
REAL WHOLESALE TRADE SALES DECREASE FOR FEBRUARY 1997

Real wholesale trade sales (at constant June 1995 prices), excluding diamonds, show a decrease of 6,7% from February 1996 to February 1997. The total real wholesale trade sales for the three months up to February 1997 are 4,0% lower than for the three months up to February 1996.


Six of the nine types of wholesalers (excluding wholesalers in diamonds) show decreases in their real sales for February 1997 compared with February 1996. These decreases range from 2,7% in respect of wholesalers in construction and building materials to 19,3% in respect of wholesalers in foodstuffs, beverages and tobacco.

The seasonally adjusted value of wholesale trade sales (excluding diamonds) for February 1997 are 1,8% lower than for January 1997. The largest decrease occurred in respect of wholesalers in furniture and household requisites (-6,0%). The value of sales of wholesalers in miscellaneous goods, which have the largest market share, decreased by 2,8% and those of wholesalers in foodstuffs, beverages and tobacco, which have the second largest market share, decreased by 3,2%. Increases occurred in respect of wholesalers in machinery and equipment (+0,9%), wholesalers in textiles, clothing and footwear (+3,8%) and wholesalers in office and shop equipment, books and stationery (+0,7%).


**REAL WHOLESALE TRADE SALES

NOTES

This statistical release shows final estimates of the wholesale trade sales in the Republic of South Africa (the former TBVC states are included). The survey is conducted on a firm basis. The results of the sample survey are raised to represent the total wholesale trade sales. Both actual and seasonally adjusted values of wholesale trade sales according to type of business at current as well as at constant June 1995 prices are shown. The value of sales at constant June 1995 prices in respect of each type of business is obtained by deflating the sales value at current prices by means of sub-indices of the production price index on base June 1995=100.

Wholesale trade sales at current prices include VAT.
