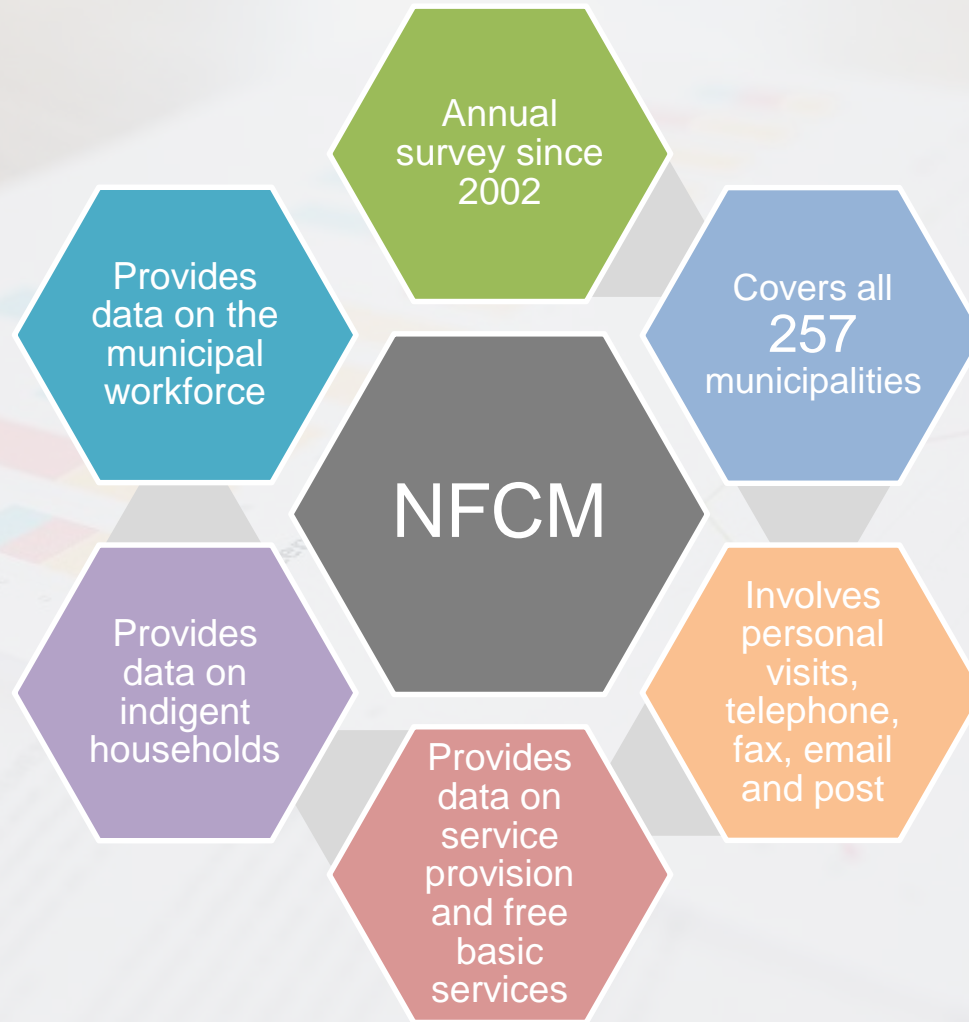

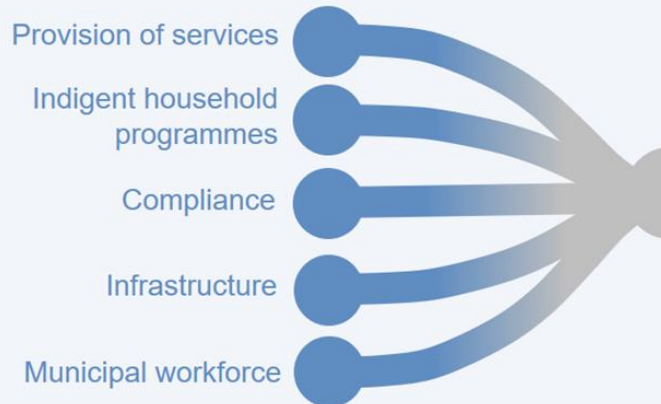

The NFCM measures the supply side of service delivery

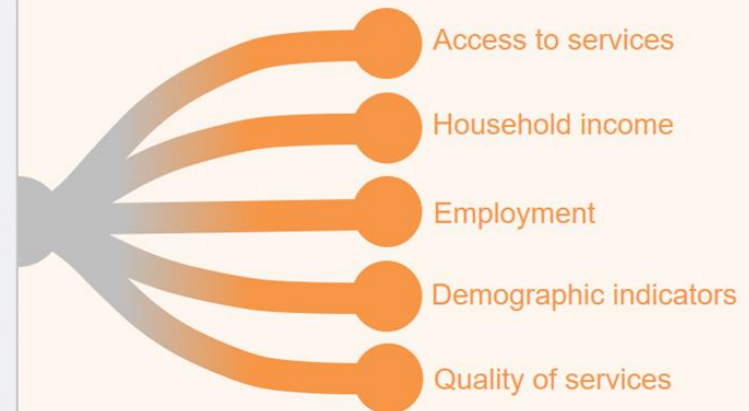
Supply side

Data are collected from municipalities
(e.g. *Non-financial census of municipalities*)



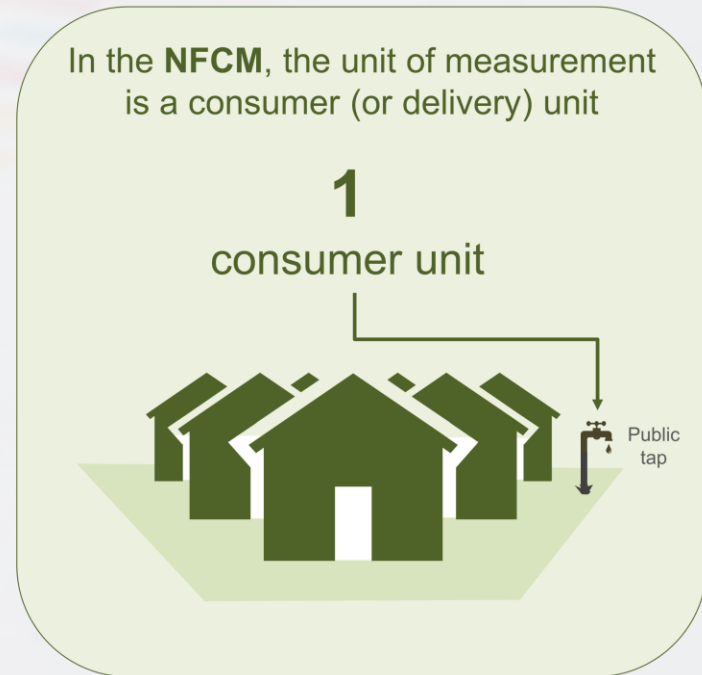
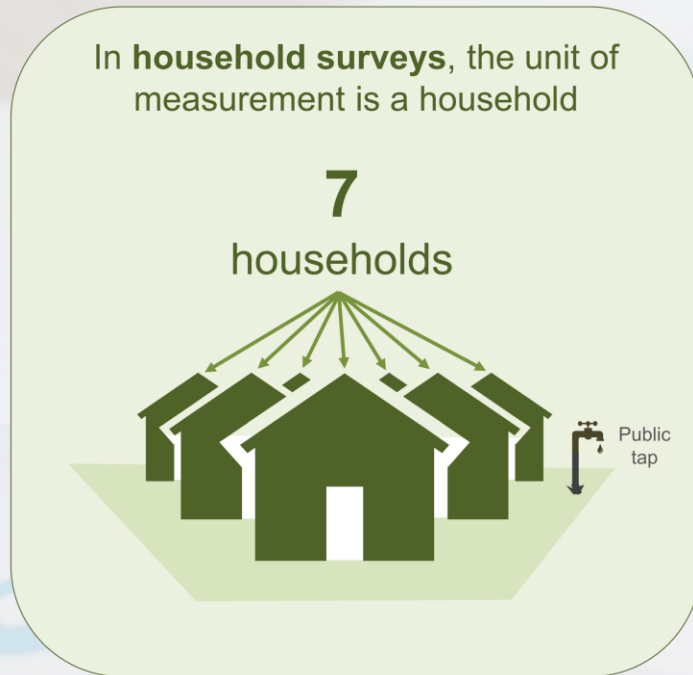
Demand side

Data are collected from households
(e.g. *household surveys, Census 2011*)



Household vs consumer unit

Consumer unit: An entity to which the service is delivered, and which receives one bill if the service is billed. Also known as a delivery point



Households and consumer units do not always coincide one to one, particularly in blocks of flats, on stands where there are multiple households in the same dwelling, or in the case of public taps

Free basic services: What are consumer units entitled to?

