#### CONSUMPTION OF ELECTRICITY DECREASES

The consumption of electricity for the three months up to August 1999 decreased by 0,9% (-438 Gigawatt-hours) after seasonal adjustment, compared with the previous three months. However, the seasonally adjusted consumption of electricity increased slightly between July and August 1999 by 0,9%.

The seasonally adjusted imports of electricity for the three months up to August 1999 increased by 4,2% (69 Gigawatt-hours) compared with the previous three months. This resulted in a decrease in the production of electricity in South Africa (-0,2% or -78 Gigawatt-hours) during this period, mainly due to lower production by producers other than Eskom.

Furthermore, the seasonally adjusted exports of electricity for the three months up to August 1999 increased by 41,0% (403 Gigawatt-hours) compared with the previous three months.

Although the total seasonally adjusted production of electricity for the three months up to August 1999 decreased by 0,2% compared with the previous three months, the seasonally adjusted production of electricity for June to August 1999, as reported by Eskom, increased slightly by 0,2% (97 Gigawatt-hours). Other producers reported a decrease in production of 6,7% (-175 Gigawatt-hours) durin this period.

#### NOTE

This statistical release contains estimates of the total number of units of electricity consumed (as indicated by electricity available for distribution) in the Republic of South Africa (including the former TBVC states). Electricity available for distribution is measured before allowing for transmission losses.

Information regarding the number of units of electricity produced, the number of units consumed in power stations, electricity purchased and sold outside South Africa are also published in this statistical release.

According to international practice, production indices are arithmetically converted to base 1995=100.

In order to improve timeliness, some information for the current month may have been estimated due to late response. These estimates will be revised as soon as new information becomes available.

## Pre-release policy

New estimates of economic indicators are kept strictly confidential by Stats SA prior to the date and time of release. To enable selected government departments to prepare their public responses, the following pre-release policy is applied. It accords with practice in leading statistical agencies.

In respect of this statistical release, an official representative from the Office of the President, the Deputy President, the Department of Finance, the South African Reserve Bank and the Department of Trade and Industry will receive a copy of the release on a strictly confidential basis two hours in advance of the public issue.
