# Manufacturing: Stocks of primary steel products on hand P3044

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STOCKS OF PRIMARY STEEL PRODUCTS SHOW AN UPWARD TREND

Stockpiling of primary steel products has been evident since the second quarter of 1997. After an increase of 5,4% from March 1997 to June 1997, the total stocks of primary steel products showed a further increase of 3,2% after seasonal adjustment from the end of June 1997 to the end of September 1997.

Large increases between June 1997 and September 1997 occurred in all the categories of the basic primary forms, namely pig iron (+65 565 metric tons), ferro-alloys (+11 765 metric tons) and other basic primary forms (+20 116 metric tons). Furthermore, increases were reflected in ingots and other primary forms of iron and non-alloy steel (+42 123 metric tons). Stocks of other processed products (e.g. flat-rolled products, profile products) remained virtually on the same level between the above-mentioned quarters.

# GENERAL

The stocks of primary steel products on hand were revised according to the results of a complete survey in respect of 30 September 1989. The classification of products was revised in collaboration with the SA Rolled Steel Producers' Co-ordinating Council.

The data are collected on a sample basis and raised to obtain estimated total figures and refer to the end of the month or quarter shown. The raising factors were based on the results of the aforementioned survey.

Separate data are published for basic iron and steel industries and all other industries.

Particulars of all stocks on hand are included, irrespective of whether these stocks are materials of own manufactures or factored goods (i.e. goods sold without any further processing). Stocks allocated for further processing or use are also included.

In order to improve timeliness, some information for the current month or quarter may have been estimated due to late response. These estimates will be revised as soon as better information is available.
