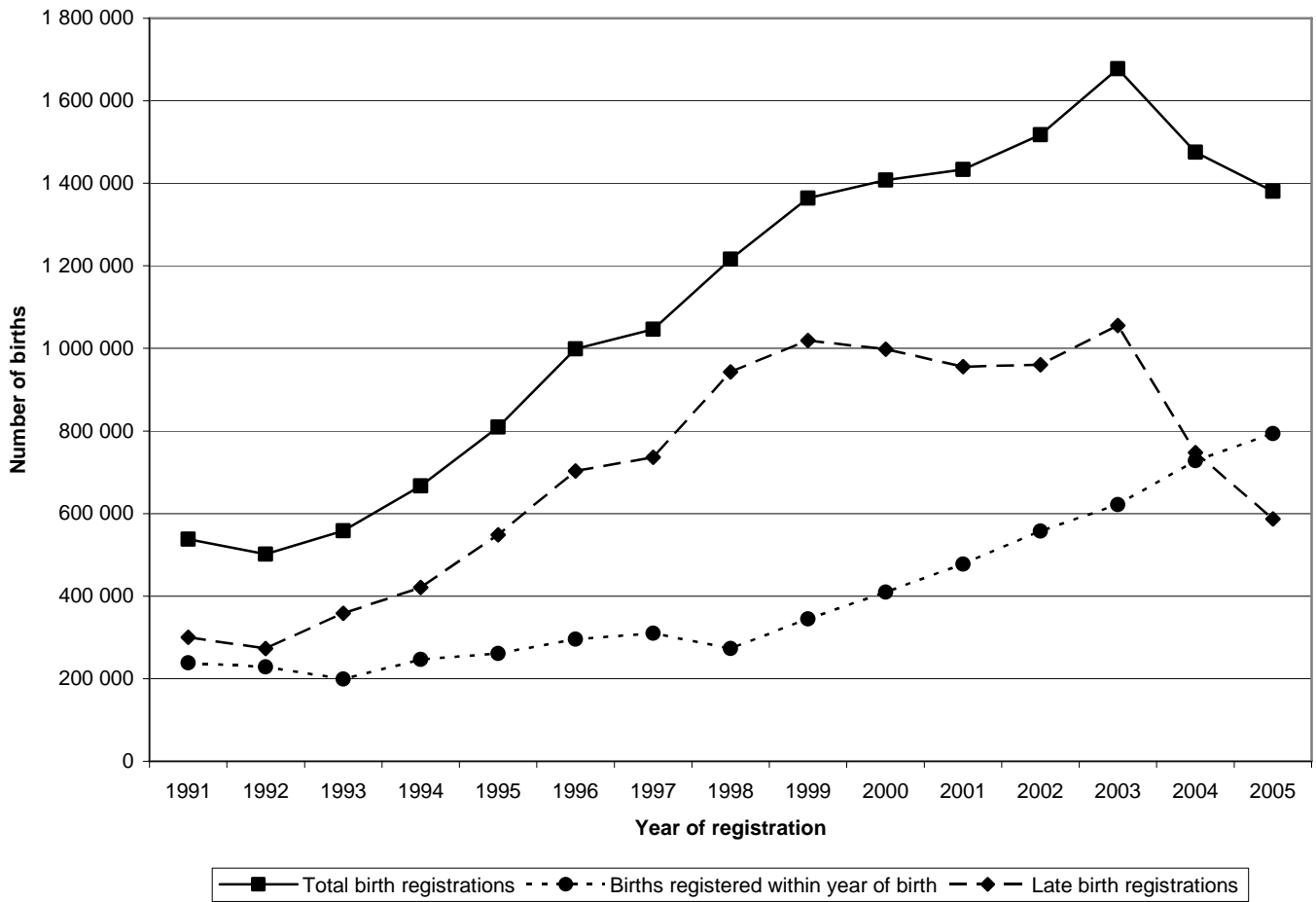
2.1 Registration-based reporting

The total number of live births registered in 2005 was 1 380 496. This represents a decrease of 6,5% from a total of 1 475 809 births registered in 2004. Figure 1 provides information on total birth registrations, births registered within the year of birth and late birth registrations from 1991 to 2005. It is observed that for the total birth registrations, the number of birth registrations increased between 1992 and 2003, after which there was a decline. The decline in total birth registrations results from a decline in late birth registrations.