Free basic service: the minimum amount of basic levels of services, provided on a day to day basis, sufficient to cover or cater for the basic needs of poor households

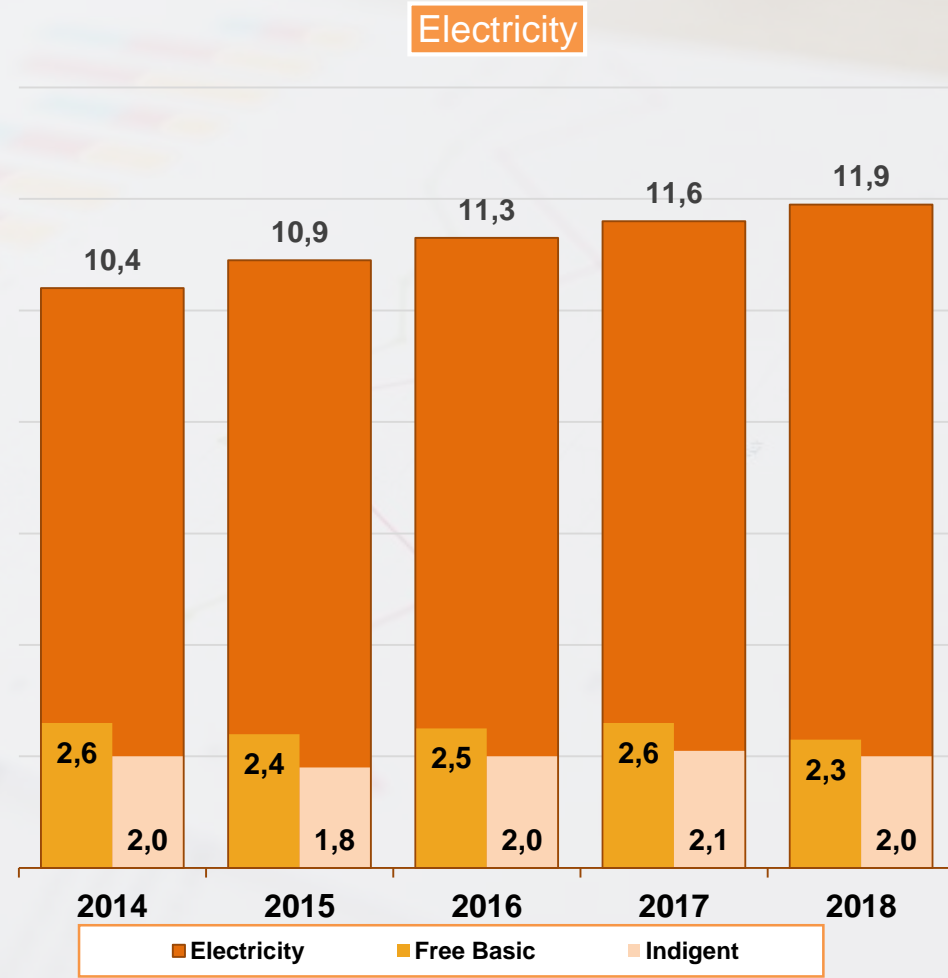

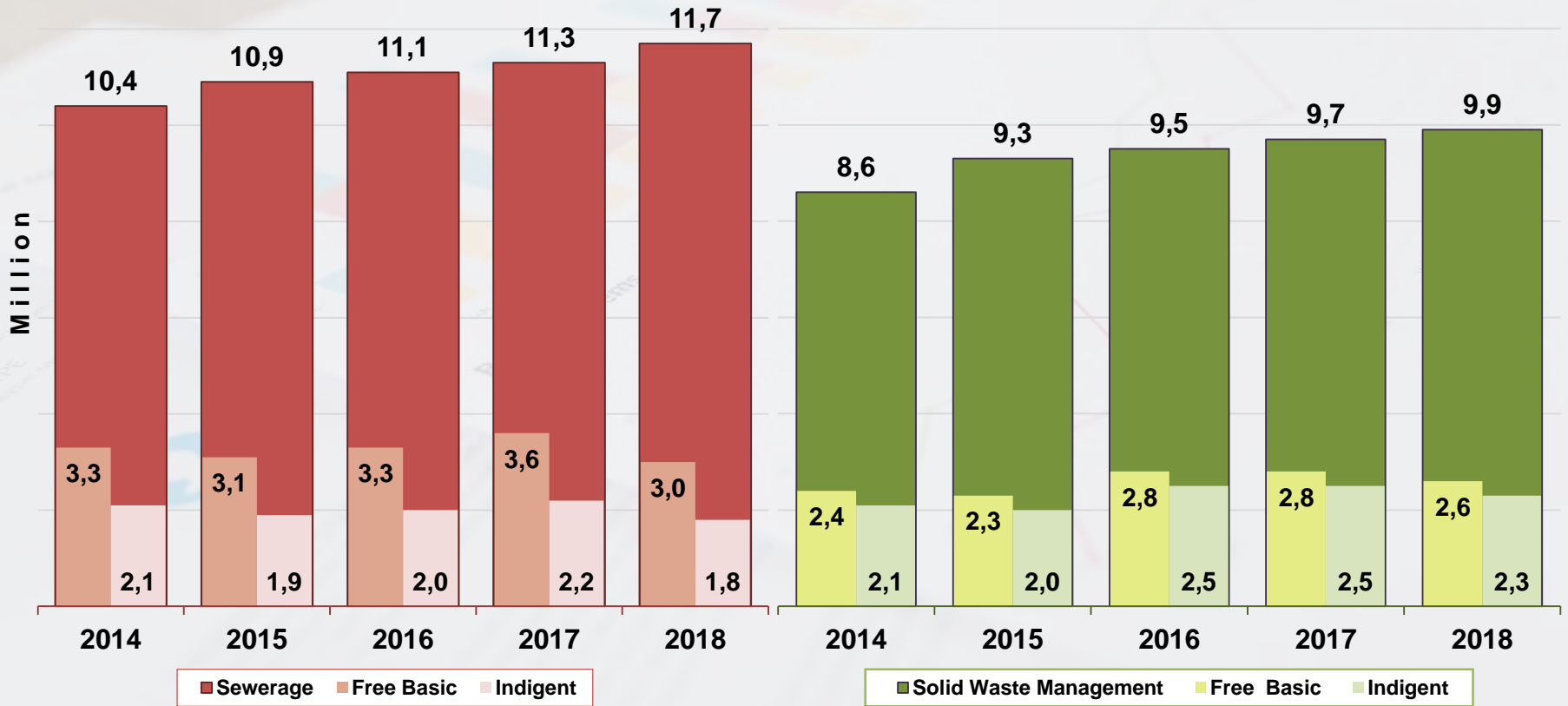

