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# P0352 Advance release of tourism statistics October 2001

# DURING OCTOBER 2001, PRELIMINARY FIGURES SHOW THAT A TOTAL OF 481 847 FOREIGN TRAVELLERS VISITED SOUTH AFRICA. THIS FIGURE INCLUDES 145 962 (30,3%) PERSONS WHO CAME FROM OVERSEAS.

## Special note to the reader:

As is a standard practice, all the figures in the September 2001 issue of P0352 were re-checked for accuracy. Somehow there was an oversight and the reference month (September) was written as August in the summary. The correct month is September instead of August. We apologise for any inconvenience.

#### **Summary of totals**

During October 2001, preliminary figures show that a total of 481 847 foreign travellers visited South Africa. This figure includes 145 962 persons (30,3%) who came from overseas and 334 334 (69,4%) from mainland Africa.

During October 2001, a total of 481 847 foreign travellers visited South Africa. This figure includes 145 962 persons (30,3%) who came from overseas, 334 334 (69,4%) from mainland Africa and 1 551 (0,3%) from unspecified countries. Of the overseas arrivals, 120 004 (82,2%) came by air and the rest, 25 958 (17,8%) came by either road or rail. Of the arrivals from mainland Africa a reverse pattern is seen, with 310 820 (93,0%) coming by road and the rest, 23 514 (7,0%) coming by either air or rail.

During the same month, a total of 347 457 foreign travellers departed from South Africa. Of these, 84 369 (24,3%) were residents of overseas countries, 262 534 (75,6%) were residents of mainland African countries and 554 (0,2%) were residents of unspecified countries. Of the departing overseas residents, 79 527 (94,3%) left by air and of the departing residents of mainland African countries, 241 914 (92,1%) left by road.

During October 2001, a total number of 249 768 South African residents left for either short or long term visits to all other countries. Of these departing residents, 78 935 (31,6%) left by air (mostly through Johannesburg International Airport) and 170 568 (68,3%) left by road. During the same month, a total of 279 427 South African residents returned. Of these returning residents 91 438 (32,7%) used air travel (again mostly using Johannesburg International Airport) and 187 720 (67,2%) used road travel.

#### Travellers from mainland Africa

During October 2001, the leading countries of travellers from mainland Africa were the neighbouring countries of Lesotho, 104 645 (31,3%); Swaziland, 58 073 (17,4%); Botswana, 49 406 (14,8%) and Zimbabwe, 44 772 (13,4%).

For departures, most of those departing were residents of the following countries: Lesotho, 74 589 (28,4%); Swaziland, 48 945 (18,6%); Zimbabwe, 38 312 (14,6%) and Botswana, 36 387 (13,9%).

For the countries neighbouring South Africa, most of the travellers from those countries arrived or departed from South Africa via road while for mainland African countries beyond Southern Africa, most used air. For air travellers from mainland Africa, the leading countries were Zimbabwe, 4 007 (17,4%); Namibia, 2 743 (11,9%); Zambia, 1 999 (8,7%) and Angola, 1 981 (8,6%). Of the travellers arriving by road from mainland Africa, the leading countries were Lesotho, 104 163 (33,5%); Swaziland, 57 583 (18,5%); Botswana, 47 647 (15,3%) and Zimbabwe, 40 757 (13,1%).

A further breakdown of the land border posts used by foreign travellers (using either road or rail) is provided in the tables. At the Lesotho-South African border, the two border post most frequently used by foreign travellers were Ficksburg and Maserubrug. Ficksburg, with 51 234 (38,3%) arriving through it and 36 118 (37,3%) departing through it and Maserubrug, 47 517 (35,6%) and 37 371 (38,6%) departed through it. At the Mozambique-South African border, the border post most frequently used was Lebombo, with 60 705 (97,1%) arriving through it and 50 452 (97,1%) departing through it. At the Swaziland-South African border, the two border posts most frequently used by travellers were Oshoek and Golela. For Oshoek, 53 822 (39,0%) arrived through it and 45 896 (41,3%) departed through it. For Golela, 30 328 (22,0%) arrived through it and 18 765 (16,9%) departed through it. At the Namibia-South African border, the border post most frequently used was Vioolsdrift, with 11 874 (45,0%) arriving through it and 8 342 (39,3%) departing through it. At the Botswana-South African border, the two border posts most frequently used by

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travellers were Kopfontein and Ramathlabama. For Kopfontein, 28 463 (29,1%) arrived through it and 22 988 (28,2%) departed through it. For Ramathlabama, 26 056 (26,6%) arrived through it and 20 788 (25,5%) departed through it. Beit Bridge is the only border post between Zimbabwe and South Africa. For the Mozambique-South African border, more than 97% of the departing or arriving travellers used the Lebombo border post.

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#### Travellers from overseas countries

For arriving overseas travellers, the leading source countries during October 2001 were the UK, 32 724 (22,4%); Germany, 22 425 (15,4%) and the Netherlands, 14 615 (10,0%).

Whereas, for departing overseas travellers, the leading destination countries were as follows: the UK, 18 986 (22,5%); Germany, 12 192 (14,5%) and the USA, 8 562 (10,1%). Most of these travellers used Johannesburg International Airport in either arriving or departing.

#### Visitors (excluding 'other travellers') from overseas and mainland African countries

The leading source countries for overseas visitors (excluding 'other travellers') were the UK, 31 012 (22,9%); Germany, 21 611(16,0%) and the Netherlands, 14 147 (10,5%). The leading source countries of visitors from Mainland Africa were Lesotho, 97 515 (31,0%); Swaziland, 54 943 (17,5%); Botswana, 45 866 (14,6%); Zimbabwe, 43 483 (13,8%) and Mozambique, 36 711 (11,7%).

