


REAL WHOLESALE TRADE SALES INCREASE: JANUARY 1999

The real wholesale trade sales (at constant June 1995 prices), excluding diamonds, for the three months up to January 1999 reflected an increase of 2,4% compared with the corresponding period a year ago. The seasonally adjusted real wholesale trade sales (at constant June 1995 prices), excluding diamonds, for the three months up to January 1999 increased slightly by 0,1% compared with the previous three months

The seasonally adjusted real wholesale trade sales, excluding diamonds, for January 1999 increased by 0,4% compared with December 1998. Five of the nine wholesalers categories reflected increases. The largest percentage increase was reflected by wholesalers in office and shop equipment, books and stationery and wholesalers in pharmaceutical and chemical products (both increased by 7,9%), followed by wholesalers in machinery (+6,7%) and wholesalers in furniture and household requisites (+5,3%). Wholesalers in foodstuff, beverages and tobacco, which have the second largest market share (19,2% of real sales in January 1999), reflected an increase of 2,4%, while wholesalers in miscellaneous goods, which have the largest market share (27,2% of real sales in January 1999), reflected a decrease of 2,7%.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

This statistical release shows final estimates of the wholesale trade sales in the Republic of South Africa. The survey is conducted on a firm basis. The results of the sample survey are raised to represent the total wholesale trade sales. Both actual and seasonally adjusted values of wholesale trade sales according to type of business at current as well as at constant June 1995 prices are reported on in this publication. The value of sales at constant June 1995 prices in respect of each type of business is obtained by deflating the sales value at current prices by means of sub-indices of the production price index on base June 1995=100.

Wholesale trade sales at current prices include VAT.

Stats SA is currently redesigning this survey, including the questionnaire. Any inputs regarding the new questionnaire will be appreciated.