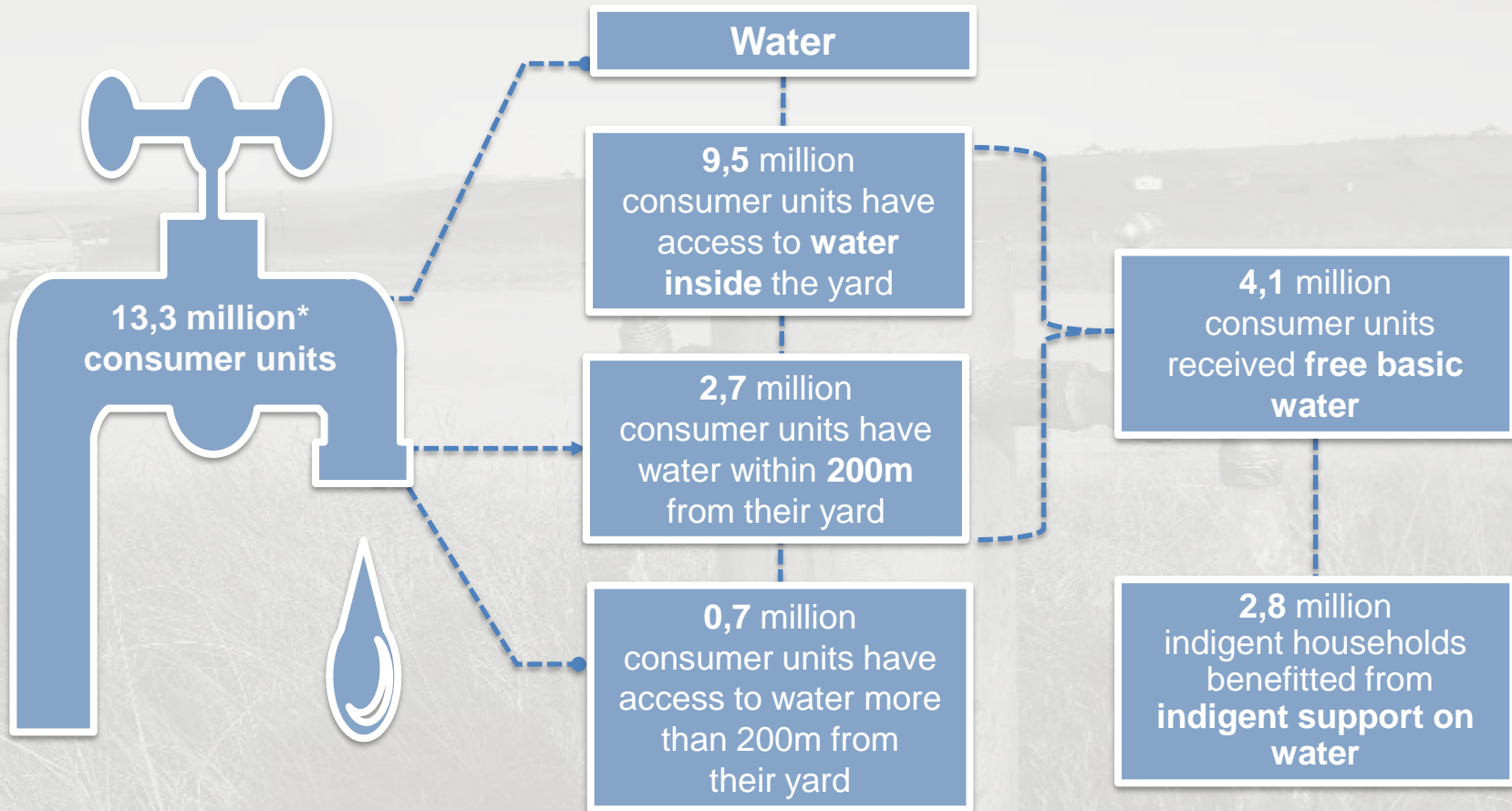

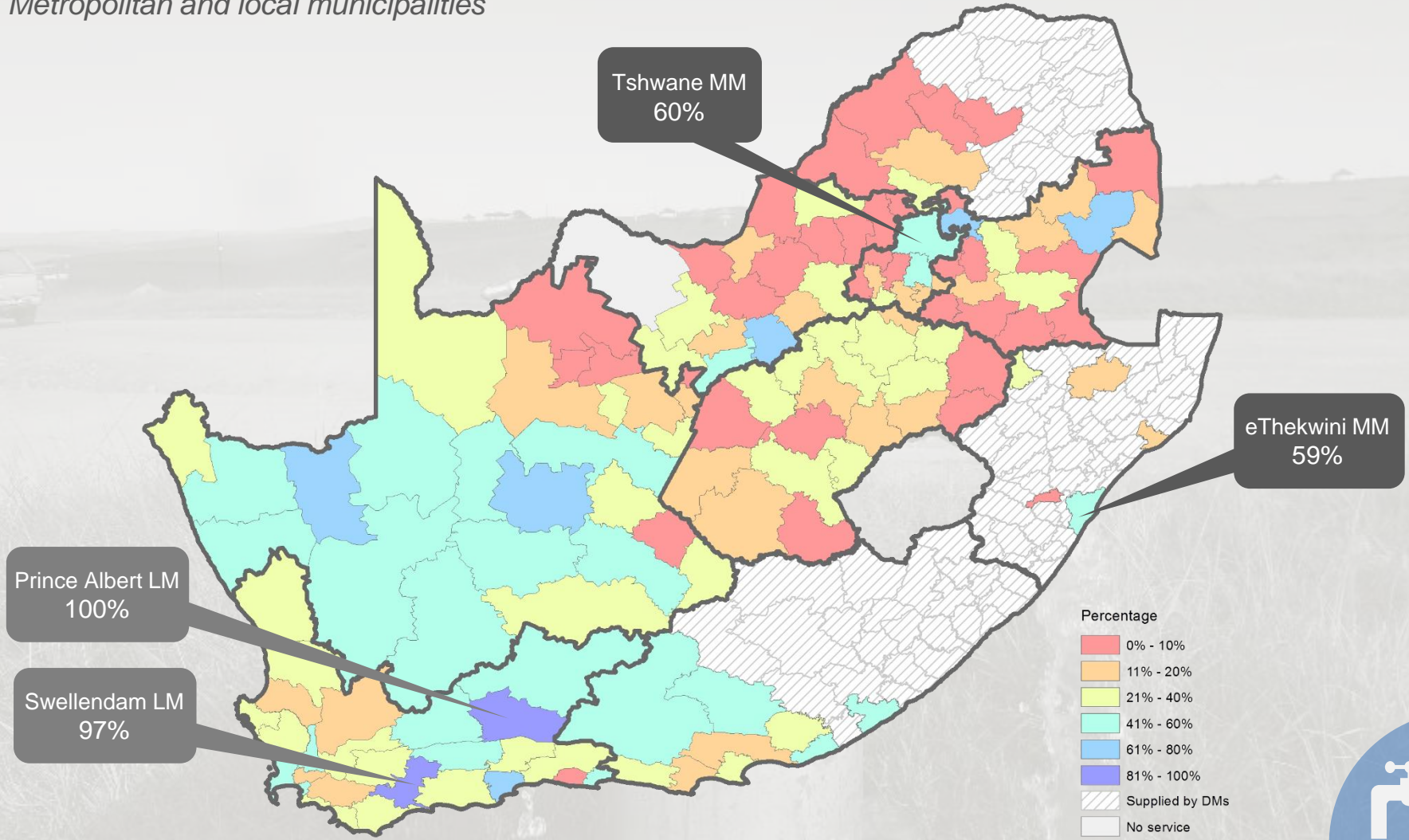
Number of consumer units benefitting from water

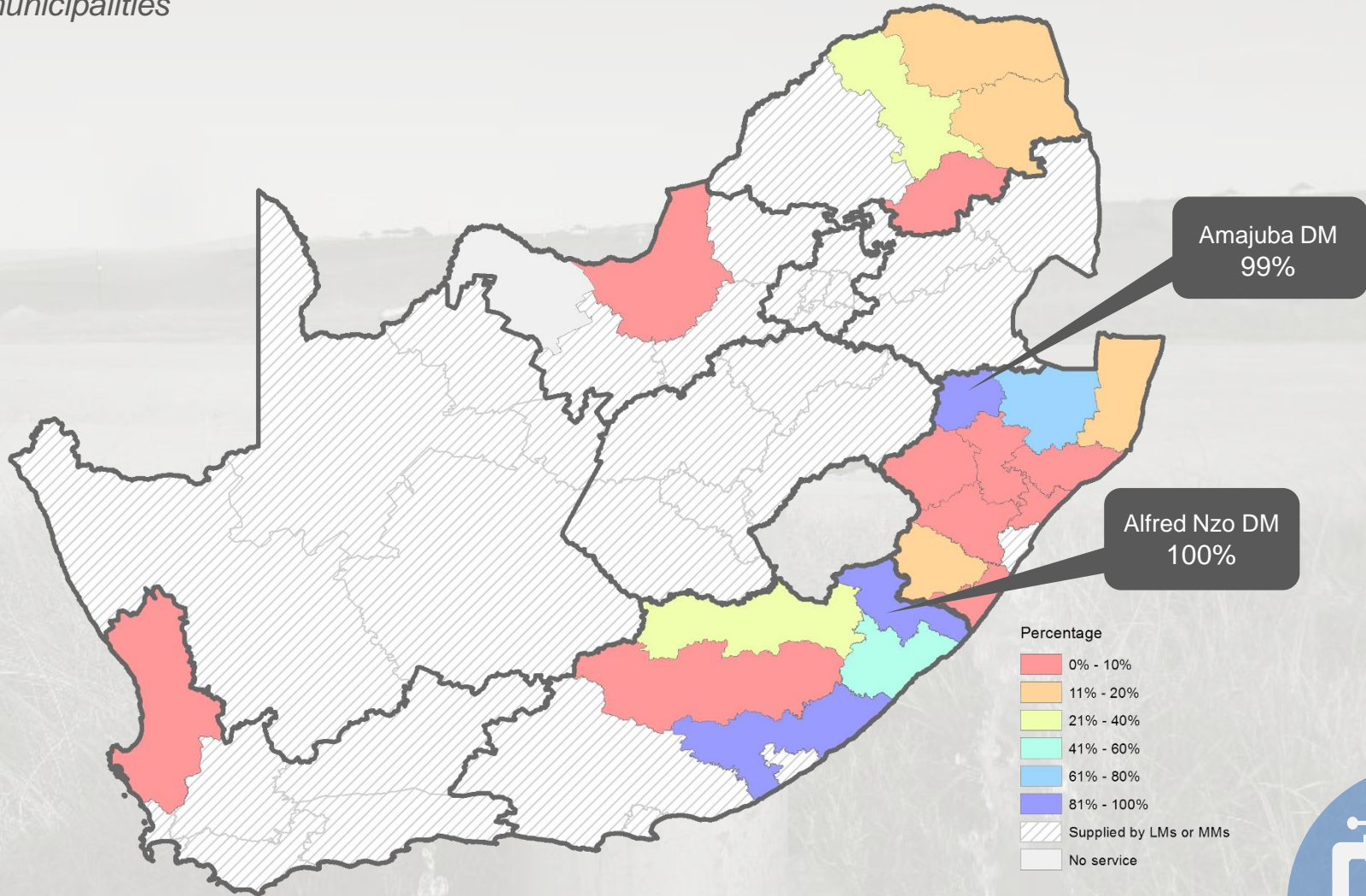
Percentage of consumer units benefitting from some free basic water in 2018

