

SUMMARY

The net result of immigration and emigration shows a gain of 784 persons for March 1990 compared with a gain of 452 persons for March 1989.

The net gain of professional, semi-professional and technical occupations was 60 persons during January 1990 to March 1990 compared with a gain of 33 persons during the same period in 1989.

Foreign visitors who arrived in the RSA during January 1990 to March 1990 increased by 15,8% compared with the same period of 1989. During March 1990 41,5% of the foreign visitors were resident in Europe and 14,5% in other overseas countries, while 44,0% were resident in Africa. Of the 36 201 visitors from Europe, 41,7% were resident in the United Kingdom and 26,0% in West Germany, while 70,7% of the visitors from the Americas were resident in the USA.

The majority of visitors from a single country during March 1990 were from Zimbabwe, namely 18,2% of the total, followed by 17,3% from the United Kingdom and 10,8% from West Germany.

During March 1990, 64,8% of the South African residents who went abroad were on holiday, while 34,6% went for business and 0,6% for study visits.

OPSOMMING

Die netto resultaat van immigrasie en emigrasie toon 'n wins van 784 persone vir Maart 1990 teenoor 'n wins van 452 persone vir Maart 1989.

Die netto wins van professionele, semi-professionele en tegniese beroepe was 60 persone gedurende Januarie 1990 tot Maart 1990 teenoor 'n wins van 33 persone gedurende dieselfde tydperk in 1989.

Vreemde besoekers wat in die RSA aangekom het, het gedurende Januarie 1990 tot Maart 1990 met 15,8% toegeneem teenoor dieselfde tydperk van 1989. Gedurende Maart 1990 was 41,5% van die vreemde besoekers woonagtig in Europa en 14,5% in ander oorsese lande, terwyl 44,0% in Afrika woonagtig was. Van die 36 201 besoekers uit Europa was 41,7% woonagtig in die Verenigde Koninkryk en 26,0% in Wes-Duitsland, terwyl 70,7% van die besoekers uit die Amerikas in die VSA woonagtig was.

Die meeste besoekers uit 'n enkele land gedurende Maart 1990 was uit Zimbabwe, naamlik 18,2% van die totaal, gevolg deur 17,3% uit die Verenigde Koninkryk, en 10,8% uit Wes-Duitsland.

Gedurende Maart 1990 het 64,8% van die Suid-Afrikaanse inwoners wat na die buiteland vertrek het, met vakansie gegaan, terwyl 34,6% vir besigheid- en 0,6% vir studiebesoeke gegaan het.

- 2.3 Artisan, apprentice and related occupations were previously classified with subgroup "production foreman and supervisor, miner and quarry worker, operator, production and related worker".




