South African economy expands by 0,4%


After contracting by a revised 1,1% in the fourth quarter of 2022, real gross domestic product (GDP) edged higher by 0,4% in the first quarter of 2023.

Manufacturing and finance industries were major drivers of growth on the supply side of the economy. The demand side was lifted by exports, with smaller positive contributions for household, government, and investment spending.

Eight of the ten industries recorded growth in the first quarter. Manufacturing output increased by 1,5%, driven mainly by the production of food and beverages. Finance, real estate & business services crept up by 0,6%, mainly driven by financial intermediation, insurance & pension funding, real estate and business services.

Electricity, gas & water and agriculture contracted in the first quarter.



The category "all 'other' retailers" is not included in the graphic Source: Retail trade sales, March 2023 (Table C)