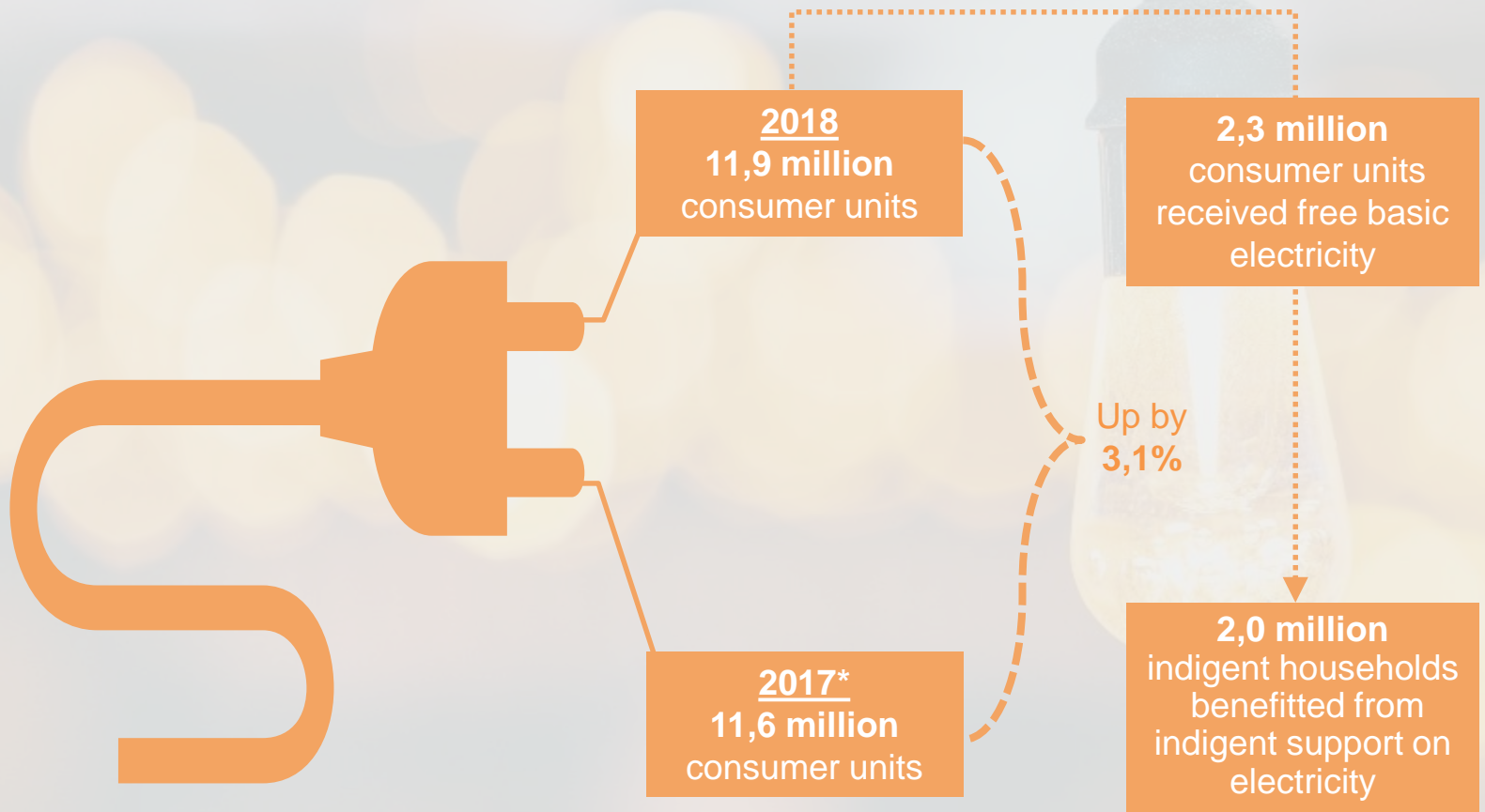

Number of consumer units receiving electricity



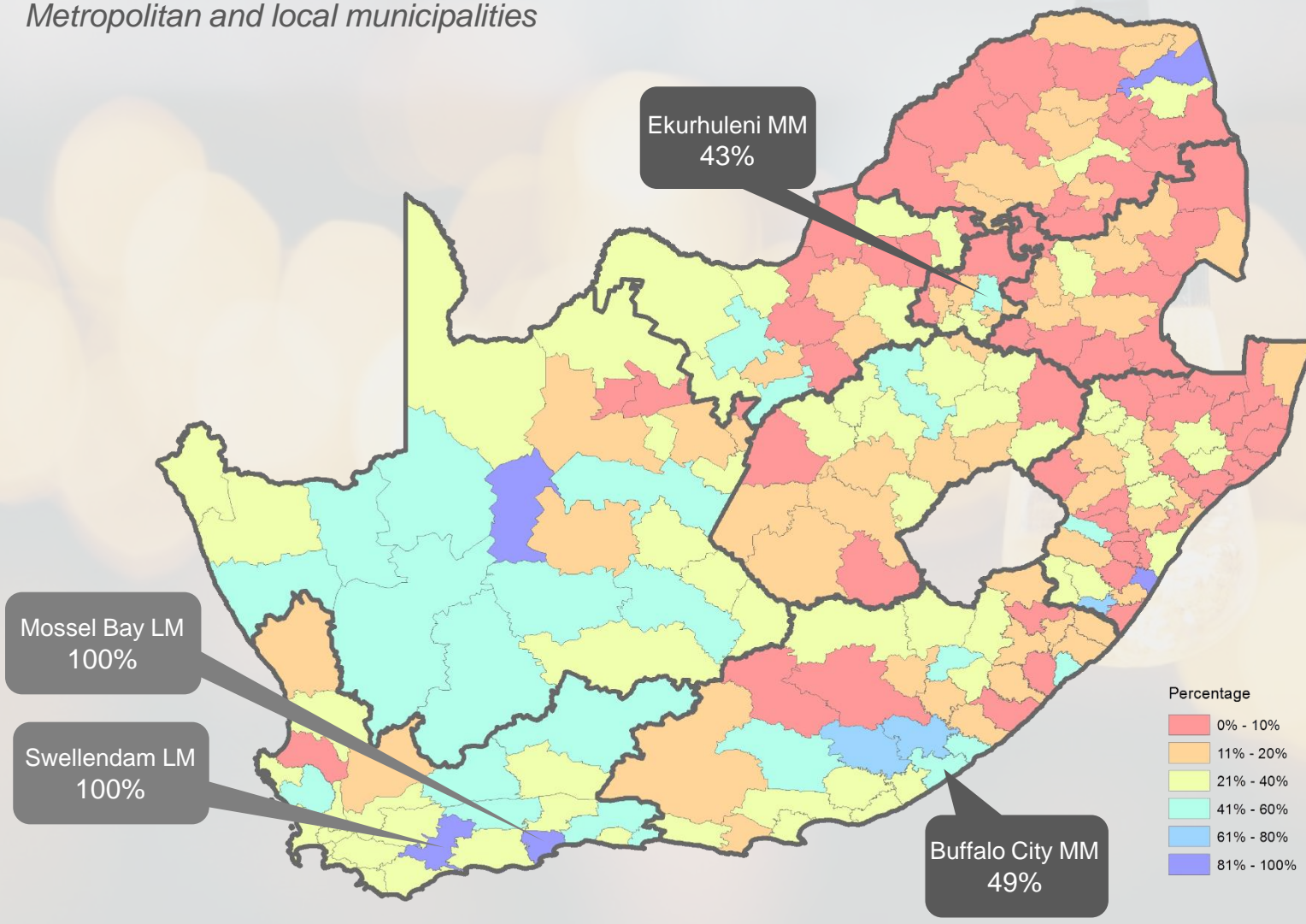

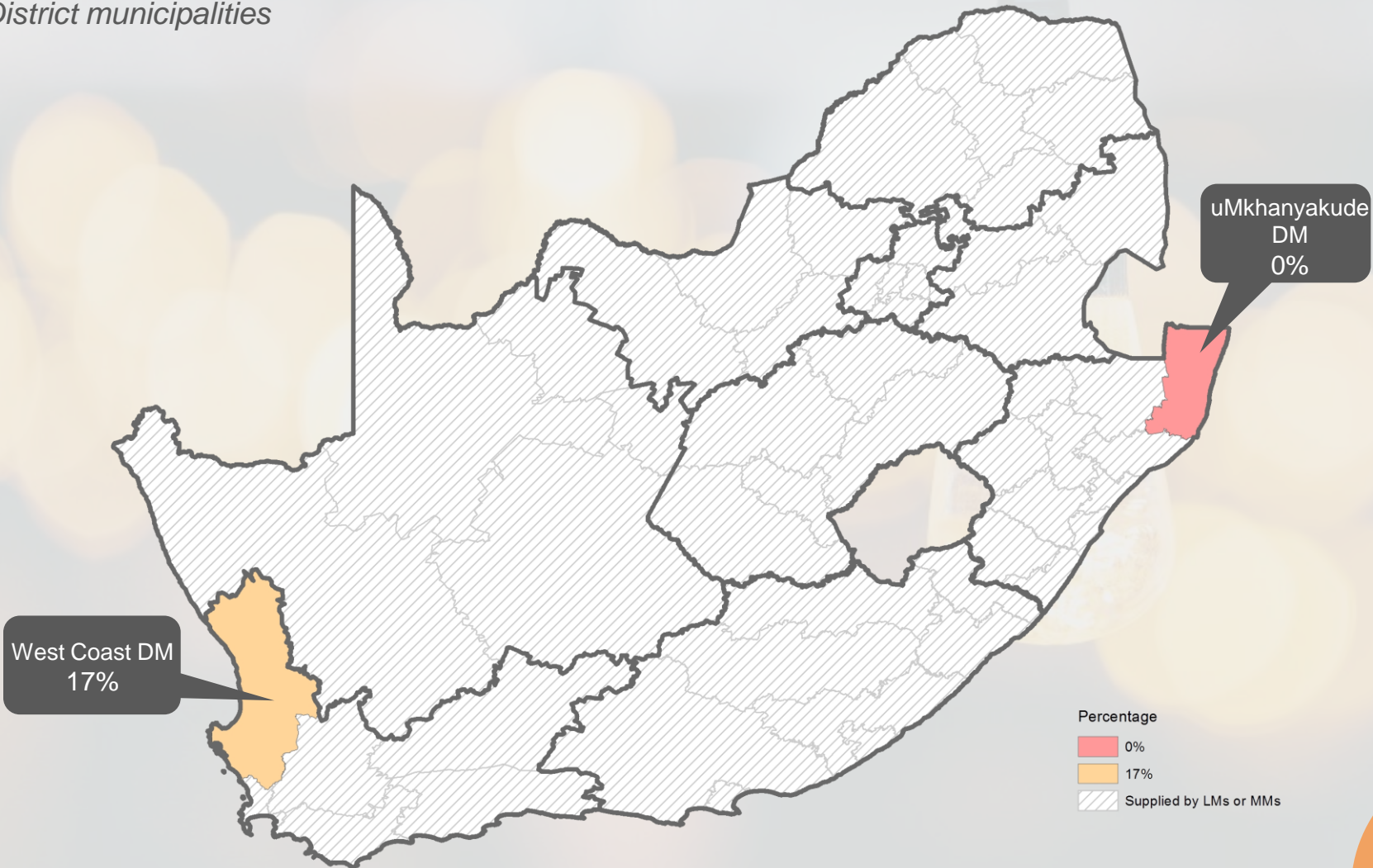

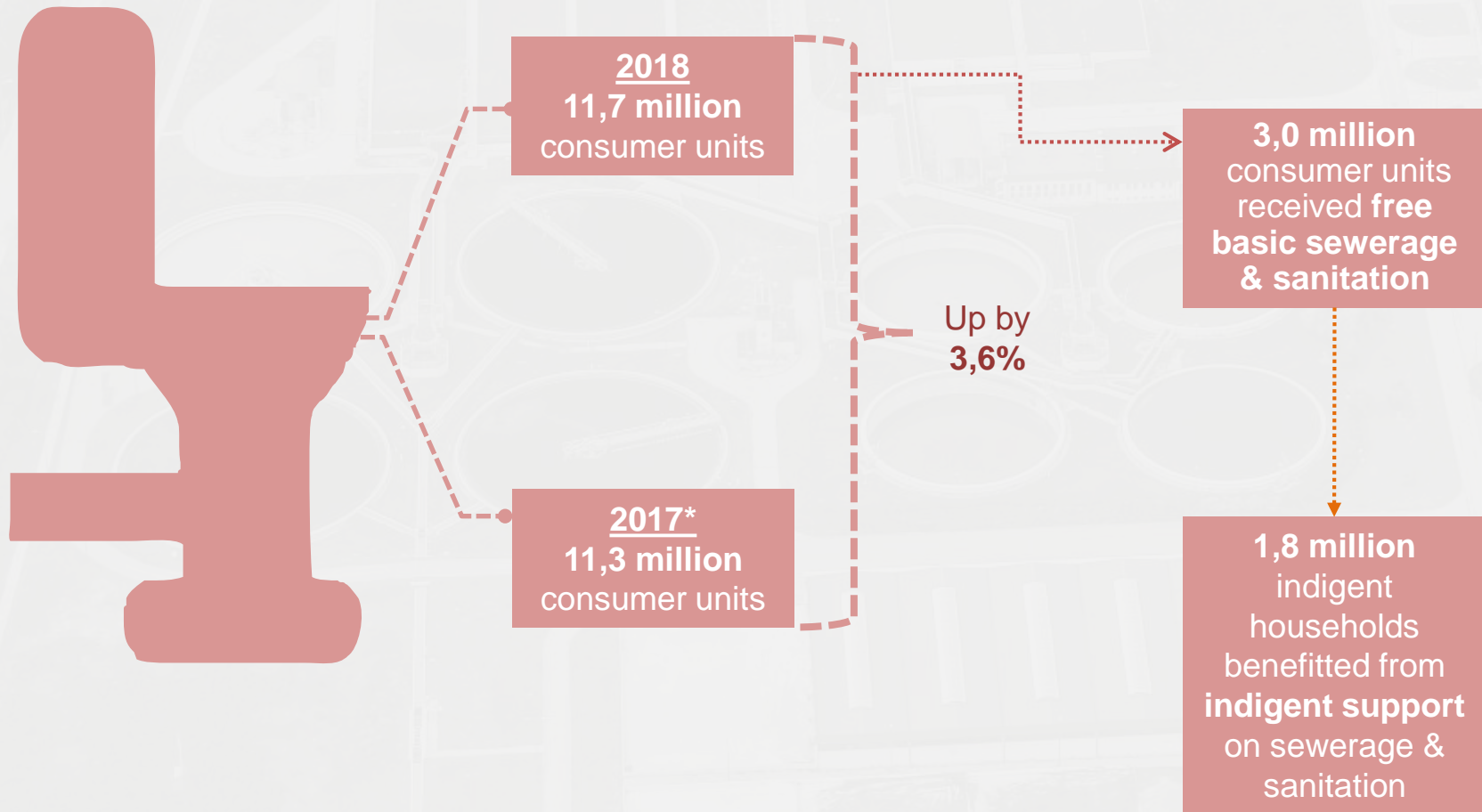

