IMPROVED AGRICULTURE CONTRIBUTES TO GROWTH RATE OF 3,3% AT MARKET PRICES IN FIRST QUARTER OF 1996

According to the latest preliminary indicators the total seasonally adjusted real GDP at market prices increased by an annualised rate of 3,3% in the first quarter of 1996 following growth rates of 1,7%; 2,2%; 3,0% and 2,7% in the four quarters of 1995. This higher growth rate in the first quarter is mainly the result of an annualised growth of 82,3% in the seasonally adjusted real GDP of the agricultural sector (corresponding to an increase of 16,2% over the previous quarter).

This high increase in agriculture (at factor incomes) is however largely a recovery from the decline in 1995. As far as the other 11 sectors are concerned the growth rate in 6 of the sectors was lower in the first quarter of 1996 than the average growth for last year in those sectors. To a certain extent, this points to a slowdown in economic activities in the first quarter of 1996. The seasonally adjusted real GDP of the non-agricultural sector increased by an annualised rate of only 0,6% following increases of 1,9% in the fourth quarter of 1995 and 2,0% for the year 1995. As against a growth of 0,8% in secondary industries in the first quarter, (compared to -1,5% in the previous quarter), tertiary industries showed an increase of only 0,5% which is much lower than the 4,0% in the previous quarter. Manufacturing showed no growth for the first quarter, compared to -2,8% for the previous quarter.

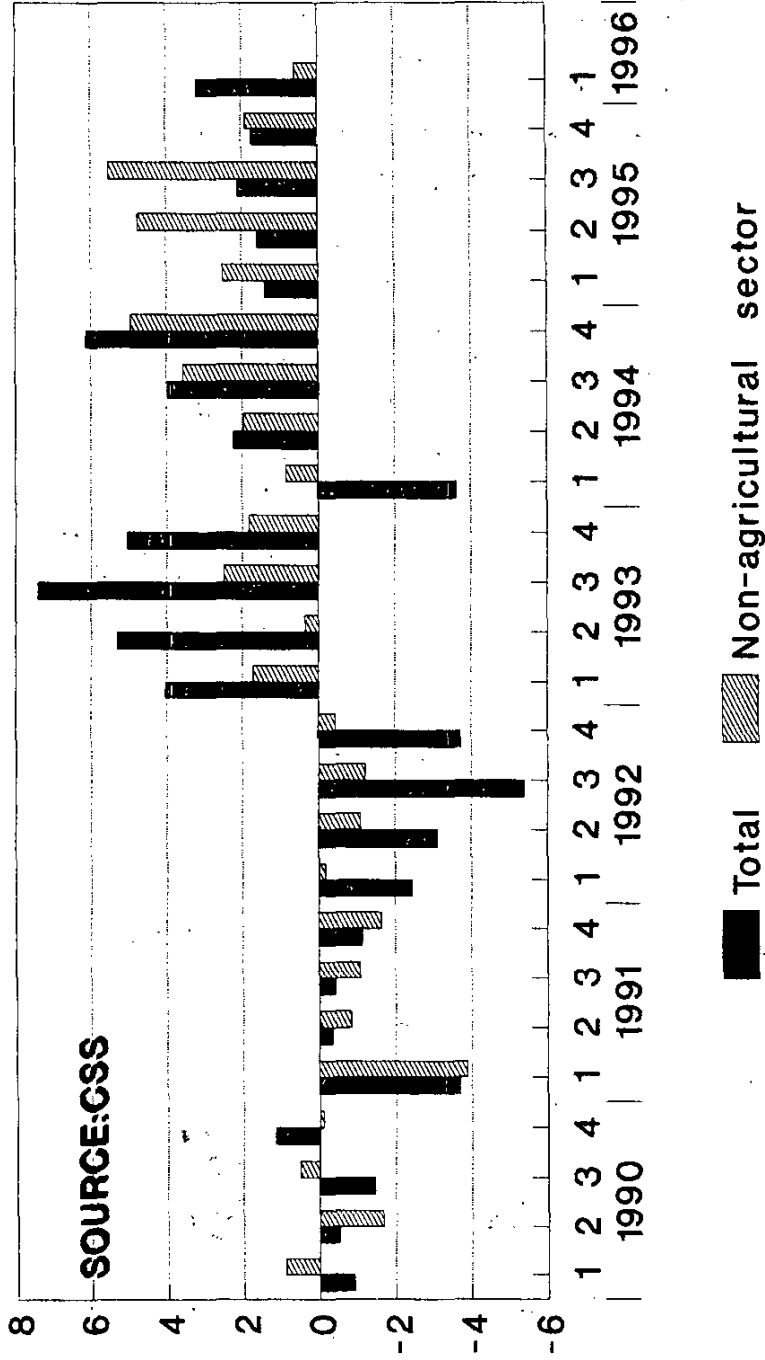

Volgens die jongste voorlopige aanwysers het die totale seisoensaangesuiwerde reële BBP teen markpryse in die eerste kwartaal van 1996 teen 'n jaarkoers van 3,3% toegeneem na groeikoerse van 1,7%; 2,2%; 3,0% en 2,7% in die vier kwartale van 1995.

Hierdie hoër groeikoers in die eerste kwartaal is hoofsaaklik die gevolg van 'n jaar-groeikoers van 82,3% in die seisoensaangesuiwerde reële BBP van die landbousektor (gelykstaande aan 'n toename van 16,2% teenoor die vorige kwartaal).

Hierdie hoë toename in landbou (teen faktorinkome) is egter grootliks 'n herstel van die afname in 1995. Wat die ander 11 sektore betref was die groeikoers in 6 van die sektore, in die eerste kwartaal laer as die gemiddelde groei van die sektore in die vorige jaar.

In 'n sekere mate dui dit op 'n verlangsaming in ekonomiese bedrywighede in die eerste kwartaal van 1996. Die seisoensaangesuiwerde reële BBP van die nie-landbousektor het teen 'n jaarkoers van slegs 0,6% toegeneem na toenames van 1,9% in die vierde kwartaal van 1995 en 2,0% vir die jaar 1995. Teenoor 'n groei van 0,8% in sekondêre nywerhede (in die eerste kwartaal (vergeleke met -1,5% in die vorige kwartaal) het tersiêre nywerhede 'n toename van slegs 0,5% getoon wat baie laer is as die 4,0% in die vierde kwartaal van 1995. Fabriekswese het geen groei in die eerste kwartaal getoon nie vergeleke met -2,8% in die vorige kwartaal.
