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**Preface**

This statistical release presents information on recorded live births based on data from the national birth registration system at the Department of Home Affairs. The release reports on birth registrations and occurrences for 2006, and also provides information on trends and patterns of recorded live births from 1991.

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## Explanatory notes

### Source of data

The Department of Home Affairs (DHA) provides Statistics South Africa (Stats SA) with information on recorded live births. Two sets of birth statistics are provided: registration-based and occurrence-based data. These data sets both come from the Nucleus Bureau of the DHA. When the clerks at the various offices of the Department of Home Affairs capture the information about a birth, they do so directly onto the database at Nucleus Bureau. These transactions are used to update the population register database. A more detailed narrative on eligibility for inclusion in the population register is given below.

For the purpose of producing vital statistics, the following system is followed: everyday all the (civil) transactions carried out at all the Department of Home Affairs offices are written onto a cassette. At the end of every month, a combined set of cassettes is created containing all the transactions done for the month. These transactions are read and the birth transactions are extracted for processing at Stats SA. The year in which the births are registered is the registration year. Using this information, Stats SA provides the breakdown of the registered births according to the year in which the births occurred.

While birth information sent to Stats SA is the same as that in the population register, there is a difference of format between the two. On one hand, Stats SA's data is based on births registered during the year (registration-based), while on the other hand, entries in the population register reflect the date of birth. The date of registration of birth is not stored on the population registration file. For this reason, the population register can only be used to obtain births data broken down by date of birth (occurrence-based).

By continuously updating the population register for late registration, the occurrence-based data from the population register gets closer and closer to the true level of births. In a situation where birth registrations are complete (with very few late registrations), the occurrence-based perspective (with births updated for late registrations) will be very similar to the registration-based perspective (with all registration births considered irrespective of year). However, if there is a large number of late registrations, the two perspectives will become widely dissimilar. With improvements in birth registration, the recorded data from the two sources will gradually converge.

### South African population register

The South African population register deals with births, deaths, identity, marriages, divorces and movements of all South African citizens and permanent residents. Thus, each of the Acts dealing with any aspect of civil registration has implications for the information inputted into the Population Register. The Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1992 (Act No. 51 of 1992) guides the registration of births and deaths throughout South Africa. The Act was subsequently amended in 1997 (Act No. 67 of 1997) and in 1998 (Act No. 43 of 1998). Another Act pertinent to the population register is the Identification Act 1997 (Act No. 68 of 1997). This Act repealed previous Identification Acts (Act No.72 of 1986, Act No. 21 of 1991, Act No. 4 of 1993 and Act No. 47 of 1995). From these Acts and amendments, the following persons and particulars are eligible to be included on the population register:

- All children born of South African citizens and permanent residents when the notice of the birth is given within one year after the birth of the child.
- All children born of South African citizens and permanent residents when the notice of the birth is given one year after the birth of the child together with the prescribed requirement for a late registration of birth.
- All South African citizens and permanent residents who upon attainment of the age of 16, applied for and were granted identification cards.
- All South African citizens and permanent residents who die at any age after birth.
- All South African citizens and permanent residents who depart permanently from South Africa.

Persons whose particulars are not eligible for inclusion on the population register are listed below:

- Non-South African citizens who sojourn temporarily in the country.
- All South African citizens and permanent residents who died before notice of their birth had been given.

## Municipal demarcation

Prior to 1994, there were about 1 300 municipalities throughout South Africa. These were reduced to 843 following the 1995/1996 local government elections. Subsequently, the Municipal Demarcation Act, 1998 (Act No. 27 of 1998) established the Municipal Demarcation Board and charged it with the responsibility of determining new municipal boundaries for the country. In this report, we have included the municipalities in accordance with their magisterial districts and updated the changes in municipal boundaries.

## Population group

As from 1991, no distinction is made between the different population groups on the data collected by the Department of Home Affairs. The statistics collected, therefore, refer to all population groups combined.

## Definition of concepts used

**1.1 Live birth** – The complete expulsion or extraction from its mother's womb of a product of conception, irrespective of the duration of pregnancy, which, after such separation, breathes or shows any other evidence of life, such as beating of the heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord, or definite movement of voluntary muscles, whether or not the umbilical cord has been cut or the placenta is attached; each product of such a birth is considered live born.

**1.2 Recorded live births** – Recorded live births (birth registrations) indicate the number of births recorded (registered) in a specific year, irrespective of when the birth actually occurred. The births recorded in any given year include the births that occurred during that year plus other births that occurred in years prior to the year of registration. It should be noted that not all births are recorded (registered).

**1.3 Late registration** – Births occurring in a given calendar year but recorded in subsequent calendar years.

**1.4 Current live births** – Births occurring in a specific year and registered within that same year.

**1.5 Stillbirths** – The Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1992 (Act No. 51 of 1992) defines a stillbirth as intra-uterine death of a foetus of at least 26 weeks of gestation that showed no sign of life after complete birth. Prior to 1997, stillbirths were reported as a separate column but in the same release as live births. Stillbirths for 1997 and later years will now to be published in a separate statistical release.