The number of births registered later than the year of birth is observed to have increased since 1992, reaching a peak in 2003. After 2003, there was a sharp decrease in the number of births registered late. However, the number of births registered within the year of birth has increased consistently since 1998.

From 1991 to 2004, the number of late birth registrations was higher than the number of births registered within the year of birth but this pattern is reversed in 2005. The proportion of births registered within the year of birth increased consistently from 1998, particularly from 2003 where the proportion of births registered within the year of birth increased from 37,1% in 2003 to 49,3% in 2004 and to 57,5% in 2005.

Figure 1: Total birth registrations, 1991–2005

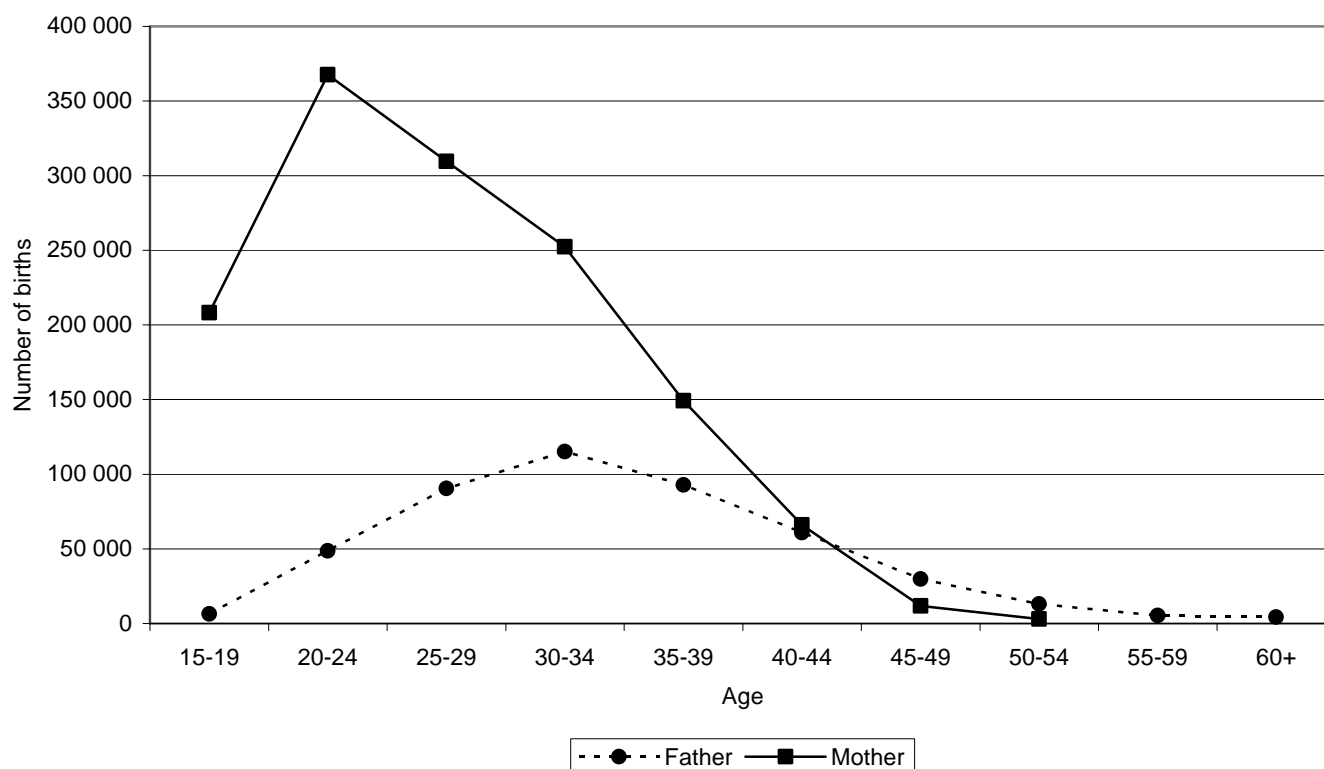


2.1.1 Birth registrations by age of parents

Figure 2 indicates total birth registrations by age of mother and age of father (excluding other and unspecified age). The data based on the age of father need to be treated with caution as about two thirds (66,2%) of the births did not have information about the father’s age. For the mothers, the highest number of births was registered among those aged 20-24, followed by those aged 25-29, 30-34 and 15-19. There was a rapid decrease in the number of registered births from age group 30-34. The median age of mothers for the registered births (excluding other and unspecified categories) was 26 years.

