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**REAL GDP AT MARKET PRICES INCREASES BY 3½% IN SECOND QUARTER OF 1996**

**Note:** Estimates for the latest quarters are preliminary and subject to revision.

According to preliminary estimates for the second quarter of 1996, based on the latest available indicators, the annualised growth of more than 3% in the total seasonally adjusted real GDP at market prices in the first quarter of 1996 (3,3%) was sustained in the second quarter with a growth rate of 3,5%. Except for a negative growth rate in the first quarter of 1994 (due to a decline in agriculture) positive growth rates for the total real GDP were recorded consecutively from the first quarter of 1993 up to the present quarter, averaging a growth over the period of 3,3% per quarter at an annualised rate.

As far as the non-agricultural sector is concerned the seasonally adjusted growth rate improved from 0,4% in the first quarter of 1996 to 1,8% in the second quarter (both at an annualised rate). This improvement is mainly the result of a reversal in the growth rates of manufacturing and trade from a decline of 0,7% and 2,1% respectively in the first quarter of 1996 to positive growth rates of 1,2% and 4,7% respectively in the second quarter. All the other sectors recorded positive growth rates in both the first and second quarters, except mining which declined by 1,0% in the second quarter after an increase of 0,6% in the first quarter.

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## EXPLANATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

### Scope

The estimates cover the Republic of South Africa including the former TBVC States.

### Gross domestic product at factor incomes

The gross domestic product at factor incomes is equal to the remuneration received by the production factors i.e. the wages, interest and depreciation, rent and profit earned by labour, capital, land and entrepreneurship respectively for their participation in the domestic production. The production of the various industries are valued at factor incomes only.

### Gross domestic product at market prices

The gross domestic product at market prices is equal to the gross domestic product at factor incomes plus total indirect taxes paid (such as VAT, excise duty, import duty, etc.) minus total subsidies received (e.g. payments from government to businesses).

### Remuneration of employees

Gross salaries and wages; remuneration in kind (food, housing, etc.); employers' contributions to staff funds and to social security funds, and remuneration to managing and working directors.

### Gross operating surplus (Other income)

Operating surplus of businesses before deduction of net interest paid, depreciation allowances and income tax.

### General government

All producers of general government services. These comprise public administration and defence, as well as education, medical services, etc. In many cases no direct payments are made for these services by users.

### Other producers

Non-profit institutions serving households (universities, trade unions, etc.) as well as domestic workers (staff in the service of households).

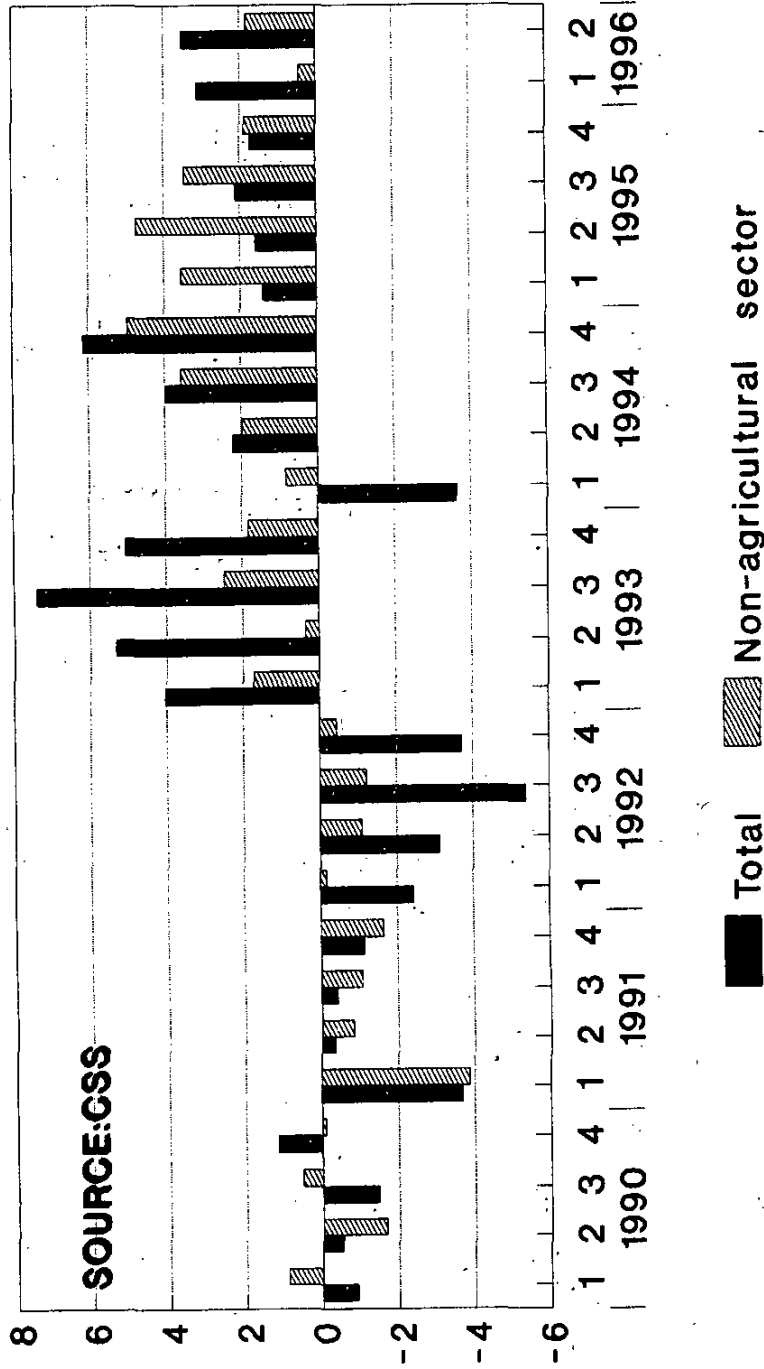
### Revision of estimates

Apart from the usual revision of the estimates for the latest quarters, the estimates for all components of the national accounts are usually investigated and revised every five years in conjunction with the rebasing of the estimates at constant prices. At such a time the results of censuses that have become available in the meantime are incorporated in the estimates.

### Timing of publication

Since the beginning of 1996 the CSS has published its GDP estimates for a given quarter after sixty days, i.e. at the end of the succeeding quarter. This allows the CSS to incorporate information from the first two months of the given quarter, and also to issue current price estimates at the same time.
