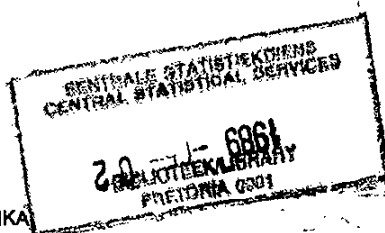

SUMMARY

The net result of immigration and emigration shows a gain of 363 persons for February 1989 compared with a gain of 427 persons for February 1988.

Foreign visitors who arrived in the RSA during January to February 1989 increased by 16,8% compared with the same period of 1988. During February 1989, 76 024 foreign visitors arrived in the RSA. During February 1989, 45,3% of the foreign visitors were resident in Europe, 15,6% in other overseas countries, while 39,1% were resident in Africa. Of the 34 441 visitors from Europe, 43,2% were resident in the United Kingdom and 22,9% in West Germany, while 67,0% of the visitors from the Americas were resident in the USA.

The majority of visitors from a single country during February 1989 were from the United Kingdom, namely 19,6% of the total, followed by 17,5% from Zimbabwe, 10,4% from West Germany and 4,3% from the USA.

During February 1989, 60,3% of the South African residents who went abroad were on holiday, while 38,5% went for business and 1,2% for study visits.

OPSOMMING

Die netto resultaat van immigrasie en emigrasie toon 'n wins van 363 persone vir Februarie 1989 teenoor 'n wins van 427 persone vir Februarie 1988.

Vreemde besoekers wat in die RSA aangekom het, het gedurende Januarie tot Februarie 1989 met 16,8% toegeneem teenoor dieselfde tydperk van 1988. Gedurende Februarie 1989 het 76 024 vreemde besoekers in die RSA aangekom. Gedurende Februarie 1989 was 45,3% van die vreemde besoekers woonagtig in Europa, 15,6% in ander oorsese lande, terwyl 39,1% in Afrika woonagtig was. Van die 34 441 besoekers uit Europa was 43,2% woonagtig in die Verenigde Koninkryk en 22,9% in Wes-Duitsland, terwyl 67,0% van die besoekers uit die Amerikas in die VSA woonagtig was.

Die meeste besoekers uit 'n enkele land gedurende Februarie 1989 was uit die Verenigde Koninkryk, naamlik 19,6% van die totaal, gevolg deur 17,5% uit Zimbabwe, 10,4% uit Wes-Duitsland en 4,3% uit die VSA.

Gedurende Februarie 1989 het 60,3% van die Suid-Afrikaanse inwoners wat na die buiteland vertrek het, met vakansie gegaan, terwyl 38,5% vir besigheids- en 1,2% vir studiebesoeke gegaan het.