Among the fathers, those aged 30-34 had the highest number of registered births. There appears to be a noticeable number of registered births among older fathers (from age group 45–49). The median age of fathers for the registered births (excluding other and unspecified categories) was 33 years.

Considering the ages of both parents, it is observed in Table 2 that the highest number of births registered in 2005 were linked to couples where mothers were aged 25–29 years and fathers aged 30–34 years (48 223). Registered live births were also high among couples where mothers were aged 30–34 years and fathers were aged 35–39 years (40 382 births), as well as couples where mothers were aged 20–24 years and fathers aged 25–29 years (40 163).

2.1.2 Birth registrations by registration status

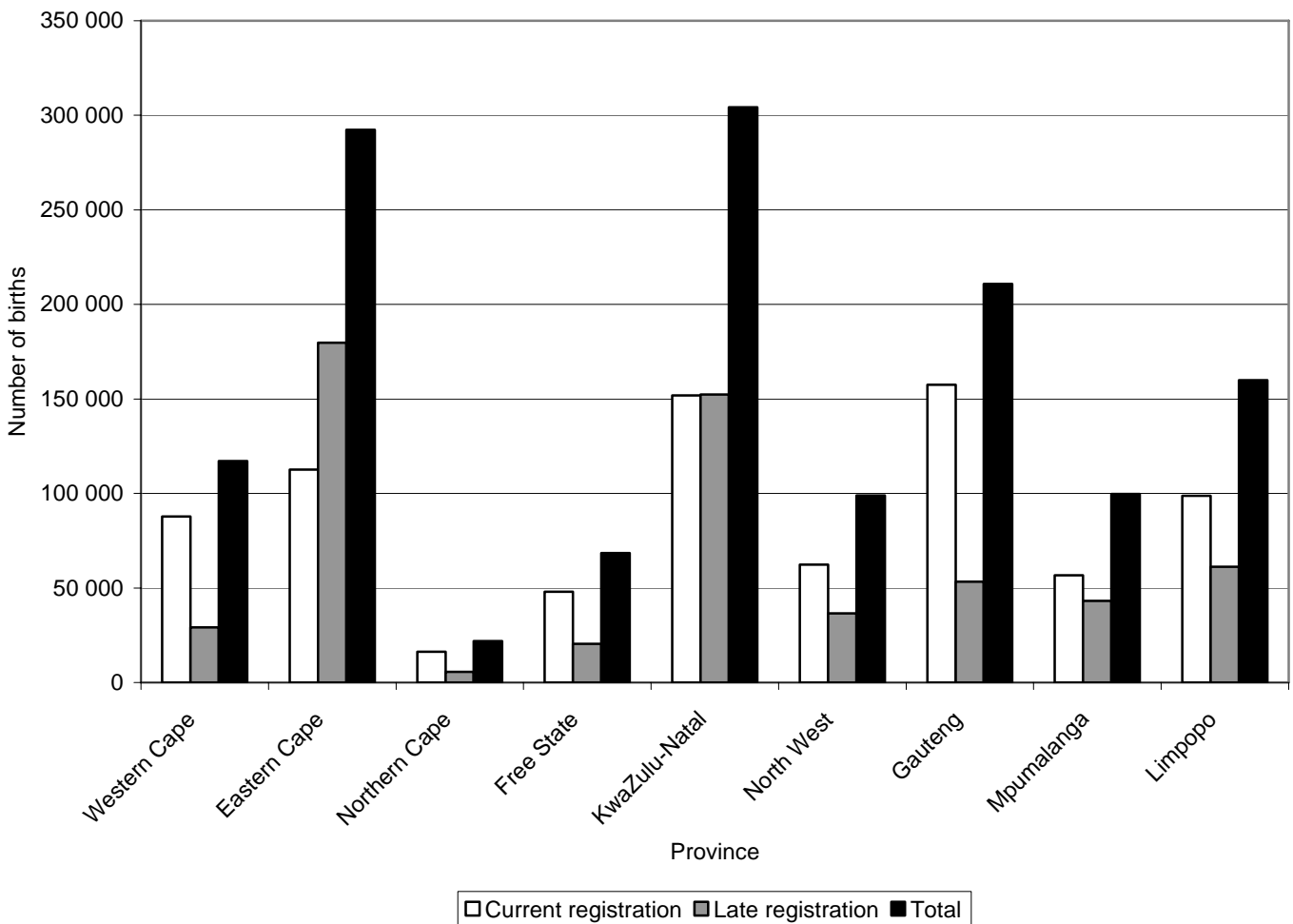
Total birth registrations are composed of birth registrations that are recorded on time (current registrations) as well as those recorded late (late registrations). Of all the births registered in 2005 (1 380 496), 793 788 (57,5%) were current registrations. Registration status in this release is reported by the following variables: province, sex and age of mother.

