
SEASONALLY ADJUSTED REAL WHOLESALE TRADE SALES DECREASE FOR AUGUST 1996

The seasonally adjusted real wholesale trade sales (excluding diamonds) for August 1996 show a decrease of 1,0% compared with July 1996.


The seasonally adjusted real sales of dealers in construction and building materials for August 1996 are 7,7% lower than for July 1996. Those for dealers in livestock and farm produce and dealers in office and shop equipment, books and stationery are both 6,3% lower. The sales of dealers in miscellaneous goods, which have the largest market share, show a decrease of 3,4%. Opposed to this, both dealers in furniture and household requisites, and in foodstuffs, beverages and tobacco show substantial increases (+15,5% and +10,3% respectively) in their real sales, after relatively low sales for July 1996.

NOTES

This statistical release shows final estimates of the wholesale trade sales in the Republic of South Africa (the former TBVC states are included). The survey is conducted on a firm basis. The results of the sample survey are raised to represent the total wholesale trade sales. Both actual and seasonally adjusted values of wholesale trade sales according to type of business at current as well as constant June 1995 prices are shown. The value of sales at constant June 1995 prices in respect of each type of business is obtained by deflating the sales value at current prices by means of sub-indices of the production price index on base June 1995=100.

Wholesale trade sales at current prices include VAT.

In order to improve timeliness, some information for the current month may have been estimated due to late response. These estimates will be revised as soon as better information is available.
