## Laundering and (dry-) cleaning services

Statistics South Africa has pleasure in announcing the release of Report No 99-01-01(1995) on laundering and (dry-) cleaning services. This report forms part of a series of other reports that are based on the Census of social, recreational and personal services of 1995.

The report provides detailed information of all enterprises (firms) in South Africa rendering laundering and (dry-) cleaning services as their main activity.

Some of the interesting statistics in this report are:

- That single owner enterprises formed the largest number of laundering and (dry-) cleaning services enterprises (58.0%) in 1995, followed by close corporations (17.4%) and private companies (11.3%)
- An average annual decrease of 4.4% in the number of laundering and (dry-) cleaning services enterprises during the period 1988 to 1995 from 1 181 to 864.
- An average annual increase 3.9% in the total number of paid employees in the laundering and (dry-) cleaning services industry during the period between 1988 to 1995 from 13 782 paid employees to 18 071 paid employees.
