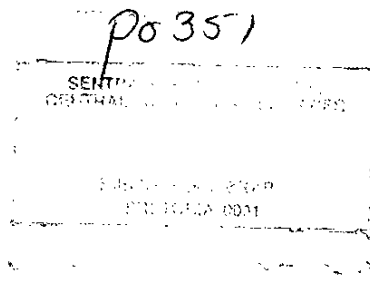

## SUMMARY

The net result of immigration and emigration shows a gain of 452 persons for March 1989 compared with a gain of 200 persons for March 1988.

The net gain of professional, semi-professional and technical occupations was 33 persons during the period January to March 1989, compared with a loss of 11 persons during the same period in 1988.

Foreign visitors who arrived in the RSA during January to March 1989 increased by 14,9% compared with the same period of 1988. During March 1989, 42,1% of the foreign visitors were resident in Europe, 14,1% in other overseas countries, while 43,8% were resident in Africa. Of the 31 390 visitors from Europe, 43,7% were resident in the United Kingdom and 24,2% in West Germany, while 71,4% of the visitors from the Americas were resident in the USA.

The most visitors from a single country during March 1989 were from the United Kingdom, namely 18,4% of the total, followed by 17,5% from Zimbabwe, 10,2% from West Germany and 4,6% from the USA.

During March 1989, 73,8% of the South African residents who went abroad were on holiday, while 25,6% went for business and 0,6% for study visits.

## OPSOMMING

Die netto resultaat van immigrasie en emigrasie toon 'n wins van 452 persone vir Maart 1989 teenoor 'n wins van 200 persone vir Maart 1988.

Die netto wins aan professionele, semi-professionele en tegniese beroepe was 33 persone gedurende die tydperk Januarie tot Maart 1989, teenoor 'n verlies van 11 persone gedurende dieselfde tydperk in 1988.

Vreemde besoekers wat in die RSA aangekom het, het gedurende Januarie tot Maart 1989 met 14,9% toegeneem teenoor dieselfde tydperk van 1988. Gedurende Maart 1989 was 42,1% van die vreemde besoekers woonagtig in Europa, 14,1% in ander oorsese lande, terwyl 43,8% in Afrika woonagtig was. Van die 31 390 besoekers uit Europa was 43,7% woonagtig in die Verenigde Koninkryk en 24,2% in Wes-Duitsland, terwyl 71,4% van die besoekers uit die Amerikas in die VSA woonagtig was.

Die meeste besoekers uit 'n enkele land gedurende Maart 1989 was uit die Verenigde Koninkryk, naamlik 18,4% van die totaal, gevolg deur 17,5% uit Zimbabwe, 10,2% uit Wes-Duitsland en 4,6% uit die VSA.

Gedurende Maart 1989 het 73,8% van die Suid-Afrikaanse inwoners wat na die buiteland vertrek het, met vakansie gegaan, terwyl 25,6% vir besigheids- en 0,6% vir studiebesoeke gegaan het.

- 2.3 Artisan, apprentice and related occupations were previously classified with subgroup "production foreman and supervisor, miner and quarry worker, operator, production and related worker".

