# Transport of passengers by bus and train P7141

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# FEWER PASSENGERS TRANSPORTED IN FEBRUARY 1997

The total number of passengers transported reflected a decrease of 7,6% when February 1997 (75,9 million) is compared with February 1996 (82,1 million). The number of passengers transported by private undertakings and municipal passenger transport departments during February 1997 decreased by 18,0% each, whereas that transported by Transnet Ltd increased by 3,1% over the same period.

The number of buses in stock of private transport undertakings increased by 3,9% from 8 144 in February 1996 to 8 461 in February 1997 and revenue-earning kilometres travelled increased by 3,8% (1,1 million kilometres). Total transport earnings increased by 16,2% over the same period.

The number of passengers transported during the three months ended February 1997 by private undertakings, Transnet Ltd and municipal passenger transport departments decreased by 11,43%, 9,3% and 6,3% respectively, after seasonal adjustment, compared with the previous three months.

Due to financial restrictions, this series will unfortunately be discontinued. The March 1997 survey, to be published in May 1997, will be the last edition in the P7141 series.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

- 1. This statistical release contains data on the transport of passengers for reward by transporters which include private sector institutions (private undertakings which operate a public passenger transport service for reward), Transnet Ltd and municipal passenger transport departments.
- 2. In the case of public transport by private sector institutions the estimates are based on particulars collected by means—of a monthly sample survey based on the results of the 1986 Census of transport and allied services.
- 3. Actual figures often show a seasonal pattern which means that every year figures show a specific repetitive tendency.
- An example is the fact that salaries and wages usually show a peak during December months. This seasonal effect is eliminated to produce seasonal adjusted figures which could be compared with that of the previous month.
- 4. As seasonally adjusted figures are recalculated monthly, small adjustments may occur each month.
- 5. To calculate the year figures, the following figures are used:
  - (i) Number of passenger buses: Average of year in question.
  - (ii) Number of persons employed: June figure.
- 6. Salaries and wages relate to gross salaries and wages and include, inter alia, overtime payments, allowances, commission and bonuses.

7. The average salaries and wages at constant 1990 prices is obtained by deflating the average salaries and wages at current prices by means of the consumer price index for the higher income group for Whites, that for the middle income group for Coloureds and Asians and that for the lower income group for Blacks on base 1990=100.

In order to improve timeliness, some information for the current month has been estimated due to late response. The information for the latest month is therefore preliminary and subject to revision.