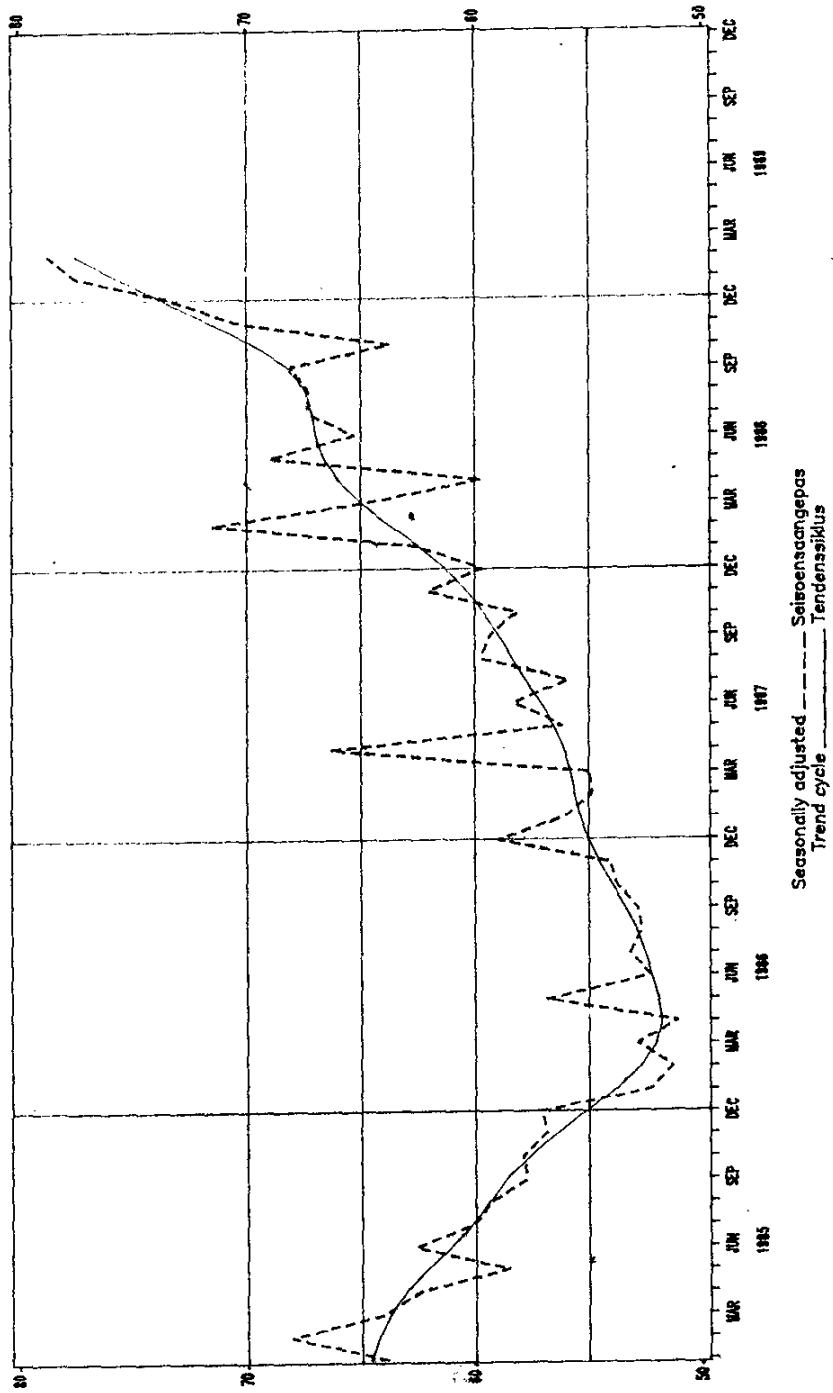

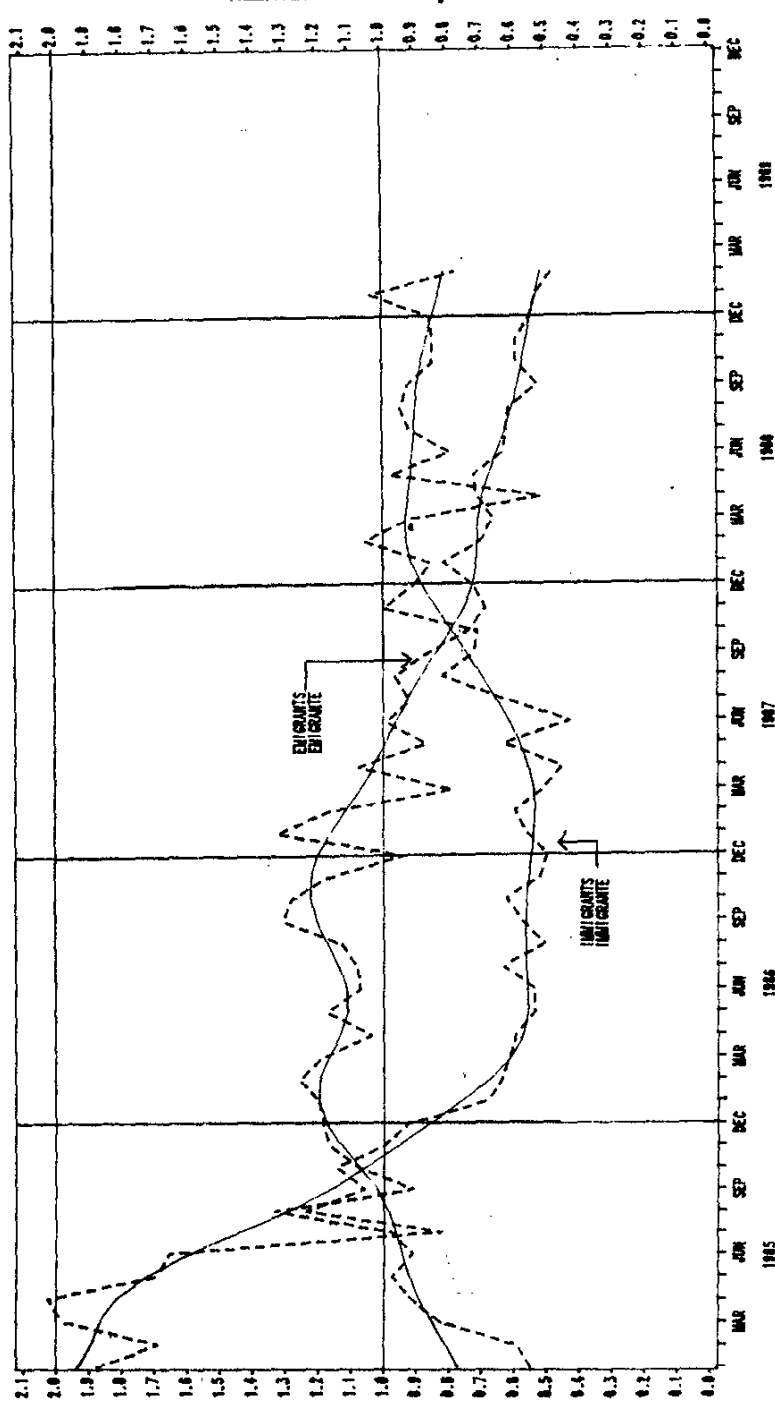
