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## 1. Introduction

### 1.1 Aim and collection unit

This publication presents estimates in respect of the Census of Commercial Agriculture (CoCA), 2017 – KwaZulu-Natal. The survey aims to provide financial, production, employment and related information for the commercial agriculture industry in South Africa.

The last CoCA was conducted in 2007 (Reports No. 11-02-06 (2007)).

It is important to note that in 2007 the collection unit was a farming enterprise. The collection unit for CoCA 2017 is a farming unit, where a farming unit consists of one or more farms, holdings or pieces of land, whether adjacent or not, operated as a single unit and situated within the same local municipality. In this report, the word farm means farming unit.

### 1.2 Scope and coverage

CoCA 2017 covers enterprises registered for value added tax (VAT) and which are mainly or primarily engaged in the following activities classified according to the January 1993 edition of the Standard Industrial Classification of all Economic Activities (SIC), Fifth edition.

- Growing of crops, market gardening and horticulture (SIC 111),
- Farming of animals (SIC 112),
- A combination of the above (mixed farming) (SIC 113),
- Agricultural and animal husbandry services, except veterinary activities (SIC 114), and
- Game propagation, including related services (SIC 1151).

### 1.3 Data items

The following categories of data items were collected: general information, land use, field crops, horticultural crops, animals, employment, income, expenditure and details of purchases.

### 1.4 Reference period

The questionnaires were completed for the financial year ended on any date between 1 March 2017 and 28 February 2018, according to the usual reporting schedule of the enterprise, with the following exceptions:

- Animals on farms as at 30 September 2018, and
- Employment as at 30 June 2018.

**1.5 Current prices**

The rand values are at current prices.

**1.6 Reliability of data**

The following are some of the likely sources of non-sampling errors: frame not up to date, wrong definitions and classification, phrasing of questions, non-response, processing and estimation. Every effort is made to minimise non-sampling errors by updating the frame, careful design of questionnaires, testing them with a sample of respondents, editing reported data and implementing efficient operating procedures. Non-sampling errors occur in both sample surveys and censuses.

**1.7 Confidentiality**

According to section 17 of the Statistics Act, 1999 (Act No. 6 of 1999), completed questionnaires remain confidential to Statistics South Africa (Stats SA). Individual business information is never disclosed. Results are presented in aggregated form only.

## 2. Key findings

### 2.1 Farming units, income, and employment


The total number of farms/ farming units involved in the commercial agriculture industry in 2017 was 3 103. The largest proportion of farms was in farming of animals (1 056 farms or 34,0% of the total), followed by growing of cereals and other crops (969 or 31,2%).

The district municipality with the highest number of farms in 2017 was Umgungundlovu (686 farms or 22,1% of the provincial total), followed by Uthukela (364 or 11,7%) and Zululand (358 or 11,5%).

The total income for the commercial agriculture industry in 2017 was R34,0 billion, which was 237% higher than the R10,1 billion recorded for 2007. In 2017, the major contributor to total income was farming of animals (R15,4 billion or 45,2%), followed by growing of cereals and other crops (R9,2 billion or 27,0%) and mixed farming (R6,3 billion or 18,6%).


The district municipality contributing the most to total income in 2017 was Umgungundlovu (R8,2 billion or 24,2%), followed by eThekwin (R4,3 billion or 12,7%) and Umzinyathi (R3,9 billion or 11,5%).

The total number of persons employed in commercial agriculture on 30 June 2018 was 96 206, down from 98 087 on 28 February 2007 (-1,9%). In terms of employment, the major commercial agriculture activity in 2017 was growing of cereals and other crops (37 848 employees or 39,4% of the total), followed by farming of animals (28 167 or 29,3%).


**Figure 1 - Number of farms, income and employment in the commercial agriculture industry by farm size, as a percentage of total, 2017**

In 2017, 308 large farms (those with annual income of more than R22,5 million) constituted 9,9% of the total number of farms in the commercial agriculture industry, and accounted for 67,6% of total income and 47,1% of total employment. This was in contrast to the 1 178 micro farms (annual income below R1 million) which made up 37,9% of the total number of farms, but which accounted for just 1,2% of total income and 4,2% of total employment. Taken together, there were 1 534 large, medium and small farms in 2017, with combined shares of 49,4% of the number of farms, 97,0% of income, and 91,7% of employment.

