# Statistical release P6141.2


#### REAL WHOLESALE TRADE SALES LOWER THAN FOR 1996

The real wholesale trade sales (at constant June 1995 prices), excluding diamonds, for the four months up to April 1997 show a decrease of 4,5% compared with the corresponding period of 1996.

Six of the nine types of wholesalers (excluding diamonds) show decreases in their real sales for the first four months of 1997 compared with the corresponding period of 1996. Wholesalers in machinery and equipment, wholesalers in textiles, clothing and footwear and wholesalers in livestock and farm produce show increases of 10,4%, 4,0% and 0,4% respectively in their real sales over this period.


The value of wholesale trade sales (excluding diamonds) for April 1997 amounted to R19 100,6 million, which shows an increase of 2,9% compared with the relatively low sales for March 1997. The earlier than usual Easter weekend of 1997 resulted in fewer than usual trading days for March and more than usual for April. The effect of this can be seen in the sales of wholesalers in construction and building materials, which show a decrease of 6,4% for March 1997 compared with February 1997 and an increase of 7,7% in April 1997 compared with March 1997. However, the sales of certain types of wholesalers were not affected by the early Easter weekend. The sales of wholesalers in foodstuffs, beverages and tobacco, for instance, show an increase of 9,3% between March 1997 and February 1997 and a decrease of 0,8% in April 1997 compared with March 1997.

#### REAL WHOLESALE TRADE SALES BY TYPE OF BUSINESS Percentage change - year on year




#### WHOLESALE TRADE SALES BY TYPE OF BUSINESS


#### Percentage change - month on month

### NOTES

This statistical release shows final estimates of the wholesale trade sales in the Republic of South Africa (the former TBVC states are included). The survey is conducted on a firm basis. The results of the sample survey are raised to represent the total wholesale trade sales. Both actual and seasonally adjusted values of wholesale trade sales according to type of business at current as well as at constant June 1995 prices are shown. The value of sales at constant June 1995 prices in respect of each type of business is obtained by deflating the sales value at current prices by means of sub-indices of the production price index on base June 1995=100.

Wholesale trade sales at current prices include VAT.