Province

The distribution of all births registered in 2005 by province and status of registration is presented in Figure 3. KwaZulu-Natal and Eastern Cape had the highest number of total births registered in 2005. There were 304 206 births registered in KwaZulu-Natal (representing 22,0% of all births) and 292 414 births registered in Eastern Cape (representing 21,2%). The lowest number of births registered in 2005 was observed in Northern Cape (21 891, representing 1,6%).

The provinces with the highest number of birth registrations also had the highest percentages of late registrations (61,5% in Eastern Cape and 50,1% in KwaZulu-Natal). However, in Western Cape, Gauteng, Northern Cape and Free State, less than 30% of birth registrations in 2005 were registered late. Detailed information on total registrations by year of registration and status of registration, province and municipality is provided in Appendix A.

Figure 3: Birth registrations by province and status of registration, 2005



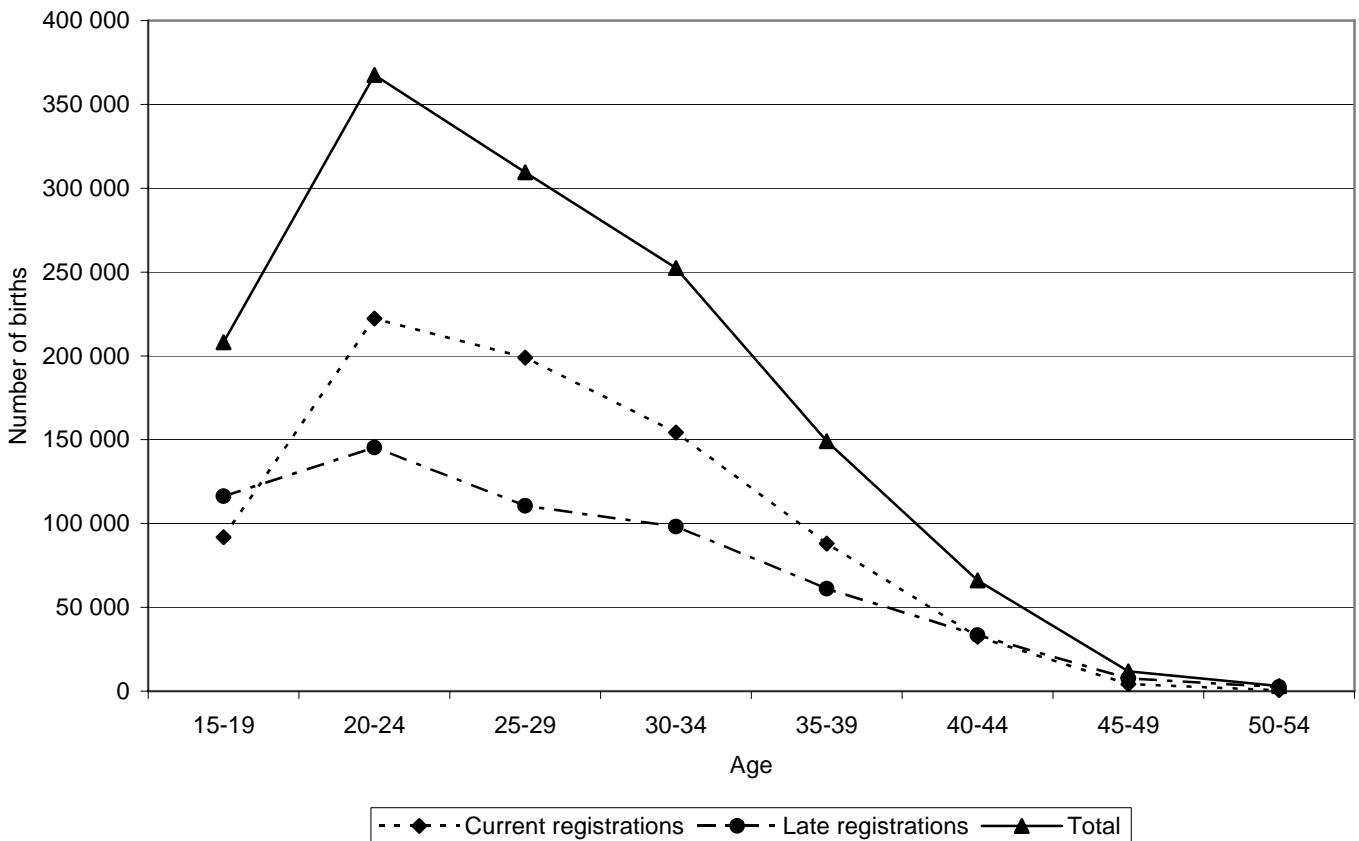
Sex

The distribution of total birth registrations in 2005 by sex indicates that there were slightly more males registered (694 966) than females (685 530), yielding a sex ratio of 101 males per 100 female births registered. The percentage distribution of birth registrations by status of registration and sex did not show any differences when taking into account the total birth registrations in the country and for each province. Detailed information on total registrations by sex, status of registration, province and municipality is provided in Appendix B.

Age of mother