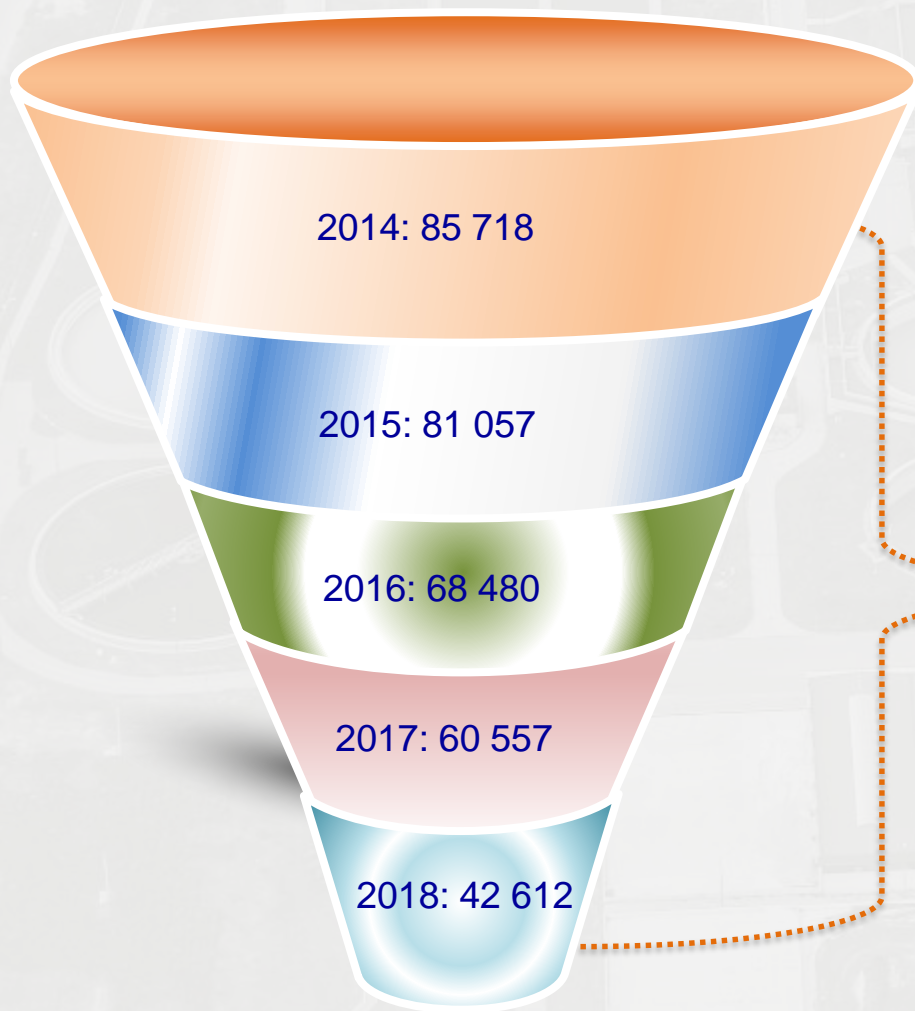


Number of consumer units receiving sewerage & sanitation

Provision of bucket toilets dropped by 50,3% from 2014 to 2018

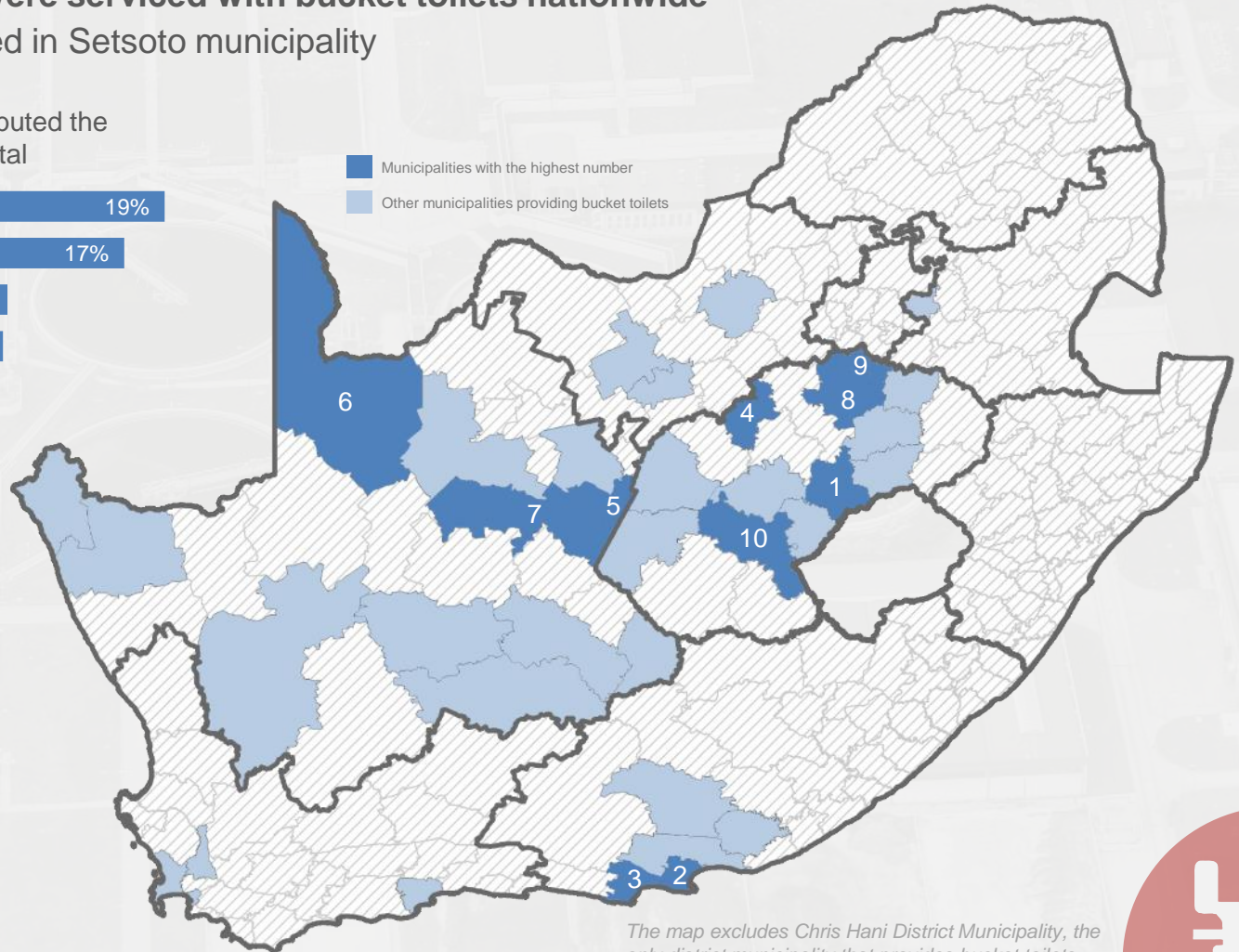
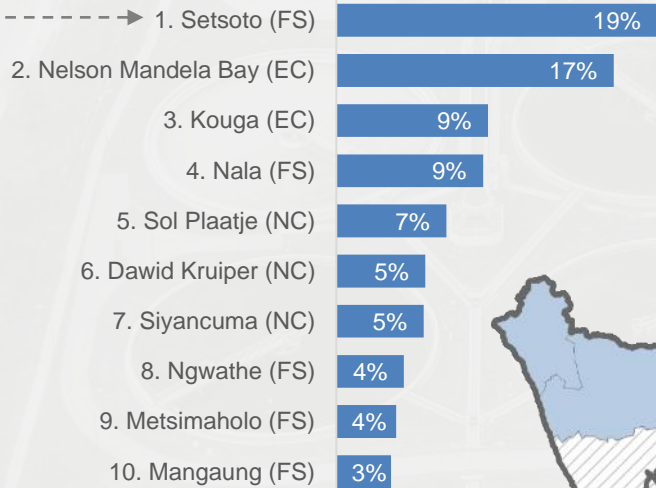


