

REAL WHOLESALE TRADE SALES INCREASE FOR FEBRUARY 1998

The real wholesale trade sales (at constant June 1995 prices), excluding diamonds, show an increase of 2,0% from February 1997 to February 1998. The seasonally adjusted real wholesale trade sales (excluding diamonds) for February 1998 show an increase of 1,7% compared with January 1998. However, the total seasonally adjusted real wholesale trade sales (excluding diamonds) for the three months up to February 1998 are 2,6% lower than for the previous three months.

Five of the nine wholesaler categories (excluding diamonds) showed increases in their seasonally adjusted real sales for February 1998 compared with January 1998. Wholesalers in foodstuffs, beverages and tobacco reflected the largest percentage increase (+6,1%), followed by wholesalers in office and shop equipment, books and stationery (+4,1%) and wholesalers in livestock and farm produce (+2,6%).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

This statistical release shows final estimates of the wholesale trade sales in the Republic of South Africa (the former TBVC states are included). The survey is conducted on a firm basis. The results of the sample survey are raised to represent the total wholesale trade sales. Both actual and seasonally adjusted values of wholesale trade sales according to type of business at current as well as at constant June 1995 prices are shown. The value of sales at constant June 1995 prices in respect of each type of business is obtained by deflating the sales value at current prices by means of sub-indices of the production price index on base June 1995=100.

Wholesale trade sales at current prices include VAT.

The CSS will be redesigning this survey, including the questionnaire. Any inputs regarding the new questionnaire will be greatly appreciated.
