Statistics South Africa has pleasure in announcing the release of Report No 99-02-01(1995) on hairdressing and other beauty treatment services. This report forms part of a series of other reports that are based on the Census of social, recreational and personal services of 1995.

The report provides detailed information of all enterprises (firms) in South Africa rendering hairdressing and other beauty treatment services as their main activity.

Some of the interesting statistics in this report are:

- That single owner enterprises formed the largest number of hairdressing and other beauty treatment services enterprises (83.3%) in 1995, followed by close corporations (8.6%) partnerships (6.9%) and private companies (1.2%).
- An average annual decrease of 2.5% in the number of hairdressing and other beauty treatment services enterprises during the period 1988 to 1995 from 3 812 to 3 183.
- An average annual increase 0.4% in the total number of paid employees in the hairdressing and other beauty treatment services industry during the period between 1988 to 1995 from

12 274 paid employees to 12 592 paid employees.