There are some differences observed by the age of mother and whether registration of the child was on time or late (excluding other and unspecified categories). Figure 4 shows that the majority of births occurring to younger mothers (aged less than 20 years) and older mothers (aged 40 and above) were registered late while births to mothers aged 20–24 up to 35–39 were mostly registered on time.

2.2 Occurrence-based reporting

The information on occurrence-based reporting is presented in two sections. The first section provides information on the number of registered births that occurred from 1991 to 2005 as at end of February 2006. This information is received electronically from the Department of Home Affairs. The end of February is the close-off date for processing by Stats SA. The second section reports on the registered births as reflected in the population register as at end of April 2006. This information is provided as a printout from the Department of Home Affairs.

2.2.1 Birth occurrences as at 28 February 2006

Table 3 shows the number of births that occurred during the period 1991 to 2005 by year of birth. The occurrences of births for different years are composed of births registered within the year in which they were born and those registered late. The figures in bold indicate all births that were registered within the year in which they occurred while those not bolded are late registrations, showing when the births for a particular year were eventually registered. For example, in 2004, there were 728 283 (in bold) births that occurred in 2004 and were registered within the same year and 150 546 births that occurred in 2004 but were registered in 2005. Both these give a total of 878 829 births that occurred in 2004 (regardless of when they were registered).