## Key findings

### 1. Introduction

The Department of Home Affairs in South Africa is responsible for the registration of vital events, including the registration of live births. The registration of births is governed by the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1992 (Act No. 51 of 1992). The Department of Home Affairs uses form BI-24 to register births for persons aged below one year, form BI-24/1 for persons aged one year and older but less than 15 years, and form BI-24/15 for persons aged 15 years and older.

"Birth registration is the official recording of the birth of a child by some administrative level of the state and coordinated by a particular branch of government. It is a permanent and official record of a child's existence" (UNICEF, 2002; 2). Subsequent to birth registration, birth certificates, which serve as legal records of birth and identification, are issued. The data they provide can be used to monitor fertility trends, population growth and population composition. Such information is essential for the planning of governments' economic and social development policies. Furthermore, in South Africa, having a birth certificate is necessary as it is a document that provides poor children with access to social security and poverty alleviation programmes.

The main purpose of this statistical release is to present data on live births registered at the Department of Home Affairs in 2006. Data for 1991 to 2005 are also presented to provide information on trends and patterns in the occurrence and registration of live births. The reporting of live births is divided into registration year (the year in which a birth was registered, regardless of when it occurred) and occurrence year (the year in which a birth actually occurred).

### 2. Birth registrations

#### 2.1 Trends in birth registration


Total birth registrations are all births registered at the Department of Home Affairs during a specific year, regardless of when they occurred. For any given year, total number of registrations comprises both current registrations (for live births registered in the year in which they occurred) and late registrations (for live births registered later than the year of birth). Table 1 provides information on birth registrations for the period 1991 to 2006, classified by status of registration.

It is observed that a total of 1 346 119 births were registered in 2006, representing a decrease of 2,5% from 1 380 496 births registered in 2005. Of all the births that were registered in 2006, 36,1% were late registrations. From 2005, less than half of the births registered within a specific year were late registrations, as opposed to over three quarters of late registrations in 1998. It is important to note that the percentage of late birth registrations has decreased consistently since 1998.

Figure 1 shows that the total number of birth registrations increased between 1992 and 2003, after which there was a decline. The decline in total birth registrations resulted from a decline in late birth registrations. The number of late birth registrations is observed to have increased since 1992. This number reached a peak in 2003, after which there was a sharp decrease. However, the number of births registered within the year of birth has increased consistently since 1998. From 1991 to 2004, the number of late birth registrations was higher than the number of current registrations. This pattern was reversed in 2005, when most births were registered during the year of birth rather than later.

## 2.2 Birth registrations by selected variables

### Age of parents


The Notice of Birth form (BI-24) makes provision for inclusion of the details of the natural father and natural mother of a child. However, 68,2% of the births registered in 2006 did not contain information on fathers. As such, only information pertaining to the mothers will be reported on in this section.

Table 2 and Figure 2 show the distribution of births registered in 2006 by age of mother and status of registration. The highest number of births was registered among mothers aged 20–24 (28,2% of all births registered), followed by those aged 25–29 (22,3%) and then 30–34 (17,7%). About 15% (14,9%) of registered births were among mothers aged 15–19 and 5,4% for mothers aged 40 years and above.

Most of the births occurring to younger mothers (aged less than 20 years) and older mothers (aged 45 and above) were registered late while births to mothers aged 20–24 up to 35–39 were mostly registered within the year of birth. For example, 72,0% of births to mothers aged 25–29 were registered within the year of birth as compared to 20,4% for those aged 50–54.

**Figure 2: Birth registrations by age of mother and status of registration, 2006\***



### Province of birth

The distribution of all births registered in 2006 by province and status of registration is presented in Figure 3. KwaZulu-Natal and Eastern Cape had the highest numbers of total births registered in 2006. There were 341 779 births registered in KwaZulu-Natal (representing 25,4% of all births) and 228 015 births registered in Eastern Cape (representing 16,9%). The lowest number of births registered in 2005 was observed in Northern Cape (27 023, representing 2,0%).

Foreign births (0,5%) represent the registered births that occurred outside the country, where at least one of the parents was a South African citizen at the time of the child's birth. The birth may be notified at the South African Embassy or Mission in the country concerned or at the Department of Home Affairs in South Africa.

The provinces with the highest numbers of birth registrations also had the highest percentages of late registrations (48,3% in Eastern Cape and 47,4% in KwaZulu-Natal). In five provinces (Western Cape, Gauteng, Northern Cape, Free State and Limpopo), less than 30% of birth registrations in 2006 were late registrations. Detailed information on total registrations by year of registration and status of registration, province and municipality is provided in Appendix A.

