SLIGHT IMPROVEMENT IN THE CONSUMPTION OF ELECTRICITY

Since the beginning of 1999 the trend in the consumption of electricity in South Africa is slightly improving. Consumption of electricity in South Africa for the three months up to April 1999, after seasonal adjustment, increased by 1,6% (726 Gigawatt-hours) compared with the previous three months. The production of electricity in South Africa increased by 0,3% (141 Gigawatt-hours) and imports of electricity increased by 57,9% (421 Gigawatt-hours) during this period. The high imports of electricity resulted in more electricity being available for distribution in South Africa. However, export of electricity decreased by 18,3% (215 Gigawatt-hours) during the above-mentioned period.

During the three months up to April 1999, production of electricity by producers other than Eskom, reflected the lowest level since October 1996. Although production as reported by Eskom, remained stable for the last few months, the imports of electricity are increasingly used to fulfil the demand for electricity in South Africa.

NOTE

This statistical release contains estimates of the total number of units of electricity consumed (as indicated by electricity available for distribution) in the Republic of South Africa (including the former TBVC states). Electricity available for distribution is measured before allowing for transmission losses.

Information regarding the number of units of electricity produced, the number of units consumed in power stations, electricity purchased and sold outside South Africa are also published in this statistical release.

According to international practice, production indices are arithmetically converted to base 1995=100.

In order to improve timeliness, some information for the current month may have been estimated due to late response. These estimates will be revised as soon as new information becomes available.

Stats SA has adopted the confidential pre-release policy in respect of selected economic indicators and specific government departments. The policy accords with practice among leading statistical agencies. The statistical integrity of the indices and strict observance of the release time has been assured by the following procedure:

In respect of this statistical release, an official representative from the Office of the President, the Deputy President, the Department of Finance, the South African Reserve Bank and the Department of Trade and Industry will receive a copy of the release on a strictly confidential basis two hours in advance of the public issue.