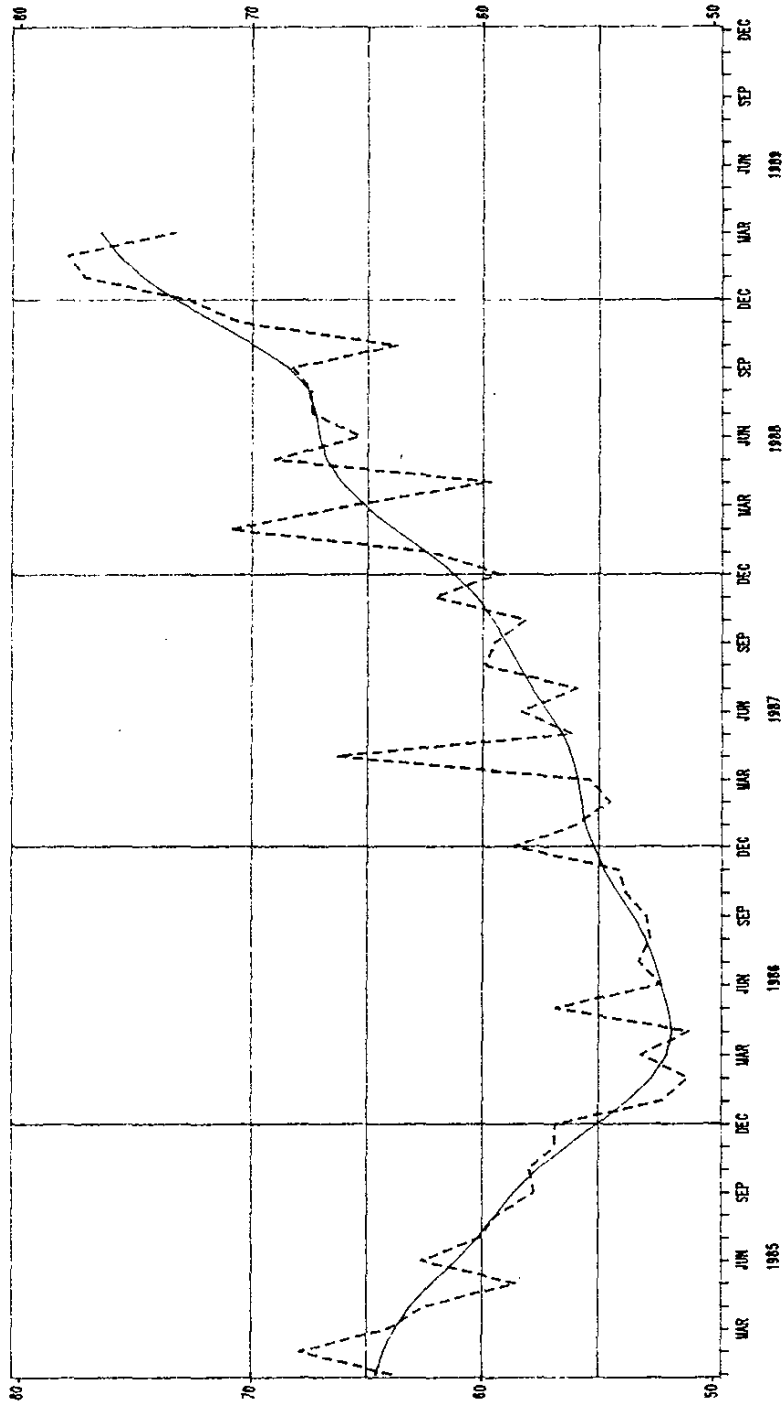

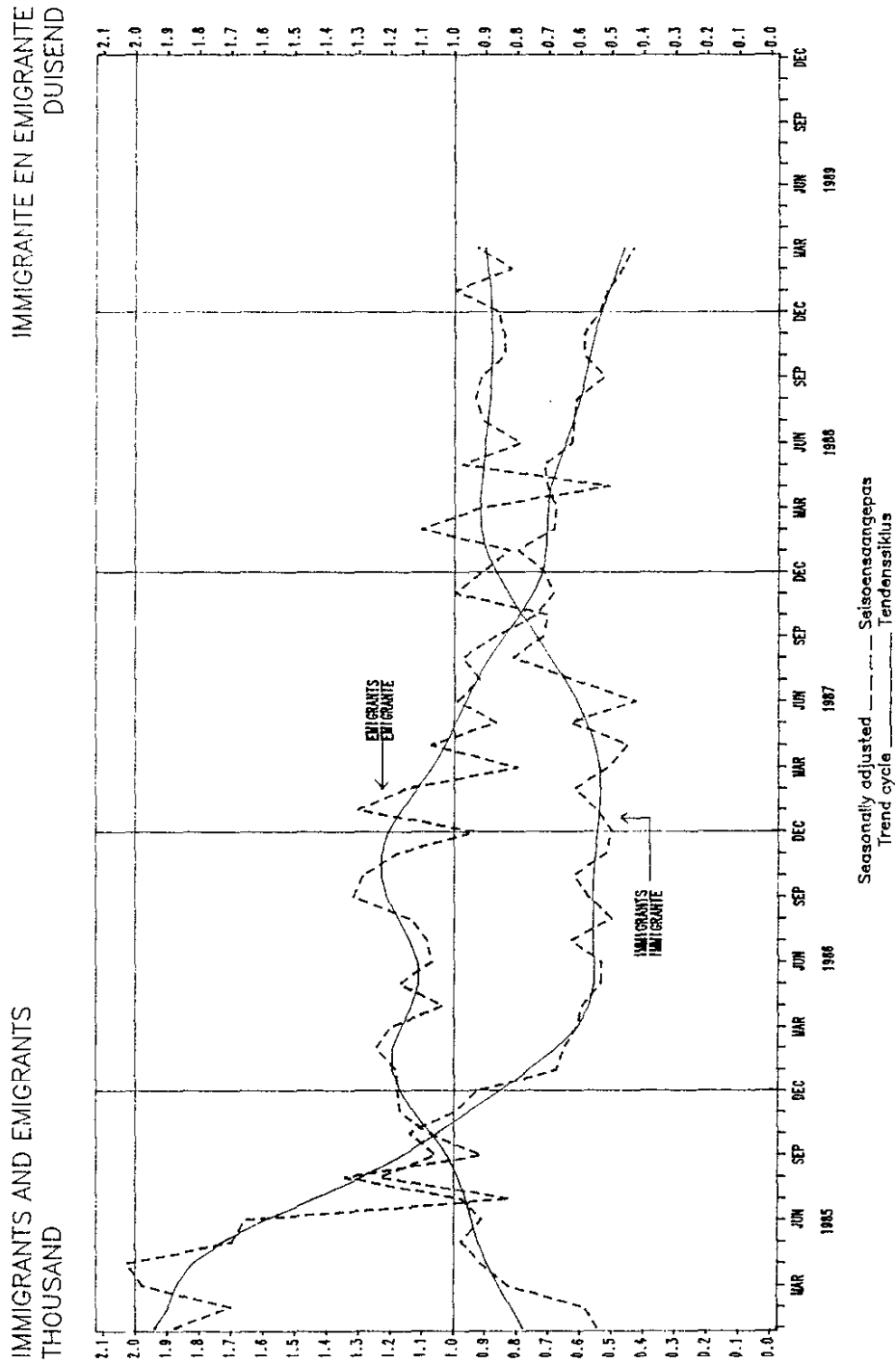