During October 2001, the number of overseas visitors arriving in South Africa was 145 962. Of these overseas visitors, 121 563 (83,3%) came for holidays and 13 202 (9,0%) for business. The leading source countries for overseas visitors were the UK, 31 012 (22,9%); Germany, 21 611 (16,0%) and the Netherlands, 14 147 (10,5%). During the same month, the number of visitors from mainland Africa arriving in South Africa was 334 334. Of these visitors, 288 596 (86,3%) came for holidays and 24 625 (7,4%) for business. The leading source countries of visitors from mainland Africa were Lesotho 97 515 (31,0%); Swaziland, 54 943 (17,5%); Botswana, 45 866 (14,6%); Zimbabwe, 43 483 (13,8%) and Mozambique, 36 711 (11,7%).

#### South African residents crossing land border posts.

Of the departing South African residents, most travelled to Swaziland, 61 266 (32,6%) followed by Botswana, 43 794 (23,3%) and Mozambique 26 086 (13,9%).

During October 2001, a total of 187 989 South African residents returned to South Africa through land border posts (187 720 by road and 269 by rail) and 170 833 departed through land border posts (170 568 by road and 265 by rail). Of the departing South African residents, most travelled to Swaziland, 59 562 (34,9%) followed by Botswana, 43 093 (25,2%) and Lesotho, 21 338 (12,5%). The border post most frequently used in travelling to Swaziland was Oshoek, 25 589 (43,0%) while in travelling to Mozambique was Lebombo, 18 340 (92,7%). Of the returning South African residents, most came from Swaziland, 61 266 (32,6%) followed by Botswana, 43 794 (23,3%) and Mozambique, 26 086 (13,9%). The border post most frequently used in returning from Mozambique was Lebombo, 24 423 (93,6%), while in returning from Swaziland was Oshoek, 27 184 (44,4%).

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#### **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

#### Source of data and background

Legal movements across South African borders fall under the jurisdiction of the Department of Home Affairs (DHA). Each South African resident who leaves or re-enters South African borders by rail, road or air or sea gets his/her passport scanned to read the barcode. This simple action provides basic particulars about the person. For those passports that do not have a stripe or barcode, the Home Affairs official at the port of entry, captures onto the computer, the personal details reflected on the passport. This information is directly up-dated on the mainframe computer of the Department of Home Affairs. The idea behind the Advance Release of Tourism Statistics is to process the data before it gets offloaded onto the mainframe computer. This release covers departures and arrivals by air from the three main airports (Cape Town, Durban and Johannesburg) and other airports. The release also includes rail and road departures from the border posts that are equipped to capture arrivals and departures electronically as these occur. It is hoped that data from border posts which are not equipped to capture data as the events occur, will be included in the final Tourism and Migration statistical release (P0351). Information on reason for temporary departure of South African residents is obtained from departure forms. These are captured at Stats SA and normally included in the P0351 statistical release. For the moment, data obtained from those forms (i.e. purpose of departure and the country of destination) do not form part of the Advance Release of Tourism Statistics.

#### Comparability of data

The tourism data used for this release is not directly comparable with previous releases because of the differences in coverage explained above. To ensure continuity in our series, we will still continue with the full Tourism and Migration statistical release (P0351).

#### Clarification of terms used in the tables

Foreign travellers: For foreign travellers, the category "overseas total" excludes travellers from mainland Africa and from "unspecified" countries.

**Border posts:** As at early 2001, there are 70 ports of entry (border posts) in South Africa. Of these, about 52 are computerised and 18 are not. Those that are not computerised (comprising small airports and seaports) are not part of the BP database. The forms filled in at those ports are captured at the regional offices of DHA.

#### Glossary of some terms used in tourism statistics

**Tourism** comprises the activities of persons travelling to and staying in places outside their usual environment for not more than one consecutive year for leisure, business and other purposes. The usual environment of a person consists of a certain area around his/her place of residence plus all other places s/he frequently visits.

**Tourist** (overnight visitor) is a visitor who stays at least one night in a collective or private accommodation in the place visited. An international tourist is an **international visitor** who stays at least one night in a collective or private accommodation in the country visited. **Domestic tourist** refers to a domestic visitor who stays at least one night in a collective or private accommodation in the place visited.

**Traveller** refers to any person on a trip between two or more localities. **An international traveller** refers to any person on a trip between two or more localities in different countries. **A domestic traveller** refers to any person, on a trip between two or more localities in his/her country of residence.

**Visitor** refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than 12 consecutive months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

**An International visitor** refers to any person, travelling to a country, other than the one in which he/she has his/her usual residence, but outside his/her usual environment, for less than 12 consecutive months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

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**Domestic visitor** refers to any person residing in a country, who travels to a place within a country other than the one in which s/he has his/her usual environment, for less than 12 consecutive months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

#### **Estimation of figures for missing days**

With the breakdown of arrivals and departure statistics by date, mode of travel and port of entry/exit, it is possible to detect missing data. In the past, the missing data were footnoted and left as they were. Steps are now being taken to provide estimates for those missing data. For each missing datum, the data for a specific date/mode of travel/port of entry or exit are averaged for the previous months, since January 2000. The average figure is used as input for that missing datum. This estimation is only done for tables 3.1.1 and 4.1.1. The grand total in those tables would be higher than the reported (unadjusted) grand totals. Any further improvements in the estimation/imputation methods used will be reported upon.