### Sex of child

The distribution of total birth registrations in 2006 by sex indicates that there were slightly more males registered (675 423) than females (670 696), yielding a sex ratio of 101 males per 100 female births registered. The percentage distribution of birth registrations by status of registration and sex did not show any differences when taking into account the total birth registrations in the country and for each province. Detailed information on total registrations by sex, status of registration, province and municipality is provided in Appendix B.

### 3. Birth occurrences

Birth occurrences are all births occurring within a specific year and registered at the Department of Home Affairs. They pertain to the year in which the birth actually occurred (year of birth). Therefore, each time a birth for any particular year is registered; birth occurrences for that specific year are updated to include those registered late. That is, information on birth occurrences varies each time data are extracted from the population register since they get updated continuously.

This section reports on birth occurrence as extracted from the population register as at 28 February (this being the cut-off date for processing by Stats SA) 2007 and as at 30 April 2007 (to provide updated information). The end of February information is received electronically from the Department of Home Affairs and the end of April information is provided as a printout from the same department.

Total birth occurrences for the period 1991 to 2006 are provided in Table 3. It is observed that by 28 February 2007, 860 263 births that occurred in 2006 were registered, increasing to 911 350 births by 30 April 2007. This indicates that between 28 February 2007 and 30 April 2007, the population register was updated by 51 087 births (5,9% increase) that occurred in 2006. For each year, birth occurrences increased between these two months, indicating a continuous update of the register.

### 3.1 Birth occurrences as at 28 February 2007

Table 4 shows the number of births that occurred during the period 1991 to 2006 by year of birth and year of registration. The birth occurrences for different years are composed of births registered within the year in which they occurred and those registered late. The figures in bold indicate all births that were registered within the year in which they occurred while those not in bold are late registrations, showing when the births for a particular year were eventually registered.

The overall number of birth occurrences between 1991 and 2006 fluctuated, with an average of about 900 000 births occurring per year. During this period, the lowest number of births were those that occurred in 2006 (860 263 births) and the highest those that occurred in 2005 (948 119 births). Between 2005 and 2006, birth occurrences decreased by 9,3%.

From 1998, the number of births that got registered during the year of birth increased consistently. In 2006, there were 860 263 birth occurrences, indicating an increase of 8,4% from the 793 788 births that had occurred and were registered in 2005. The highest percentage increase, from year to year, in births registered within the year of birth was observed between 1998 and 1999 (26,2%) and between 1993 and 1994 (23,5%).



## Province

The distribution of births that occurred in 2006, classified by province, is given in Figure 4. The highest percentages of births occurred in Gauteng and KwaZulu-Natal, where about one out of five births (19,7% and 20,9%, respectively) occurred in these provinces. The lowest proportions of births occurred in the Northern Cape (2,4%) and Free State (5,8%). Less than 1% of registered births took place outside South Africa.

## 3.2 Birth occurrences as at 30 April 2007

This sub-section provides birth occurrences by sex, citizenship and by month of birth as reflected in the population register on 30 April 2007. It should be noted that the figures from the population register vary each time data are extracted. Therefore, the magnitude of change in the number of births between any two periods of extraction will depend on the number of late birth registrations for each year.

The total number of births per year shown in Table 5 indicates that birth occurrences fluctuated between 900 000 and 960 000 births (per year) over the period 1991–2006. The highest number of birth occurrences was in 2005 (960 411 births) and the lowest in 1991 (907 436 births).

### Sex

The overall number of births provided in Table 4 shows that for all the years, except in 1992, there were slightly more male births than female births. In 2006, there were 457 826 male births compared to 453 524 female births, yielding a sex ratio of 101 male births for every 100 female births.

### Citizenship

The majority of birth occurrences for all years were for South African citizens, comprising over 99% of all births.



### Month of birth

Figure 5 shows birth occurrences from 2000 to 2006, classified by month of birth. For most years, the highest number of births occurred in September. November and February were the least common months for birth occurrences. Detailed information of birth occurrences from 1991 to 2006 by month of birth, sex and citizenship is given in Appendix C.

#### 4. Concluding remarks

This statistical release has highlighted the number of births registered and occurring in South Africa over the period 1991 to 2006. There has been a decline in total birth registrations and occurrences between 2005 and 2006. The number of births registered within the year of birth has increased during this period while late birth registrations have decreased. Most birth registrations in 2006 were recorded in KwaZulu-Natal and Eastern Cape, although these provinces also had the highest percentage of late registrations. Furthermore, most birth occurrences took place in KwaZulu-Natal and Gauteng.

There has been an improvement in the registration of births as observed in the increase in the number of births registered within the year of birth. However, there is still a need to increase efforts aimed at increasing birth registration in the country, particularly in provinces such as KwaZulu-Natal and Eastern Cape where late registration of births is still high. Furthermore, details of fathers were missing in the majority of cases. Therefore, completeness of information upon registering a birth has to be ensured.