37 out of 257 municipalities provided bucket toilets in 2018

The map excludes Chris Hani District Municipality, the only district municipality that provides bucket toilets



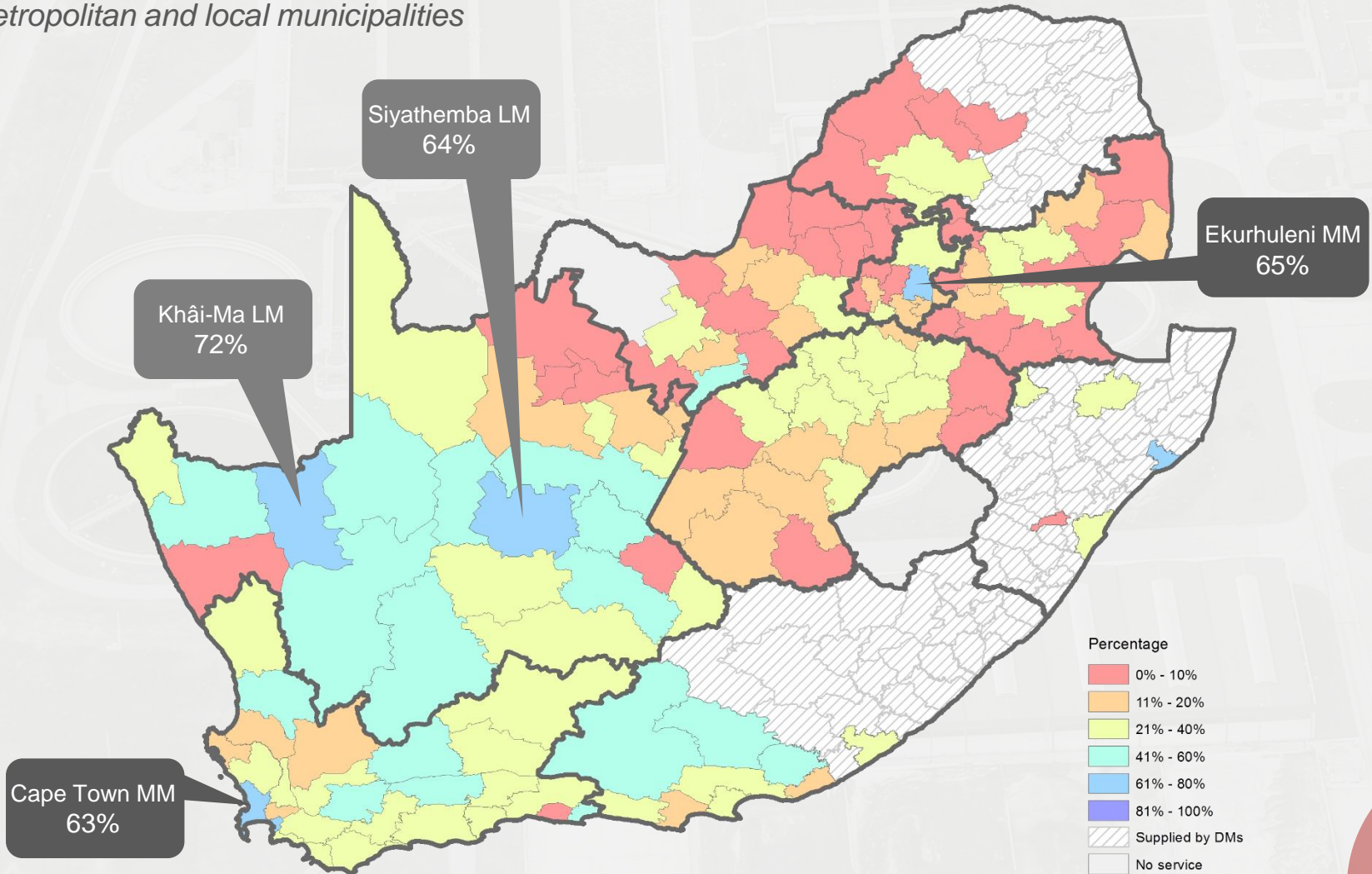

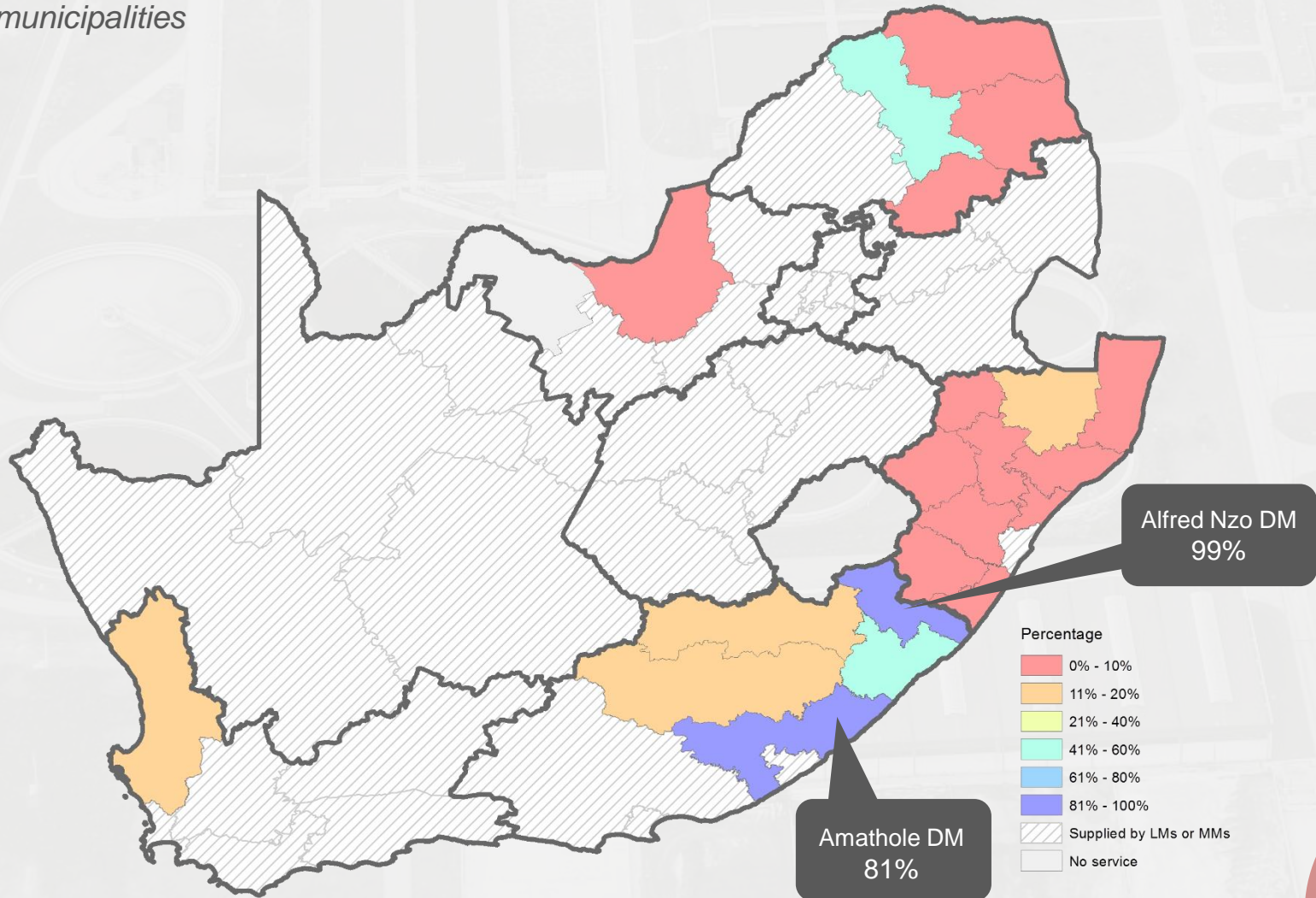
Percentage of consumer units benefitting from some free basic sewerage and sanitation services: 2018