Measured by farm size, small farming units were the second largest in terms of number of farms, income and employment in 2017.

Farming of animals had the largest share of number of farms (34,0%) and income (45,2%), as well as the second largest share of employment (29,3%) in 2017. Growing of cereals and other crops had the largest share of employment (39,4%) and the second largest share of number of farms (31,2%) and income (27,0%).

In 2017 the Umgungundlovu district municipality recorded the largest provincial share in all the three categories shown in Figure 3 (22,1% of number of farms, 24,2% of income and 19,6% of employment). eThekvinci had the second largest share of income (12,7%) and employment (18,2%) while Uthukela had the second largest share of number of farms (11,7%).

Of the total income of R34,0 billion in the commercial agriculture industry in 2017, R30,2 billion was derived directly from agricultural activities, which is herein referred to as gross farming income. The animals and animal products category was the biggest contributor to gross farming income with 58,7% of the provincial total, followed by field crop products (30,2%). The eThekini metropolitan municipality derived 80,9% of its gross farming income from animals and animal products.

## 2.2 Land use

On 30 September 2018, the total land used for commercial agriculture in KwaZulu-Natal was 1,8 million hectares, which represents 19,5% of the total land area of KwaZulu-Natal (9,4 million hectares). Commercial agricultural land in KwaZulu-Natal comprised mainly grazing land (0,9 million hectares) and arable land (0,5 million hectares). Grazing land is used for livestock and game farming, and arable land is used for crop production.

The Uthukela district accounted for the largest share of KwaZulu-Natal's commercial agricultural land (30,1%), followed by Zululand (14,4%), Harry Gwala (11,9%) and Umgungundlovu (11,8%). Umkhanyakude (1,1%) recorded the smallest share.

Regarding grazing land, 59,2% was located in three districts, namely Uthukela (22,9%), Zululand (21,7%) and Harry Gwala (14,8%). Four districts accounted for 57,1% of arable land, namely Uthukela (17,0%), Umgungundlovu (16,4%), Harry Gwala (14,6%) and Zululand (9,1%).

## 2.3 Field crops

Field crops are important for food security, and they account for the largest portion of cultivated land in South Africa. In terms of area planted, the major field crops in both 2007 and 2017 were sugarcane, maize and soya beans. All three major field crops were mostly planted under dry land, i.e. their main source of water was rain. Sugarcane had the highest proportion (90,9% of sugarcane) planted under dry land in 2017.

Between 2007 and 2017, sugarcane production decreased by 54% (from 13 million to 6 million tons). The Umgungundlovu district produced 24,3% of sugarcane in KwaZulu-Natal in 2017, followed by eThekweni (15,9%) and King Cetshwayo (15,6%).

Maize production increased by 113% from (357 thousand to 761 thousand tons) between 2007 and 2017. Three districts accounted for 73,1% of the province's total in 2017, namely Uthukela (45,9%), Umzinyathi (14,8%) and Amajuba (12,3%).

Soya bean production increased by 68% (from 32 thousand to 53 thousand tons) between 2007 and 2017. Three districts accounted for 86,5% of the province's total in 2017, namely Uthukela (37,7%), Amajuba (26,1%) and Zululand (22,7%)

## 2.4 Horticultural crops

### 2.4.1 Vegetables

The major vegetables in terms of production were potatoes, cabbages and tomatoes. Potatoes and cabbages showed a decrease in area planted.

Regarding production, there were decreases of 60% in potatoes (from 124 thousand to 50 thousand tons) and 37% in cabbages (from 60 thousand to 38 thousand tons) between 2007 and 2017. Tomatoes showed an increase in production of 161% (from 11 thousand to 30 thousand tons) over the same period.

In 2017, the three leading districts in potato production were Uthukela (54,4% of the provincial total), Umgungundlovu (17,9%) and Umzinyathi (15,1%). The largest proportion of the province's tomatoes was produced in the King Cetshwayo district (80,1%). Harry Gwala, Umzinyathi and Uthukela produced 82,9% of the province's cabbages in 2017.

In 2017 the largest shares of tomatoes (40,1%) and cabbages (45,5%) were sold direct to retailers and chain stores (including contract farming); and 67,5% of potatoes were sold to fresh produce markets.

