### Feature article

#### GDP weakens in the third quarter


After two consecutive quarters of growth, South African real gross domestic product (GDP) contracted by 0,2% in the third quarter of 2023.

On the production (supply) side of the economy, five of the ten industries recorded weaker results, with agriculture, manufacturing and construction the biggest drags on growth.

The agriculture industry declined by 9,6%, driven lower mainly by field crops, animal products and horticulture products. Weaker demand saw manufacturing production decline by 1,3%. The construction industry weakened further, recording a second consecutive quarter of decline.

The contributions to the performance of the economy were evenly spread between the industries on the production side of the economy. The contributions ranged from -0,3 of a percentage point to +0,1 of a percentage point.



#### Eggflation across the country


Prices for poultry-related products, including eggs, have come under increased upward pressure due to the outbreak of avian flu.

Price increases for eggs vary across the country. Western Cape consumers felt the most pain, with the average price of a tray of six eggs rising by R6,42, from R17,71 in October 2022 to R24,13 in October 2023.

Gauteng consumers had to fork out an additional R4,81 over the same period. At an average price of R24,32, a tray of six eggs was the most expensive in Gauteng during October.

Of the seven provinces surveyed, Free State bucked the trend. Breakfast in that province became slightly cheaper, with the average price for a tray of six eggs declining from R19,33 in October 2022 to R18,38 in October 2023.