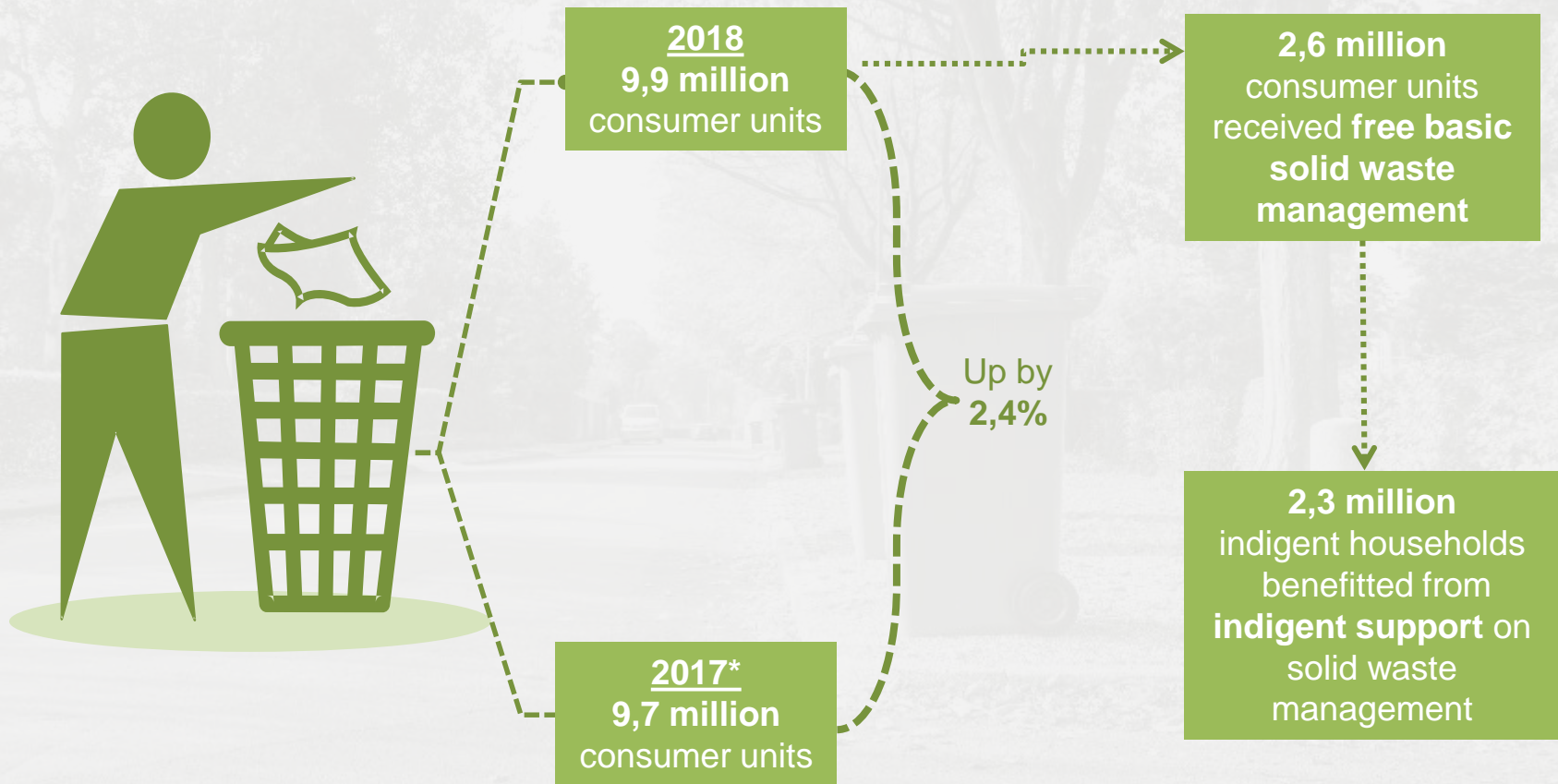

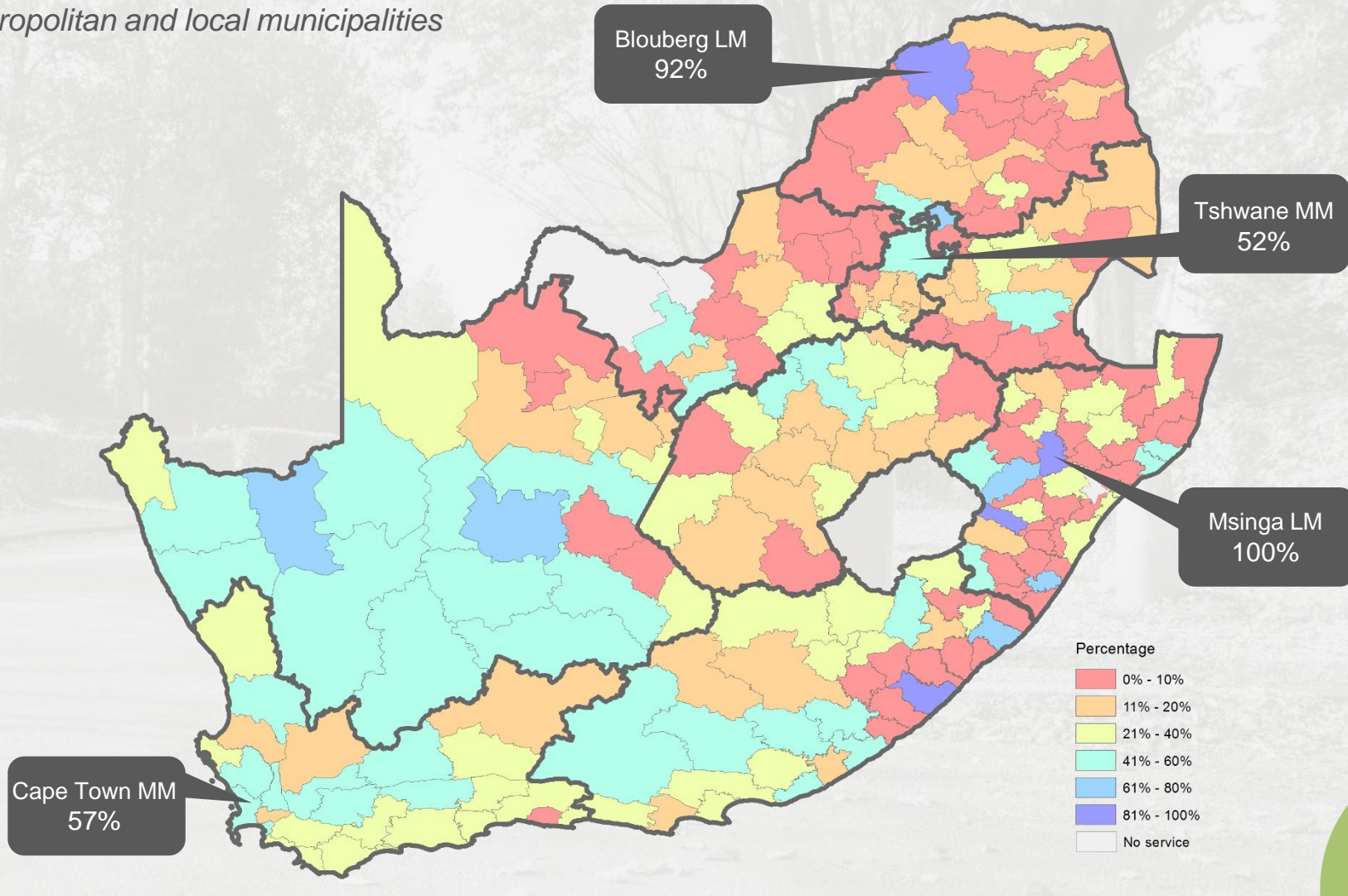
Number of consumer units receiving solid waste management

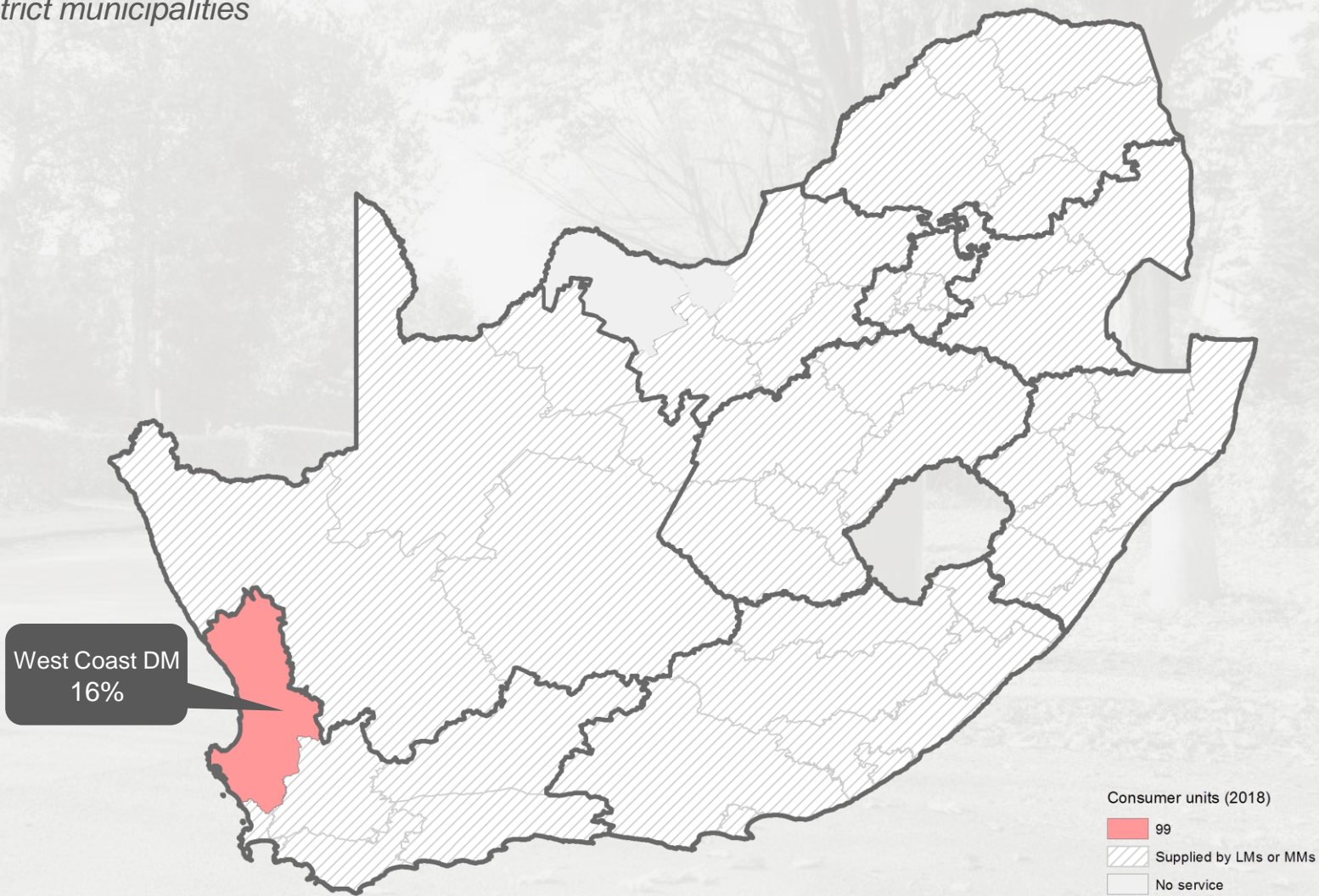
Percentage of consumer units benefitting from some free basic solid waste services: 2018