## 2.5 Fruits

### 2.5.1 Citrus fruits

Citrus fruits continue to play an important role in the economy, with strong links to packaging, processing and distribution in the agricultural value chain. Oranges accounted for 910 hectares of area planted in 2017, down by 56,3% from 2007.

Regarding production, oranges fell by 50% between 2007 and 2017 (from 56 thousand to 28 thousand tons), and lemons increased by 147% (from 3 thousand to 7 thousand tons). Compared with 2007, oranges showed an increase in volume of production per hectare in 2017 while lemons showed a decrease.

Oranges and lemons were mainly produced in the King Cetshwayo district (75,5%) and (74,2%) respectively in 2017.

The largest shares of the 2017 production of oranges (57,1%) and lemons (35,7%) were exported. The second largest marketing/distribution channel for oranges (38,1%) and lemons (20,7%) was to fresh produce markets.

## 2.5.2 Subtropical fruits

The cultivation of subtropical fruits is only possible in certain parts of the country due to the nature of their climatic requirements. Between 2007 and 2017, banana production decreased by 39% (from 51 thousand to 32 thousand tons), and pineapple decreased by 23% (from 51 thousand to 39 thousand tons). Compared with 2007, bananas showed a decrease in production per hectare in 2017 while pineapples showed an increase.

The two leading districts in banana production in 2017 were Ugu (66,4% of the province's total) and eThekwini (27,0%). Pineapples were produced in Umkhanyakude (100,0%).

Most of the banana production (89,2%) and over half of pineapples (56,6%) were sold to fresh produce markets in 2017.

## 2.5.3 Tree nuts

There was substantial growth in tree nut production between 2007 and 2017. Macadamia nuts grew by 415% in terms of area planted and by 495% in terms of production (production per hectare increased).

Pecan nuts grew by 50% in terms of area planted and by 159% in terms of production (production per hectare also increased) between 2007 and 2017.

The two leading districts in macadamia nut production in 2017 were Ugu (47,6% of the national total) and iLembe (23,0%). Most of the province's pecan nuts were produced in Zululand (41,8%) and Uthukela (32,8%).

Most macadamia (80,4%) and pecan (60,8%) nuts were sold to processing factories in 2017.

## 2.6 Animals

Cattle, sheep, pigs and chickens are the most reared animals in commercial agriculture in KwaZulu-Natal province.

Between 2007 and 2017, the number of cattle sold decreased by 34% (from 334 thousand to 219 thousand). The leading districts in cattle sales in 2017 were Uthukela (30,3% of the province's total), Harry Gwala (24,6%) and Zululand (16,6%). However, the number of cattle on farm in the province increased by 16% (from 601 thousand to 699 thousand) between 2007 and 2018.

Compared with 2007, the number of sheep sold in 2017 fell by 81% (from 106 thousand to 20 thousand). Most sheep were sold in Harry Gwala (35,6%), Zululand (23,0%) and Uthukela (14,5%). The number of sheep on farm fell by 55% (from 173 thousand to 78 thousand). On 30 September 2018, Harry Gwala district (26,0%), Umzinyathi (19,8%) and Zululand (16,6%) had the highest number of sheep on farm.

There was a decrease of 8% (from 376 thousand to 346 thousand) in the number of pigs sold between 2007 and 2017. Pigs were sold mainly in Umgungundlovu (55,8%), Zululand (29,3%) and Amajuba (8,6%) in 2017. Between 2007 and 2018, the number of pigs on farm increased by 42% (from 172 thousand to 244 thousand). Umgungundlovu (53,5%) had the highest number of pigs on farm in 2018, followed by Umzinyathi (21,4%) and Zululand (15,9%).

The number of chickens sold fell by 8% between 2007 and 2017 (from 126 million to 116 million). In 2017, the largest number of chicken sales took place in Umgungundlovu (48,0%) and Umgungundlovu (44,0%). Ugu (26,6%) and eThekweni (19,8%) reported the largest number of chickens on farm in 2018.

## Explanatory notes

### Background

The results presented in this publication have been derived from the Census of Commercial Agriculture (CoCA), 2017 – KwaZulu-Natal. This publication summarises data on the size, structure and nature of the commercial agriculture industry.

The frame was drawn from Stats SA's business register. The business register is mainly based on the value added tax (VAT) database of the South African Revenue Service (SARS).

The last CoCA was conducted for the year 2007 (Report No. 11-02-06 (2007)).

### Value added tax (VAT)

All figures exclude value added tax (VAT).