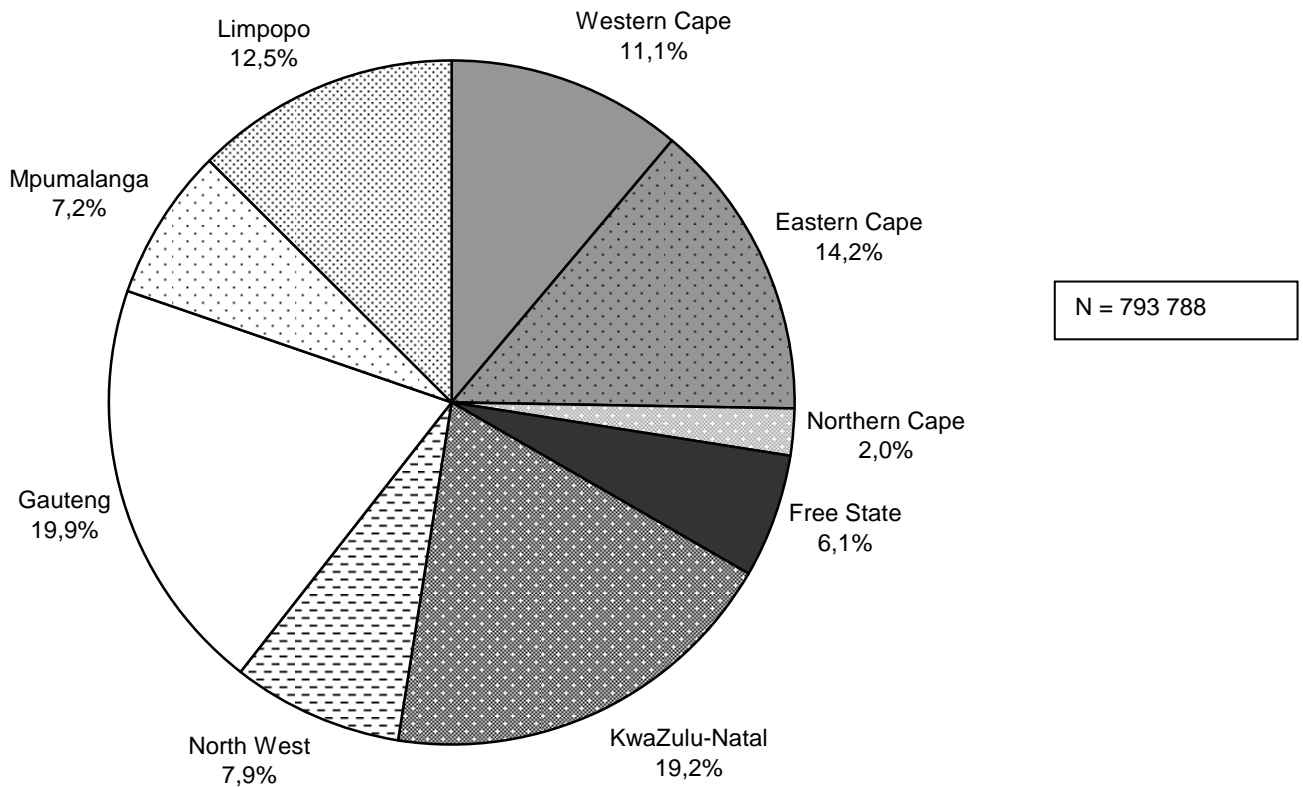

The number of births was more or less constant at between 850 000 and 890 000 births, increased to over 900 000 births between 1996 and 1997. There was a small decrease in the number of birth occurrences between 1999 and 2003, after which there was a small increase and a decrease in 2004 and 2005, respectively. Information pertaining to births registered within year of birth indicates that, since 1993, with the exception of 1998, there was an increase in the number of births registered within the year of birth. In 2005, there were 793 788 birth occurrences, indicating an increase of 9,0% from the 728 283 births occurring and registered in 2004.

The number of births that occurred in 2005, classified by province, is given in Figure 5. The highest number of births was observed in Gauteng and KwaZulu-Natal, where one out of five births (20%) occurred in this province. The lowest number of births occurred in the Northern Cape (2%) and Free State (6%).

2.2.2 Birth occurrences as at 29 April 2006

The updated overall birth occurrences as at 29 April 2006 for the period 1991 to 2005 were provided in Table 1. It should be noted that the figures from the population register varies each time data are extracted. This sub-section provides birth occurrences by citizenship and by month of births as reflected in the population register on 29 April 2006.

Citizenship

Table 4 provides a breakdown of birth occurrences by year of birth, sex and citizenship for the period 1991 to 2005. It is observed that the total number of birth occurrences fluctuated between 840 000 and 930 000 during this period. Furthermore, the number of male and female births was roughly the same for all years, although there were slightly more male births from 2000 to 2005. The majority of the birth occurrences were for South African citizens.

