


REAL WHOLESALE TRADE SALES INCREASE DURING FIRST QUARTER OF 1999

The seasonally adjusted real wholesale trade sales (at constant June 1995 prices), excluding diamonds, for the first quarter of 1999 reflected an increase of 0.7% compared with the fourth quarter of 1998. Furthermore, the real wholesale trade sales, excluding diamonds, for the first quarter of 1999 reflected an increase of 2.6% compared with the corresponding period of 1998. However, the seasonally adjusted real wholesale trade sales, excluding diamonds, for March 1999 decreased by 1.7% compared with February 1999.

Five of the nine wholesaler categories reflected increases in the seasonally adjusted real wholesale trade sales for the three months up to March 1999 compared with the previous three months. The largest percentage increase was reported by wholesalers in machinery (+8.1%), followed by wholesalers in pharmaceutical and chemical products (+4.1%) and wholesalers in furniture and household requisites (+4.0%).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

The data in this statistical release are based on a monthly sample survey of 500 wholesalers in the Republic of South Africa. The response rate for this month was 87,9% and the outstanding 54 questionnaires were imputed. The results of the sample survey are raised to represent the total wholesale trade sales. Both actual and seasonally adjusted values of wholesale trade sales according to type of business at current as well as at constant June 1995 prices are reported on in this publication. The value of sales at constant June 1995 prices in respect of each type of business is obtained by deflating the sales value at current prices by means of sub-indices of the production price index on base June 1995=100.

Wholesale trade sales at current prices include VAT.

Stats SA is currently redesigning this survey, including the questionnaire. Any inputs regarding the new questionnaire will be appreciated.