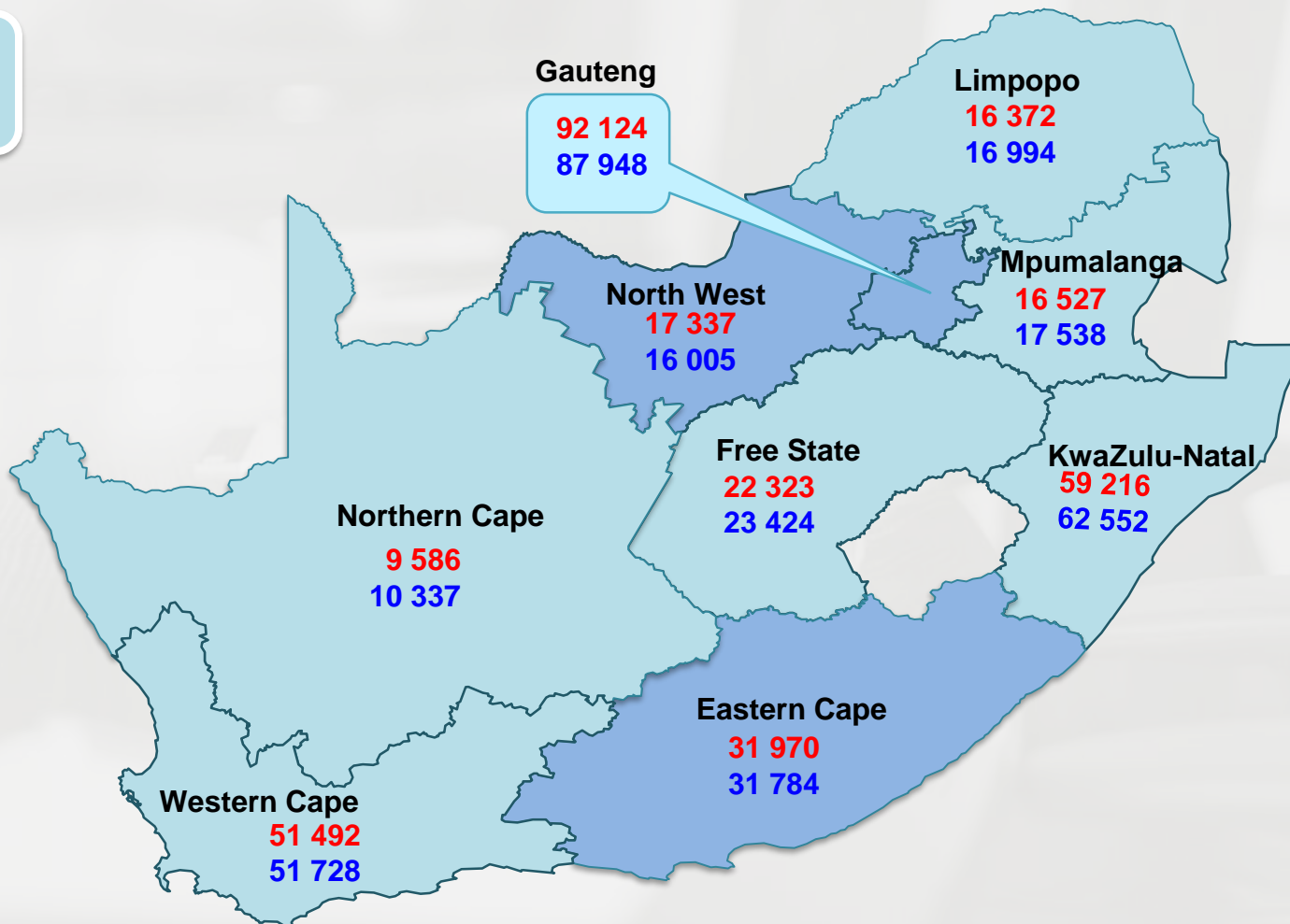

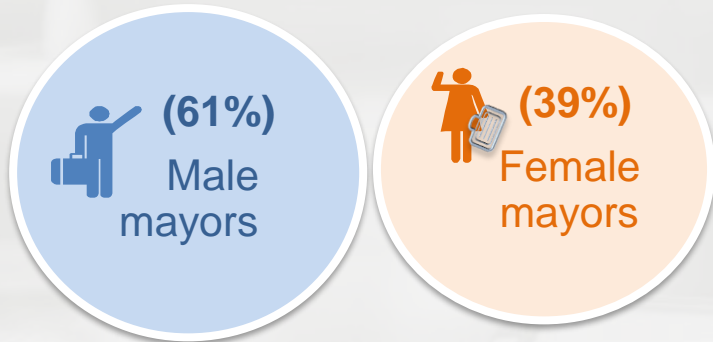

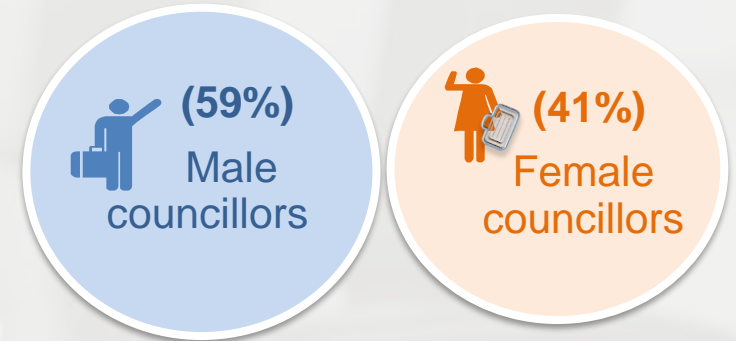


Percentage of males and females in positions of authority: 2018

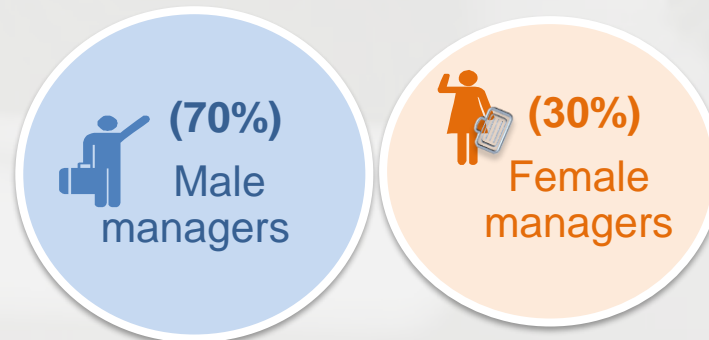

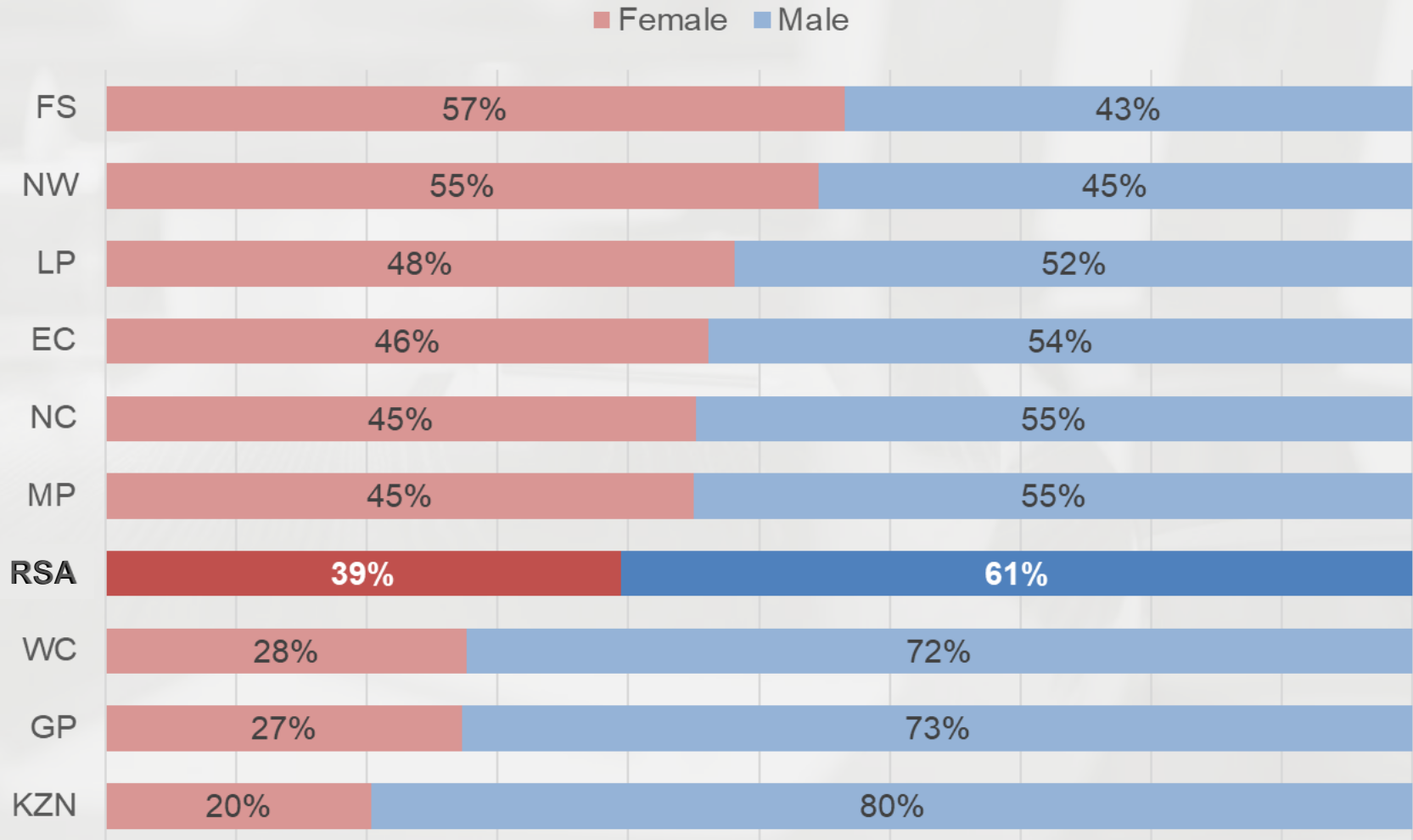

Concluding remarks

1. NFCM : Service delivery estimates from municipalities (supply side)
2. Key findings from 2017 to 2018:
 - More consumer units received services
 - A decline in provision of free basic services
 - Indigents increased from **3 511 741** to **3 631 443**
 - Bucket toilets decreased from **60 557** to **42 612**