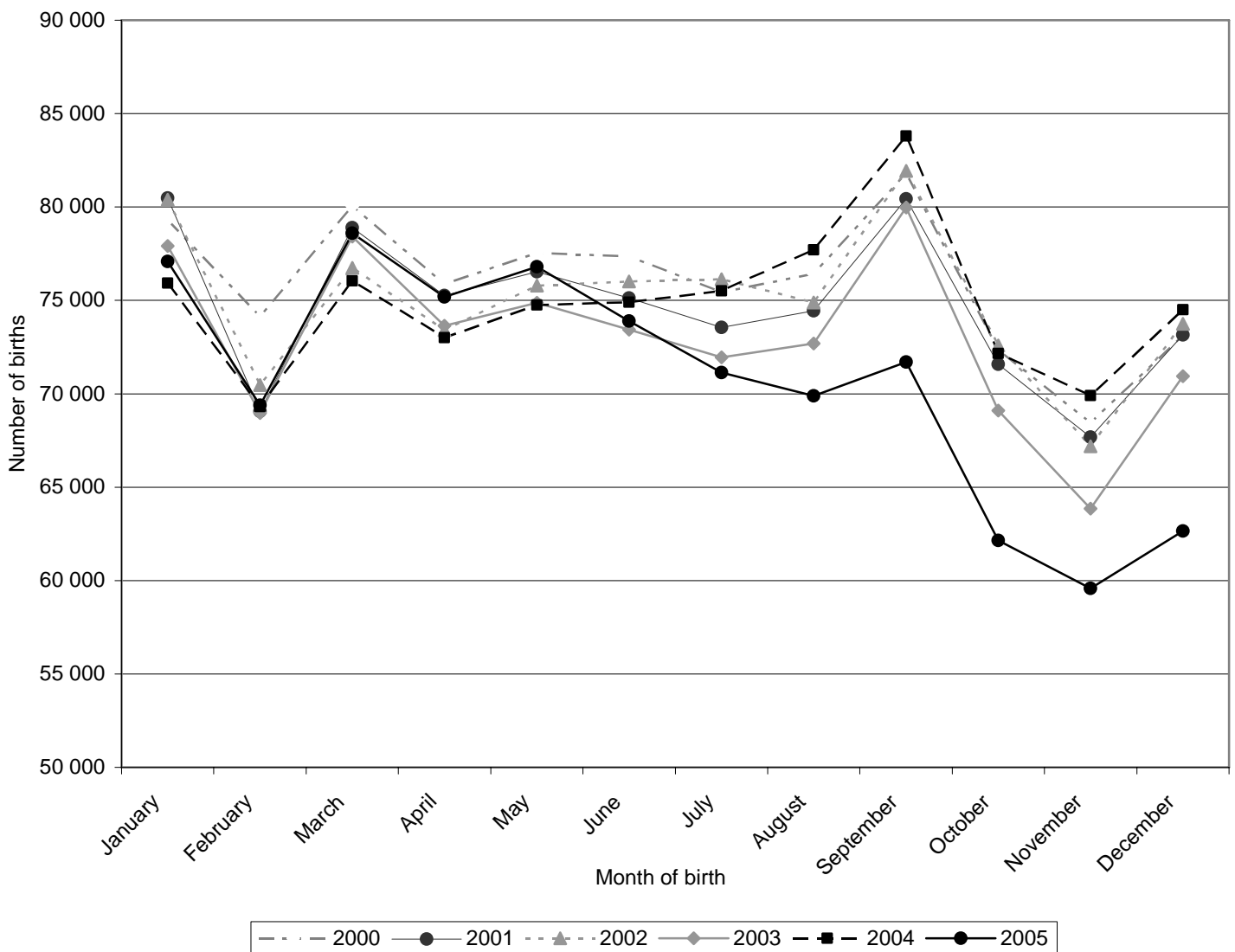

Month of birth

Birth occurrences from information on the population register as at end of April 2006 for births that occurred from 2000 to 2005, classified by month of birth, is provided in Figure 6. The distribution of births by the month in which the birth occurred shows that for most years, the highest number of births occurred in September. The other common months of birth occurrence were January and March. This pattern is consistent for the period 2000 to 2003. In 2004, the most common months (from highest) were September, August and March while in 2005 they were March, January and May. February and November were the least common months for birth occurrences. Detailed information from 1991 to 2005 by month of birth, sex and citizenship is given in Appendix C.

3. Concluding remarks

This statistical release reported on the number of births registered and occurring in South Africa over the period 1991 to 2005. In 2005, total birth registrations were lower than the figures recorded in 2004. However, there has been an increase in the number of births registered within the year of births.

Out of a total of 1 380 496 births registered in 2005, 793 788 (57,5%) were born in 2005. The highest number of births registered in 2005 was in KwaZulu-Natal and Eastern Cape. However, these provinces also had the highest percentage of late registrations. Birth registrations were higher among women aged 20–24, with late registration being more prevalent among younger (less than 20) and older (40 and above) mothers.