### Reference period

The information was collected from enterprises for their financial year which ended on any date between 01 March 2018 and 28 February 2019.

### Statistical unit

The statistical unit is an enterprise. An enterprise is a legal unit (or a combination of legal units) that includes and directly controls all functions necessary to carry out its production activities.

### Collection unit

The collection unit is a farming unit. A farming unit consists of one or more farms, holdings or pieces of land, whether adjacent or not, operated as a single unit and situated within the same local municipality. Thus, an enterprise can have one or more farming units.

### Classification

The 1993 edition of the Standard Industrial Classification of all Economic Activities (SIC), Fifth Edition, Report No. 09-09-02, was used to classify the statistical units in this census. The SIC is based on the third revision of the 1990 International Standard Industrial Classification of all Economic Activities (ISIC), with suitable adaptations for local conditions. Farming sectors included were classified to the five-digit (subgroup) level for the detailed results.

### Size groups

The enterprises are divided into four size groups according to the value of turnover recorded for them on the Stats SA business register. Table J presents the cut-off points for size groups.

### Survey methodology and design

Initially, telephones were used to contact enterprises and update their information on the frame in terms of specific agriculture activity and location. Enterprises were given an option of either self-enumeration or a visit by a Stats SA official. CAPI (Computer Assisted Personal Interview), on both tablet and desktop, was used to conduct the interview and/or capture the data.

### Collection rate

Collection rate = ((collected enterprises + finalised investigations) / sample size) \* 100. The collection rate was 76,9%.

<b>Turnover collection rate</b>	Turnover collection rate = ((collected enterprises BR turnover + finalised investigations BR turnover) / population BR turnover) * 100. The turnover collection rate was 88,9%.
<b>Rewvisions to 2007 results</b>	Rewvisions were made to previous results due to new information obtained after publication.
<b>Non-sampling errors</b>	Inaccuracies may occur because of imperfections in reporting by enterprises and errors made in the collection and processing of the data. Inaccuracies of this kind are referred to as non-sampling errors. Every effort is made to minimise non-sampling errors by updating the frame, careful design of questionnaires, testing them in pilot studies, editing reported data and implementing efficient operating procedures. Non-sampling errors occur in both sample surveys and censuses

## Glossary

<b>Dry land</b>	Main source of water was rain.
<b>Employees</b>	People employed by the business or organisation who received payment (salaries, wages, commission, piece rates or payments in kind) for the last pay period ended on or before 30 June 2018.
<b>Enterprise</b>	A legal entity or a combination of legal units that includes and directly controls all functions necessary to carry out its production activities.
<b>Exports</b>	Outward flow of goods and services leaving the economic territory of a country to the outside world.
<b>Farmer</b>	A farmer is the individual, partnership, close corporation, company, or other enterprise that operates a farming unit for their own account; or the manager, foreman or other person to whom the control of the farming unit was entrusted.
<b>Farm operator/ manager</b>	This is the person who exercises management control over the agricultural holding operation and takes major decisions regarding the use of resources.
<b>Farming unit</b>	A farming unit consists of one or more farms, holdings or pieces of land, whether adjacent or not, operated as a single unit and situated within the same local municipality.
<b>Field crops</b>	Includes grains, oil seeds, legumes, fodder crops and other field crops (e.g. cotton, sugarcane and tobacco).
<b>Fodder crops</b>	Includes grass, lucerne and maize for silage.
<b>Game</b>	Includes elephant, buffalo, rhino, springbok, impala, wildebeest, kudu, zebra, lion, leopard and cheetah.
<b>Grains</b>	Includes maize (white & yellow), wheat, sorghum, barley, oats and rye.
<b>Gross farming income</b>	Includes income earned from agricultural products sold, but excludes other income generated outside farming.
<b>Imports</b>	Inward flow of goods and services entering the economic territory of a country from the outside world.
<b>Legumes</b>	Includes beans and peas.
<b>Livestock</b>	Includes cattle (beef and dairy breeds), sheep (wool and non-wool breeds), pigs, goats (meat, milk and mohair breeds), horses and poultry (chickens, turkeys, ducks, ostriches and geese) etc.
<b>Livestock products</b>	Includes eggs, honey, meat, milk, hides and skins.
<b>Oil seeds</b>	Includes sunflower, groundnuts, canola and soya beans.
