Manufacturing: Stocks of primary steel products on hand P3044

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STOCKS OF PRIMARY STEEL PRODUCTS REMAIN ON HIGHER LEVEL

The stockpiling of primary steel products, which was evident in the second and third quarters of 1997, stabilised in the fourth quarter of 1997. The stocks of primary steel products on hand at the end of the fourth quarter of 1997 are only 0,4% higher after seasonal adjustment than at the end of the third quarter. However, stocks at the end of 1997 were 8,8% higher than at the end of 1996.

Noticeable changes in stock levels between September 1997 and December 1997 occurred in ingots and other primary forms (-52 375 metric tons), unclad flat-rolled products wider than 600 mm, in coils (+69 208 metric tons), wire, bars and rods (+46 428 metric tons) and other profile products (+28 337 metric tons). These fluctuations were mainly reported by the basic iron and steel industries. Changes in stocks of other industries remained virtually on the same level.

The increase of 8,8% in stocks between 1996 and 1997 can mainly be attributed to an increase of 68 565 metric tons in wire, bars and rods which were reported by the basic iron and steel industries as well as an increase of 25 219 metric tons reported by other industries. Stocks of basic primary forms remained on the same level as a year ago.

GENERAL

The stocks of primary steel products on hand were revised according to the results of a complete survey in respect of 30 September 1989. The classification of products was revised in collaboration with the SA Rolled Steel Producers' Co-ordinating Council.

The data are collected on a sample basis and raised to obtain estimated total figures and refer to the end of the month or quarter shown. The raising factors were based on the results of the aforementioned survey.

Separate data are published for basic iron and steel industries and all other industries.

Particulars of all stocks on hand are included, irrespective of whether these stocks are materials of own manufactures or factored goods (i.e. goods sold without any further processing). Stocks allocated for further processing or use are also included.

In order to improve timeliness, some information for the current month or quarter may have been estimated

due to late response. These estimates will be revised as soon as better information is available.
