


### All three economic sectors grew in Q4: 2020








### Manufacturing and trade were the biggest contributors to growth in Q4: 2020







Quarter-on-quarter growth, seasonally adjusted and annualised



**Agriculture**: Increased production was reported for animal products

**Mining**: Decreased production was recorded for PGMs, coal and diamonds





Quarter-on-quarter growth, seasonally adjusted and annualised



Manufacturing: Growth was driven largely by increases in food and beverages, motor vehicles, and metal and steel products

Electricity, gas and water: Growth was driven by a rise in both electricity usage and water consumption


Construction: Increased activity was reported for residential buildings, non-residential buildings and construction works





### In the tertiary sector, trade recorded the highest growth rate in Q4: 2020

Quarter-on-quarter growth, seasonally adjusted and annualised



Trade: Retail and motor trades and catering and accommodation all recorded a rise in economic activity

Transport: There was an increase in land and air transport and communication services

Finance: Financial intermediation and auxiliary activities reported a fall in activity

Personal services: Increased economic activity was reported for community and other producers

Government: The rise was mainly attributed to increased employment in the civil service





Nominal GDP was estimated at **R1,35 trillion** in Q4: 2020, up by R86 billion from Q3: 2020



Trade was up by R26 billion to R193 billion



Finance was up by R20 billion to R235 billion



Electricity, gas and water was down by R7 billion to R37 billion




Agriculture was down by R19 billion to R15 billion












Household consumption expenditure increased in Q4: 2020, in line with the retail trade sales and increased expenditure in the restaurant sector












Growth in Q4: 2020 was driven largely by increasing investments in transport equipment, construction works, machinery and other equipment.

























#### Which industries drive your provincial economy?

Top four largest industries in each province, 2019



National agriculture production is concentrated in Western Cape and KwaZulu-Natal Industrial activity for eight of the ten industries is concentrated in Gauteng






